INTRODUCTION

This report has been developed to provide information regarding selected offender characteristics in each correctional complex, major institution, satellite housing unit and halfway house under the jurisdiction of the New Jersey Department of Corrections as of December 31, 1986. The selected characteristics compiled in this report are Base Offense at Admission, Total Term at Admission, Ethnicity, Age, County of Commitment, and Mandatory Minimum Terms.

The Prison Complex includes the Trenton, Rahway, Leesburg, Mid-State, Southern State, Riverfront and Clinton Men Facilities. The Adult Diagnostic and Treatment Center and Clinton Women, although a part of the Prison Complex, are combined with Newark and Essex House.

The Youth Correctional Complex consists of the Youth Reception and Correction Center-Yardville, the Youth Correctional Institution-Bordentown, and the Youth Correctional Institution-Annandale. The Juvenile Facilities include the Jamesburg Training School for Boys, the Skillman Training School for Boys and Girls, and the Juvenile Medium Security Facility.

On December 31, 1986, there were approximately 1825 State sentenced offenders temporarily housed in County Facilities awaiting transfer into the State Prison System. Characteristic Data on these offenders is not included in this report. Similarly, the 1306 Prison and Youth Reception residents, Juvenile Group Center Residents, and Central Medical Unit residents are not included in these tabulations.

"Not Coded" are records on offenders in the correctional system in which admission characteristic data has not been entered into the computerized information system as of December 31, 1986. Also note (-) represents figures that are less than 5%.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

The preparation of this report entailed the assistance of numerous individuals and reporting units. The extensive data collection effort was significantly enhanced by the assistance of the Correctional Information and Classification Services Data Base, the Prison and Youth Reception Units and the Correctional Institutions that report data to the Data Base daily. Special acknowledgement is given to Mrs. Terry Lihvarcik, Principal Statistical Clerk of the Correctional Information and Classification Services Central Office Report Preparation Unit, for the compilation of data and the layout of the report format.

#### HIGHLIGHTS

Sixty-six percent (66%), or 4928 out of 7412, of all offenders in the Prison Complex were committed for crimes against persons, which include Homicide, Sexual Assault, Assault, Robbery, Sodomy, Sexual Abuse and Other Person Offenses. Sixty-two percent (62%), or 7669 out of 12,303, of all New Jersey Offenders were committed for Crimes Against Persons. These figures reflect base or controlling offense at admission, only, and do not include offenses in addition to the base offense in the case of multiple sentences at admission, nor are additional sentences imposed following initial admission to the State Correctional System included in this data.

One out of two or 6033 out of 12,303 of all New Jersey Offenders were committed with a maximum statutory sentence of 10 years or more. Of these, 647 offenders or 5% are serving Life Sentences and 23 offenders are serving Capital Sentences.

Fifty-nine percent (59%) of New Jersey's Offender population is black, while 27% are white and 14% are Hispanic.

Fifty-six percent (56%) of all Offenders in the New Jersey Department of Corrections are under 29 years of age.

Of the 21 New Jersey counties, five counties (Essex, Passaic, Camden, Monmouth, and Union) contribute more than half (57%) of Total State Correctional Commitments. Essex County is the highest contributor with twenty-two percent (22%).

Fifty-three percent (53%) of the offenders housed in the Prison Complex have mandatory minimum sentences.

OFFENDERS IN NEW JERSEY CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS  
ON DECEMBER 31, 1986 BY BASE OFFENSE

In these tabulations, the Base Offense for an offender is that which is the most serious offense at the time of admission. These figures reflect base or controlling offense at admission, only, and do not include offenses in addition to the base offense in the case of multiple sentences at admission, nor are additional sentences imposed following initial admission to the State Correctional System included in this data.

Violent Crimes include homicide, sexual assault, aggravated assault, robbery, and other sex offenses i.e. incest, carnal abuse, sodomy and impairing the morals of a minor.

Other Persons Offenses include simple assault, weapons offenses, coercion, larceny from a person and negligent manslaughter.

Property Offenses include arson, breaking and entering, theft, forgery, embezzlement, auto theft and receiving or possessing stolen property.

