

1985 Court Commitments to Massachusetts County Facilities for Operating Under the Influence of Alcohol

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Abstract

This report presents a statistical description of individuals committed by the courts to a county correctional facility in Massachusetts for Operating Under the Influence of Alcohol (O.U.I.) during 1985. This report also presents some information on trends in commitments for this offense and some comparative information on the O.U.I. population and county offenders committed for other offenses. Some highlights of the information contained in this report are:

- In 1985 there were 2,118 offenders committed to county facilities for O.U.I. This is an increase of 112 (6 percent) over the 2,006 commitments for O.U.I. in 1984.
- The median sentence length for O.U.I. commitments was 2 months. This is twice the median sentence length of 1984 commitments (1 month). This is more than six times the median sentence length of those committed in 1983 (10 days).
- The 2118 commitments for O.U.I. represent 22 percent of all offenders committed to the counties in 1985. This is similar to 1984 when 21 percent of all commitments were for O.U.I.
- Commitments for O.U.I. varied by county. Commitments ranged from 9 in Dukes county to 517 in Middlesex county. Commitments ranged from 9 percent of all commitments in Suffolk county to 34 percent of all commitments in Norfolk county.
- The typical offender committed for O.U.I. in 1985 was white, 28 years old, male, single and a high school graduate.

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Introduction

Chapter 373 of the Acts of 1982, which became effective on September 1, 1982, increased the certainty and length of punishment for O.U.I. First time O.U.I. offenders are subject to a period of probation supervision which generally includes mandatory attendance in a Driver Alcohol Education Program; second offenders receive a mandatory minimum sentence of seven days or placement in a 14-day residential alcohol treatment program; and multiple repeat offenders receive a mandatory minimum sentence of sixty days.

Continued public interest in the issue of drunk driving along with Chapter 373 had a tremendous impact on the criminal justice system, particularly the county correctional system, in a short period of time. During 1985, 22 percent of all commitments to the county system were for the offense of O.U.I. This report presents a description of this large and important offender group in the county correctional system. The report first presents data on trends in commitments for this offense for the period 1976 to 1985. The report then presents a profile of 1985 commitments for O.U.I. including various characteristics of the present offense and personal background characteristics of these offenders. Comparative information on the O.U.I. offender and offenders committed for other offenses is given as well.

The information is this report was derived from data submitted to the Department by each county correctional facility, collected by the Operations Research Unit of the Department of Correction, and produced on the Regent's Computer Network.

Trends in Commitments for O.U.I.

In this section trends in the number of O.U.I. commitments and length of sentence are explored. Table I shows commitments to county facilities by offense (O.U.I. and non-O.U.I) for the ten-year period 1976 to 1985. The table also shows the percentage of O.U.I. and non-O.U.I. commitments and the percent change from the prior year.

As shown in Table 1, there has been a dramatic increase in commitments to county facilities during this period, from 4,393 in 1976 to 9,511 in 1985, an increase of 117 percent. This increase is true of commitments for both O.U.I. and other offenses. Commitments for offenses other than O.U.I. rose from 4,347 in 1976 to 7,393 in 1985. Commitments for O.U.I. rose more dramatically, from 46 in 1976 to 2,118 in 1985.

The peak year for both total county commitments (9,617) and O.U.I. commitments (2,372) during the ten year period was 1983. The peak year for non-O.U.I. commitments (7,393) was 1985. The last three years, 1983 to 1985 have been relatively stable in terms of the number of O.U.I. commitments, the number of commitments for other offenses and the total number of commitments to the county correctional system.

The data in Table I also demonstrate the continued impact of the O.U.I. population on the county correctional system. During the first six years of the period, O.U.I. offenders accounted for 2 percent of all commitments. During the last four years of the period, O.U.I. offenders accounted for 21 percent of all commitments.

Table 2 shows recent trends in O.U.I. commitments by the county facility to which the offenders were committed. All counties, with the exception of Essex County, experienced an increase in O.U.I. commitments during the period 1982 to 1985. The largest inceases in commitments occurred in Middlesex County (an increase of 252), Norfolk County (an increase of 103), Worcester County (an increase of 94), Bristol County (an increase of 89), Hampden County (an increase of 89), and Plymouth County (an increase of 87).

As shown in Table 2, the O.U.I. population varies by county. In 1982 O.U.I. commitments ranged from 4 percent of Deer Island commitments to 32 percent of Essex County (Lawrence) commitments. In 1985 O.U.I. commitments ranged from one percent of Charles Street commitments to 33 percent of Norfolk county commitments.

Both the number of offenders being admitted and the length of sentence will have an impact on the county correctional system. Table 3 shows the sentence length for offenders committed for O.U.I. for the period 1982 to 1985. During this period the median sentence length increased dramatically, from less than one month in 1982 and 1983 to one month in 1984 and to two months in 1985.

From 1983 to 1985 there has been a shift away from shorter sentences for O.U.I. and a shift towards longer sentences. There has been a 62 percent decrease in seven day sentences, from 882 in 1983 to 334 in 1985; and there has been a 57 percent increase in two month sentences, from 341 in 1983 to 535 in 1985. In 1983, 690 (29 percent) of the O.U.I. offenders received a sentence of two months or longer; in 1984, 931 (46 percent) received a sentence of two months or longer; and, in 1985, 1089 (51 percent) received a sentence of two months or longer.

