MANDATORY INCARCERATION STATUS
OF UNDER CUSTODY PRISON POPULATION

This report provides information on the proportion of persons currently held under custody who have been committed to state prison for criminal offenses that carry a legislatively mandated state prison sentence.

- HIGHLIGHTS -

The commitment offense type and prior criminal record of inmates held under custody were examined in order to determine the proportion of persons held in New York State correctional facilities who were subject to a legislatively mandated state prison sentence.

Our review indicates that 82% of the inmates under custody were subject to legislatively mandated state prison sentences. Another 8% of the population were convicted of offenses which presumptively carry a mandatory state prison sentence. The remaining 10% of the inmates under custody were classified as eligible for a sentencing disposition other than state prison.

Mandatory Incarceration Status of Under Custody Prison Population

Due to the substantial cost of constructing and operating correctional facilities, the Department of Correctional Services is frequently asked what proportion of the under custody population is eligible for probation or other sentencing alternatives. This question is posed in a slightly different manner by asking what proportion of those persons currently held under custody have been committed to state prison as a result of legislative requirements that mandate a state prison sentence. The purpose of the present study is to identify, as far as the legal history information available on our computer files will allow, the proportion of persons currently under custody who are subject to mandatory state prison requirements.

A. Identifying Mandatory Incarceration Cases

The distinction between those inmates who are serving a mandatory state prison sentence and those who might have received an alternative sentence is, for many cases, ambiguous. Many of the problems associated with defining "probation eligibility"^{A/} are also presented in identifying those inmates who were subject to mandatory state incarceration.

A variety of factors determine whether or not a defendant will face a mandatory state prison term. Offense type is one of the criteria for mandatory state prison sentencing. For instance, convictions for Class A-I felony offenses (e.g., Murder 2nd, Kidnapping 1st, Arson 1st), Class B violent felony offenses (e.g., Robbery 1st, Manslaughter 1st), and Class C violent felony offenses (e.g., Assault 1st, Attempted Rape 1st) draw a mandatory term (see New York State Penal Law Section 70.02).

Another factor is the prior criminal record of the defendant. New York State law requires that persons convicted a second time for a felony offense be committed to state prison (see New York State Penal Law Section 70.06).

There are other factors that serve to include, or to exclude, a defendant from the mandatory state prison category. For instance, certain offenders who use a weapon in the commission of a Class D or Class E violent felony offense may face a mandatory state prison term (see New York State Penal Law Section 70.02 (2)(c)). However, for these same offenders the judge may select some other non-state-prison sentencing alternative if he finds that certain "mitigating circumstances" exist (e.g., role of defendant was relatively minor; deficiencies in proof that it was an "armed felony," etc.). As another example, cooperation with the prosecution may exempt a defendant from a mandatory state prison term. Persons convicted of a Class A-II drug felony must receive an indeterminate state prison sentence; but these persons may receive a sentence of life-time probation if they provide assistance in the apprehension or prosecution of other drug offenders (New York State Penal Law Section 65.00 (1)(b)).

Conviction offense type and prior criminal record as determinants of mandatory state prison status are relatively straightforward. Moreover, information on these variables is contained on computer data files maintained by the Department. The operation of other factors on mandatory state prison status is more subjective (e.g., extent of cooperation with prosecution, findings of mitigating circumstances by the judge, plea negotiation restrictions, extent of weapon use, nature of prior offenses, etc.). Information pertaining to these variables would not generally be contained on electronic data files maintained by the Department and in many instances would not be reflected in the inmate case file folder. For purposes of the present study, we have relied on conviction offense type and prior criminal record to identify those inmates who are subject to mandatory state prison sentences. We recognize that some of our classification decisions might be different if we had access to the full range of information used by the judge at sentencing.

B. Proportion of Under Custody Inmates Subject to Mandatory Incarceration Statutes

Three different categories are used in defining the sentencing status of persons held under custody. The first group consists of those cases for which current law requires a state prison sentence. The second group is made up of cases in which a state prison sentence is required, but there are conditions specified in the law that allow for some other type of sentencing alternative. These circumstances include assistance in the arrest and prosecution of other offenders, a judicial finding of

"mitigating circumstances," a finding by the court that a state prison term would be unduly harsh, and others. This second group is treated as cases in which a state prison term is presumptive; that is, a defendant will be committed to state prison unless certain conditions are found to obtain.

