<sup>2</sup> Recipients subject to the administrative provisions of the Safe Streets Act are exempt from the Equal Employment Opportunity Program (EEOP) requirement, if they meet any of the following criteria: (1) the recipient is a nonprofit organization, a medical or educational institution, or an Indian tribe, (2) the recipient has less than 50 employees, or (3) the recipient received a single award or subaward for less than \$25,000.