For a third offender there is a mandatory minimum sentence of 60 days. This suggests that by 1985 half of the O.U.I. offenders committed to the county may be the result of a third conviction for this offense. This trend toward longer sentences is noteworthy because of its likely impact on population in the county

system and because individuals with sentences of two months or more are candidates for the specialized O.U.I. treatment programs offered by W.M.C.A.C. and Longwood Treatment Center.

Thus, the continued high number of admissions for O.U.I. combined with an increase in sentence length will contribute to a substantial impact of this offender group on the population in the county correctional system.

Profile of 1985 O.U.I. Commitments

This section provides information on offenders committed to Massachusetts county facilities during 1985 for O.U.I. and compares this population with other 1985 county commitments. This description includes information on the characteristics of the present offense (month in which committed, institution to which committed, court from which committed, sentence length and sentence type) and personal background characteristics of this offender group (age, race, sex, marital status, education, place of birth and residence). The first set of twelve tables that follow this section show information for the O.U.I. population by the institution to which the offender was committed. The second set of tables provides information on the O.U.I. population in comparison with other offenders.

Upon referring to the tables in this section, the reader should note the following: (1) the total population is sub-divided by committing institution or offense group; (2) the top number in each cell represents the total number of offenders who fall into the corresponding category in that row of the tables; (3) the bottom number in each cell (the number contained in parentheses) is the percentage of the number of individuals in the category to the total number of individuals from that group (column percents). For example, from the table on page 14, Month of Commitment is presented and the following types of information can be obtained:

- (1) The total number of offenders is broken down by commitment institution, and these are labeled and presented horizontally across the top of the table;
- (2) The specific months are labeled and presented vertically;
- (3) Of the 2118 O.U.I. offenders committed during 1985, 517 were committed to Middlesex county;
- (4) Of the 517 offenders committed to Middlesex, 74 (14 percent) were committed in January.

Present Offense Characteristics

<u>Institution.</u> The number of commitments for O.U.I. ranged from a low of 9 in Dukes County to a high of 517 in Middlesex County. Proportionally, commitments for O.U.I. ranged from 9 percent of all commitments in Suffolk County to 33 percent of all commitments in Norfolk County.

Month. The number of O.U.I. commitments ranged from a low of 132 in August to a high of 257 in January. There was an average of 176 commitments for O.U.I. each month.

Sentence. The median sentence length of O.U.I. offenders was two months. Because the law mandates a sentence of at least 60 days for a third or subsequent conviction for O.U.I., this suggests that the typical O.U.I. offender in the county system has at least two prior convictions for this offense. This is less than the median sentence of three months for other offenders.

Four percent of all O.U.I. commitments were in lieu of payment of a fine. This contrasts with 14 percent for other offenses. Fines were used most extensively in Dukes county where 33 percent of all O.U.I. commitments were in lieu of payment of a fine.

With the exception of one O.U.I. commitment to Charles Street Jail, all O.U.I. commitments were to houses of correction. Because this facility had only a single commitment, Charles Street and Deer Island data are presented together as Suffolk County in the following statistical tables.

Eight percent of all O.U.I. commitments were week-end sentences. This contrasts with only 3 percent for other offenses. Week-end sentences were used most extensively in Middlesex county where 18 percent of all O.U.I. commitments were week-end sentences.

<u>Court From Which Committed.</u> Like other offenders, O.U.I. offenders are generally sentenced from a lower court in the county of the facility to which they were committed. Only one percent of all O.U.I. commitments were from Superior Courts.

Personal Background Characteristics

Age. The age of O.U.I. offenders ranged from 17 to 69 years. The median age of this group was 28 years. This is older than other offenders whose median age was 25 years.

<u>Sex.</u> Of the 2,118 O.U.I. commitments in 1985 there were 2,114 males and 4 females. It is important to note that almost all female offenders are committed to the state correctional facility, MCI-Framingham, and thus are not reflected in this analysis. In 1985 there were an estimated 76 females committed to MCI-Framingham for O.U.I.

Marital Status. Most O.U.I. offenders were single (59 percent). Twenty-four percent were married and 17 percent were separated, divorced or widowed at the time of commitment. This contrasts with other offenders where 73 percent were single, 16 percent were married and 11 percent were separated, divorced or widowed.

Education. The median educational level for O.U.I. offenders was 12th grade. This is slightly higher than other offenders whose median educational level was 11th grade. Sixty-two percent of all O.U.I. offenders had at least a high school level education compared with 46 percent of other offenders.

Race. Ninety-two percent of the O.U.I. offenders were white, four percent were black and four percent were hispanic or other races. This contrasts with other offenders who were 76 percent white, 17 percent black and 7 percent other races.

Place of Birth. Seventy-seven percent of all O.U.I. offenders were born in Massachusetts, 15 percent were born in other states, 4 percent in U.S. territories and 4 percent in other countries. This is similar to other offenders.

Residence. Most O.U.I. offenders resided in the same county as the facility to which they were committed. The proportion of same county O.U.I. offenders ranged from a low of 56 percent of Dukes county O.U.I. offenders to a high of 91 percent of Hampden county O.U.I. offenders.

Summary

The typical O.U.I. offender entering the county correctional system was committed from a district court to serve a two month sentence. This individual was a 28 year old, single, white male with a high school education. O.U.I. offenders had somewhat shorter sentences than other offenders (two months vs. three months). The O.U.I. offenders are older on average, more likely to be married or in a state of marital separation. The O.U.I. offender is more likely to be white and to have a higher educational level.