The third group consists of those cases for which sentencing alternatives other than state prison are available to the court (and which do not require exceptional circumstances to be used).

Our assignment of cases to each of these three categories is based on current law. We have benefited from a recent review of legislation affecting probation eligibility put together by staff in the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services (part of which is attached as Appendix A).^{A/} With respect to mandatory sentencing provisions, we have taken a conservative position in assigning cases to a sentencing category. If the law provides some set of circumstances in which an alternative to state prison is an option, the case was placed in the alternative sentence category or in the presumptive state prison sentence category, whichever was appropriate.

Table 1 presents an overview of the mandatory incarceration status of persons held under custody on June 5, 1986, according to felony class category of conviction offense. The footnotes to Table 1 help explain our assignment of cases to one sentencing status category or another. These notes also indicate that more information than the legal criteria typically found on our computer files (e.g. offense type, felony class category, first or second felony offender status) may be needed to confidently determine that a particular defendant was subject to a mandatory state prison term.

In addition to the data presented in Table 1, several other tables are included in Appendix B. These tables contain more detailed information on the mandatory sentencing status of persons convicted of particular offenses. Used in conjunction with the New York State Penal Law or the New York State Sentence Charts, these additional tables offer users some opportunity to review the mandatory sentencing status classifications we have applied. These tables (in Appendix B) include: (a) specific offense type by mandatory incarceration status; (b) offense type (aggregated) by mandatory incarceration status; (c) first or second felony offender status by mandatory incarceration status; (d) violent felony offenders (aggregate) by mandatory incarceration status; (e) non-violent felony offenders (aggregate) by mandatory incarceration status; (f) specific offense type by felony class category (for first felony offenders only).

FINDINGS

Table 1 presents mandatory incarceration status according to felony class category of conviction offense. The numbers in parentheses reflect the number of persons in each specific felony class category who were sentenced as second or persistent felony offenders (e.g. of the 10,097 Class B violent felony offenders held under custody, 4,183 had been sentenced as a second or persistent felony offender).

Persons convicted of the very serious crimes that fall into the Class A-I felony category (e.g. Murder 2nd, Kidnapping 1st, Arson 1st), not surprisingly, face mandatory state prison sentences.

The A-II felony class category is comprised of persons convicted of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance 2nd and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance 2nd. The Penal Law requires a state prison term for conviction of an A-II felony. However, the law allows for a sentence of life-time probation on the condition that the defendant has provided material assistance in the investigation or prosecution of other drug felony suspects. Hence, these cases are treated as presumptively requiring a state prison term.

Those inmates found in the Class B violent felony offense category (N = 10,097) face a mandatory state prison term for several reasons. First, the law requires a mandatory indeterminate state prison term for nearly all Class B felony offenses (and specifically for Class B violent felony offenses). Second, approximately 40% (4,183) of these Class B felony offenders have been sentenced as a second felony offender. The New York State Penal Law provides for a mandatory state prison sentence for persons convicted of a second felony offense (see NYS Penal Law Section 70.06). Legislatively designated violent felony offenses are identified in Section 70.02 of the Penal Law (and are listed in Appendix A of this report).

A substantial number of Class B non-violent felony offenders fall into the presumptive state incarceration category (N = 1,393 see Table 1). The inmates in this category are persons who have been convicted of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance 3rd and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance 3rd. Persons convicted of a Class B drug felony are eligible to receive a sentence of life-time probation in return for material assistance in connection with the arrest or prosecution of other drug offenders. Interestingly, this life-time probation provision extends to Class B drug felony offenders convicted of a second felony offense as well (see NYS Penal Law Section 70.06 (5); 65.00; 60.05 (3)).

A/ Persons convicted of a Class A-I felony offense must be sentenced to state prison (NYS Penal Law Section 60.05(2), 70.00).

B/ Offenses in the A-II felony class category are treated as presumptively requiring a state prison sentence. Like the Class A-I felony offense, the Penal Law requires a state prison sentence for conviction of a Class A-II felony (NYS Penal Law Section 60.05 (2)); but for persons convicted of a Class A-II drug felony or a Class B drug felony, the law allows for a sentence of life-time probation "upon the ground that such person has or is providing material assistance in the investigation, apprehension or prosecution" of persons suspected of having committed a drug felony (see NYS Penal Law Section 65.00 (1)(b)). The option of life-time probation in return for assistance in the apprehension or prosecution of other drug felony suspects is, however, not available where the court "sentences a defendant for more than one crime and imposes a sentence of imprisonment for any one of the crimes, or where the defendant is subject to an undischarged, indeterminate or reformatory sentence of imprisonment which was imposed at a previous time by a court of this state and has more than one year to run (NYS Penal Law Section 65.00 (1)(b)).

- C/ The number in parentheses reflects the proportion of persons in the A-II drug felony class category who were sentenced as second felony offenders. For virtually all other persons convicted of a second felony offense (second felony offenders are defined in NYS Penal Law Section 70.06), a state prison sentence is required and there are no alternative sentence possibilities. However, a person convicted of a Class A-II drug felony or a Class B drug felony, and who is also a second felony offender, may be sentenced to life-time probation (NYS Penal Law Section 70.06 (5)).
- D/ The A-III felony class category was abolished in 1979 and the offenses reclassified as Class B felonies. There are seven of these cases still under custody. They are placed in the presumptive incarceration category because, like the drug offenders in the Class A-II category, the option for life-time probation existed for those who assisted in the arrest and prosecution of other suspected drug law offenders.
- E/ Class B Violent Felony Offenses are those listed in Penal Law Section 70.02. These are offenses designated by the legislature as violent felony offenses. These offenses are also listed in the attached summary of probation eligible offenses prepared by the Division of Criminal Justice Services.
- F/ The figure in parentheses represents the number of Class B violent felony offenders who were sentenced as Second Felony Offenders. For all the categories in Table 1, the number in parentheses reflects the number of cases in the particular category that were sentenced as Second Felony Offenders. For instance, of the 37 Class B Non-Violent Felony Offenders who were subject to mandatory incarceration, 13 were Second Felony Offenders.
- G/ Even though they are second felony offenders, persons convicted of a Class B drug felony are eligible to receive a sentence of life-time probation in return for defendant's material assistance in connection with the investigation and prosecution of other drug offenders (NYS Penal Law Section 70.06 (5), 65.00, 60.05 (3)).
- H/ For defendants convicted of Class D violent felony weapons offenses (Criminal Sale of Firearms 1st or Criminal Possession of a Weapon 3rd), the court must impose an indeterminate state prison sentence or a flat definite term of one year, unless mitigating circumstances can be shown (see NYS Penal Law Section 70.02 (2), 70.02 (5)).

- I/ Where a defendant enters a plea of guilty to a Class D violent felony offense in satisfaction of an indictment charging the defendant with an armed felony (i.e., any violent felony offense committed while armed), the court must impose an indeterminate sentence of imprisonment (NYS Penal Law Section 70.02 (5)(b)). However, a defendant may (at the discretion of the court) receive a sentence other than state incarceration if the court determines that mitigating circumstances exist. A fraction of defendants in this alternative sentence category (i.e., those who have pled down to a Class D violent felony offense following indictment for an armed felony) should properly be treated as either presumptive state prison incarceration or perhaps mandatory incarceration. Since our computer data file does not contain information on whether the original indictment charge was for an "armed felony," we have elected to treat all the cases in this category as eligible for a sentencing option other than to state prison. It is still the case, however, that those persons indicted for an armed felony and who have pled to a Class D violent felony offense and who cannot show mitigating circumstances, face a mandatory state prison term. Identification of these cases would increase the number of persons in the mandatory state prison category and reduce the number in the alternative sentences category.
- J/ These cases are all Attempted Criminal Possession of a Weapon 3rd. These cases are in the mandatory state prison category because of their status as second felony offenders. See also the discussion in footnote K below.
- K/ These cases are all Attempted Criminal Possession of a Weapon 3rd. If a defendant is indicted for Criminal Possession of a Weapon 3rd (NYS Penal Law Section 265.02) and has a conviction for a Class A misdemeanor within five years preceding the instant weapons offense or is indicted for Criminal Sale of a Firearm 1st (NYS Penal Law Section 265.12), he may plead to no lower than a Class E violent felony offense (NYS Criminal Procedure Law Section 220.10 (5)). Persons convicted of a Class E violent felony offense are subject to mandatory state prison incarceration unless "mitigating circumstances" can be shown (see NYS Penal Law 70.02 (2) (c), 70.02 (5) (b,c)). Hence, these cases are treated as presumptive but not mandatory state prison incarceration.

It is also important to note that Attempted Criminal Possession of a Weapon 3rd is a "violent" felony offense only when a conviction for this crime results from a plea negotiation arrangement in which Attempted Criminal Possession of Weapon 3rd is the lesser included offense ((see NYS Penal Law Section 70.02 (1) and Hechtman "Practice Commentary"; and NYS Criminal Procedure Law 220.20)). A defendant originally charged with and convicted of Attempted Criminal Possession of a Weapon 3rd would properly be a Class E non-violent felony offender (and not a Class E "violent" felony offender). As a Class E non-violent felony offender, he would be eligible for probation or other community sentences. For purposes of this report, we have elected to treat these 39 cases as Class E violent felony offenders (i.e. we assume the bulk of these convictions are a result of a plea negotiation agreement in which a more serious crime was charged in the original indictment).

As noted, the Legislature has designated certain crimes as violent felony offenses (NYSPL Section 70.02). The law provides that persons convicted of a Class C violent felony offense (e.g. Assault 1st, Robbery 2nd, Attempted Manslaughter 1st, Criminal Possession of a Weapon 2nd, etc.) must receive an indeterminate state prison sentence (Penal Law Section 70.02). We can also note that half (51.1%, N = 3543) of these Class C violent felony commitments were also sentenced as a second felony offender.

Only certain Class C non-violent felony offenders face mandatory incarceration. The Legislature has identified certain specific Class C non-violent felony offenses for which a state prison term is mandatory (e.g. Arson 3rd, Promoting Prostitution 2nd, etc.). These offenses are listed in Table 1. We can also see in Table 1 that 414 Class C non-violent felony offenders were sentenced as a second felony offender. As second felony offenders, these persons must be (with certain exceptions) committed to state prison. Table 1 also shows that there were 423 Class C non-violent felony offenders held under custody who were eligible for a sentencing option other than state prison.

Table 1 shows that Class D and Class E felony offenders (whether violent or non-violent) who face mandatory state incarceration are made up almost exclusively of persons sentenced as second felony offenders. Of the total number of Class D and Class E felony offenders held under custody (N = 10,693), 71% (N = 7,582) were sentenced as second or persistent felony offenders.

Persons convicted of certain weapon offenses that are Class D violent felony offenses (e.g. Criminal Possession of a Weapon 3rd, Criminal Sale of Firearms 1st) or Class E violent felony offenses (Attempted Criminal Possession of a Weapon 3rd) must receive an indeterminate state prison term or a flat definite term of one year, unless mitigating circumstances can be shown. These cases (Class D violent felony offense N = 185; Class E violent felony offense N = 39) are classified as presumptive state prison incarceration.

Those Class D and Class E felony offenders who are not sentenced as a second felony offender, or who are not convicted of certain weapons offenses, or who are not subject to certain plea negotiation restrictions (see footnotes I and J in Table 1), are eligible for a sentencing alternative other than state prison.

As indicated in Table 1, there are 1,253 Class D violent felony offenders that have been assigned to the alternative sentence category. However, the Penal Law provides that persons who have pled down to a Class D violent felony in satisfaction of an indictment charging the defendant with an "armed felony" (i.e. a violent felony offense in which a firearm is possessed or used, see NYS Criminal Procedure Law 1.20 (41)) must be committed to state prison unless certain "mitigating circumstances" are found (NYS Penal Section 70.02 (5)). Further, if the judge determines that mitigating circumstances exist and a sentence other than an indeterminate state prison term is ordered, the judge must make a

statement on the record of the facts and circumstances supporting his determination and a transcript of this record must be forwarded to the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services. We can note that of the 1,253 cases in this category, 62% (N = 777) were committed for Attempted Assault 1st (N = 45), Assault 2nd (N = 221) or Attempted Robbery 2nd (N = 511), all offenses in which weapon use is not uncommon. That fraction of cases in this category who have pled down from an armed felony and who cannot show mitigating circumstances would be defendants who face a mandatory state prison term. This would reduce the number of inmates categorized in the alternative sentence category and increase the number of persons in the mandatory sentence category. Since our information about these plea negotiation decisions is limited or non-existent, we have treated all of these cases (N = 1,253) as eligible for an alternative sentence.

Finally, persons granted Youthful Offender Status are eligible for probation or other non-state-prison sentencing alternatives (NYS Criminal Procedure Law Section 60.02, 60.05). Although, recent legislation (Chapter 408, Laws of 1978) has placed additional limits on Youthful Offender Status eligibility for persons indicted for an armed felony offense (NYS Penal Law Section 720.10).

Examining figures for the total group of inmates held under custody in June of 1986 shows that 82.0% (N = 28,897 inmates) were subject to mandatory state incarceration requirements. Most of these persons were subject to a mandatory state prison sentence because of the serious nature of the conviction offense (e.g. Class A-I felony, Class B violent felony, or Class C violent felony) or because they had been convicted of a second or third felony offense. Among Class D and Class E felony offenders, those who face mandatory state incarceration are made up almost exclusively of persons sentenced as second felony offenders.

Approximately 8% (N = 2,707) of the under custody population were treated as presumptively requiring a sentence to state prison. Again, these are cases where the law calls for a state prison term, but there are provisions whereby a court may select some other sentencing alternative. Certain drug offenders may receive life-time probation for material assistance in the arrest or prosecution of other drug offenders. Persons convicted of certain weapon offenses may escape a state prison term depending on the circumstances of the offense or the defendant's prior record (see NYSPL Section 70.02).

Approximately 10% (N = 3,626) of the under custody inmates remain in the category in which alternatives to state prison are a sentencing option. These are cases that could have received a local jail term, probation, jail and probation, or some other sentencing disposition. While these cases are eligible for other than state prison sentences, other investigators who have examined this population maintain that prior misdemeanor convictions, prior failure experiences on probation, the coercive nature of the offense, or other factors, reduce the suitability of these cases for community based sentencing alternatives. B/

In conclusion, we have categorized the under custody population with respect to current penal law requirements regarding mandatory state prison sentences. Our review indicates that 82% of the inmates under custody were subject to legislatively mandated state prison sentences. Another 8% of the population were convicted of offenses which presumptively carry a mandatory state prison sentence. Unless certain circumstances are found by the court to obtain, these defendants must be committed to state prison. The remaining 10% of the inmates under custody were classified as eligible for a sentencing disposition other than state prison.

History of Legislation Affecting Probation Eligibility Since 1967

The determination of probation eligibility has become increasingly difficult because offense classifications have changed over time. Certain offenses considered to be probation eligible at one point became ineligible as the result of revised statutes. Legislative changes over the years has created pools of normally eligible, normally ineligible and may be eligible offenders. Normally eligible offenders are those who clearly meet the statutory requirements at a point in time. Examples of this category include youthful offender cases, misdemeanor offenders and offenders convicted of non-penal law felonies. Normally ineligible offenders are those convicted of most Class A and Class B felonies and multiple felony offenses. The may be eligible category is more difficult to determine because of ambiguous statutes or factors not available from a statutory analysis. For example, offenders convicted of Class A and Class B drug crimes may receive probation if they cooperate with the prosecutor.

In determining probation eligibility, one must note the conviction charge (a violent felony or non-violent felony), any mitigating circumstances surrounding the case, and the offenders prior legal record. In addition, probation is not authorized in the following cases:

- (1) where the offender is sentenced for more than one crime and imprisonment is ordered for one of the crimes; and
- (2) where the offender, at the time of sentencing, is serving a prison or reformatory term and has more than one year to serve of that term.

Since 1967 there have been significant changes in the laws affecting eligibility for probation sentences ordered by the criminal courts. The changes discussed below are presented in Table 1. Authorized dispositions of mandatory imprisonment for felony offenders are specified in PL 60.05, and the sentence of probation is authorized by PL 65.00.

1967

Effective September 1, 1967, all offenders were eligible for probation except those convicted of murder and kidnapping 1° (Class A felonies). This

provision was part of a completely revised Penal Law produced by the State Commission on Revision of the Penal Law and Criminal Code.

1973

The next recodification of the Penal Law occurred on September 1, 1973 at which time the Rockefeller Drug Laws were enacted. As the result of these laws, convictions for the following offenses were considered to be normally ineligible for a probation sentence:

All Class A Felonies (except A-111 drug felony whereby the defendant assists in the prosecution of drug cases and receives a lifetime probation sentence.)

All Class B Felonies

Class C Felonies

Assault 1°
Burglary 2°
Robbery 2°
Criminal Possession of Dangerous Weapon 2°
Criminal Possession of Controlled Substance 5° (excluding marijuana cases)
Criminal Sale of Controlled Substance 5° (excluding marijuana cases)
Rewarding Official Misconduct 1°
Receiving Reward for Official Misconduct 1°

Class D Felonies

Attempted Assault 1° and Assault 2° convictions could receive a definite sentence to jail plus probation in cases where the court determined that a mandatory prison sentence was unduly harsh.

The 1973 laws also defined and authorized mandatory imprisonment for multiple felony offenders (predicate and persistent felonies). To be sentenced as a predicate felony offender, a defendant must have been convicted of a second Penal Law felony offense within ten years of the first felony conviction. Multiple felony offenders are considered to be normally ineligible for probation sentences. The 1973 laws continued the provision that youthful offenders,

misdemeanor offenders, and non-penal law offenders are normally eligible for probation sentences.

1975

In 1975, convictions for Criminal Possession and/or Sale of a Controlled Substance 4° (methadone cases) became normally eligible for probation.

1976

On September 1, 1976, a new crime, Criminal Usury 1° (Class C felony), was created and added to the list of those normally ineligible for probation.

1978

Effective September 1, 1978, the laws were amended to include the violent felony and juvenile offender classifications. Upon conviction, juvenile offenders are sentenced to mandatory terms in Division for Youth secure facilities. Violent felony offenders, excluding individuals granted youthful offender status, are also sentenced to mandatory imprisonment. The law affected probation eligibility by mandating prison sentences for certain Class C and Class D violent felonies and specified attempted non-violent B felonies, and by prohibiting plea bargains from VFO to non-VFO charges.

Class C violent felony offenses including attempted Class B violent felony offenses, Assault 1°, Burglary 2°, Robbery 2° and Criminal Possession of Dangerous Weapon 2° are considered to be normally ineligible for probation.

Class D violent felonies including attempted Class C violent felony offenses,* Assault 2°,* Attempted Assault 1°, Sexual Abuse 1° and Criminal Possession of a Dangerous Weapon 3°, are also considered to be normally ineligible for probation except as noted.

*May receive imprisonment plus probation.

The 1978 laws also added Attempted Promoting Prostitution 1° (230.32) and Promoting Prostitution 2° (230.30) as mandatory imprisonment offenses to curb prostitution activities. Criminal Possession and/or Sale of a Controlled Substance 4° (phencyclidine cases) convictions became normally eligible for probation.

1979

In September, 1979, the drug laws were substantially revised, especially in the resentencing area for certain offenders who had received life sentences. A Class B drug felony became a new crime replacing the previous A-III felony drug offense. All PL 220 drug B felonies and A-11 felonies are considered may be eligible for probation where the crime commission date is after August 31, 1979. In addition, the juvenile offender law was amended to provide for youthful offender treatment and probation sentences where appropriate.

1980

The enactment of the so-called gun laws on August 12, 1980 increased the number of violent felony offenses that fall into the normally ineligible category. Such offenses are listed below.

1982

Effective July 1, 1982, Arson 3° was added as a mandatory imprisonment offense and is thus considered to be normally ineligible.