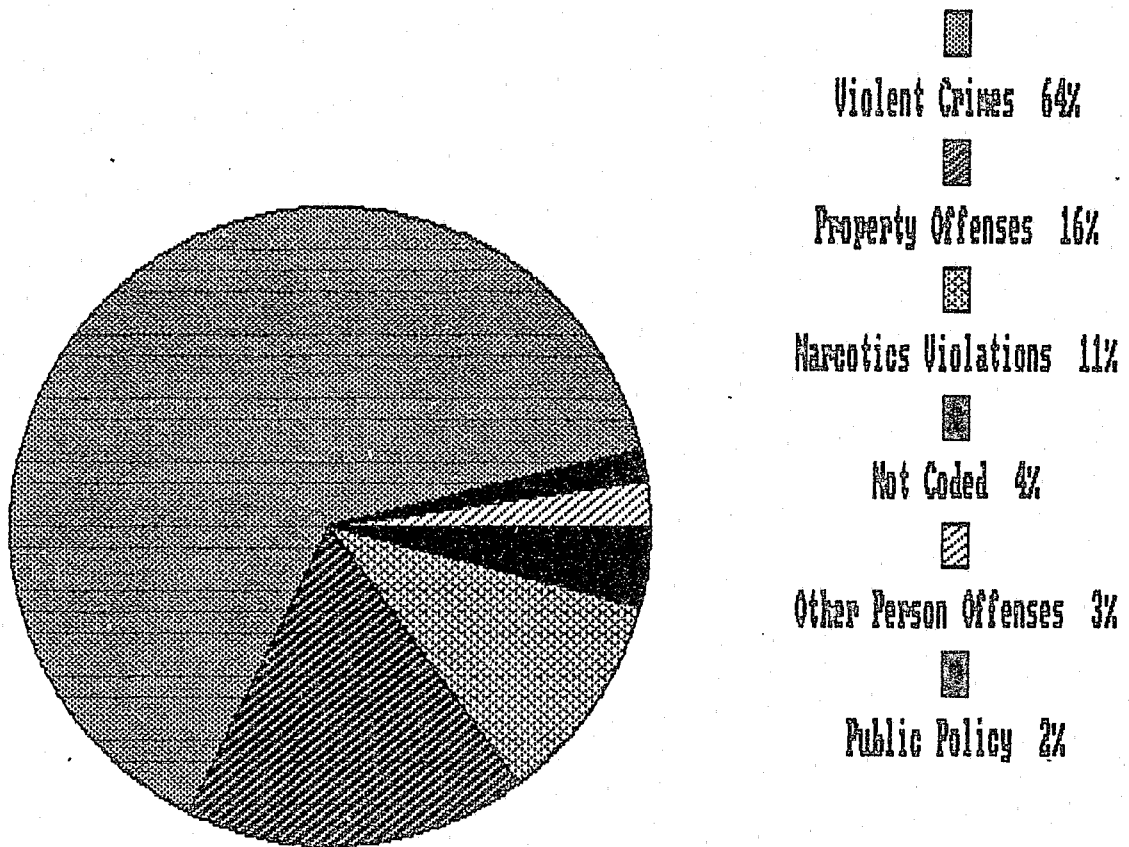
Public Policy Offenses include racketeering, gambling, prostitution, corruption, perjury, escape, bail jumping, juvenile or family related offenses and conspiracy.

Narcotics Violations include distribution, manufacture and possession/use of drugs.

More than 27% of violent crime offenders in the Prison Complex have been convicted of homicide.

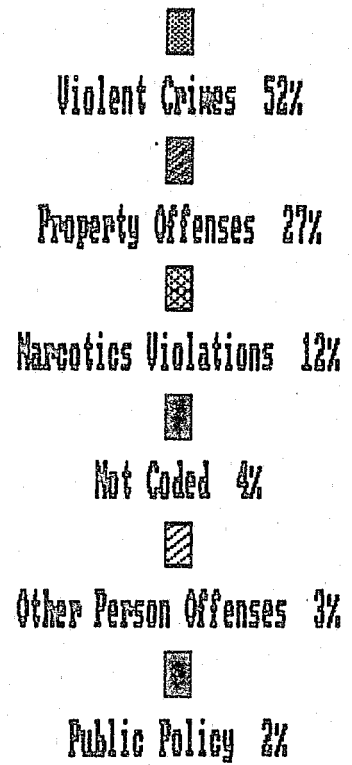
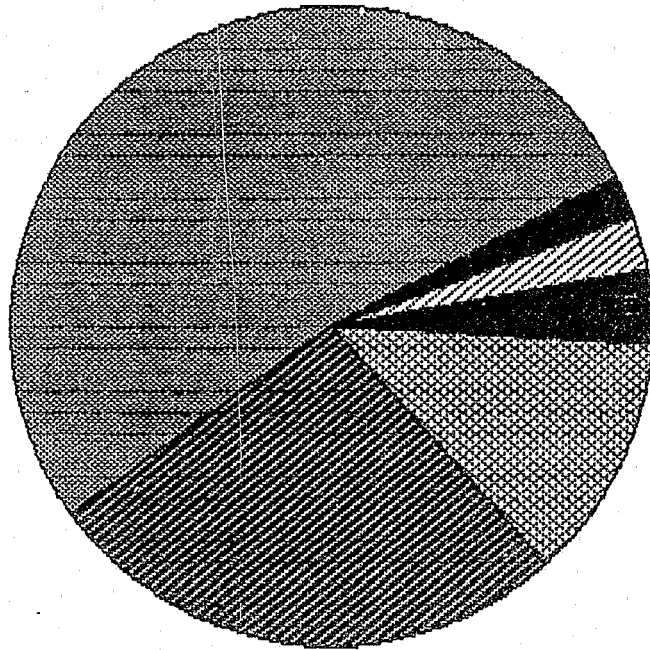
Almost one third (32%) of all offenders at Trenton Prison have been convicted of homicide.

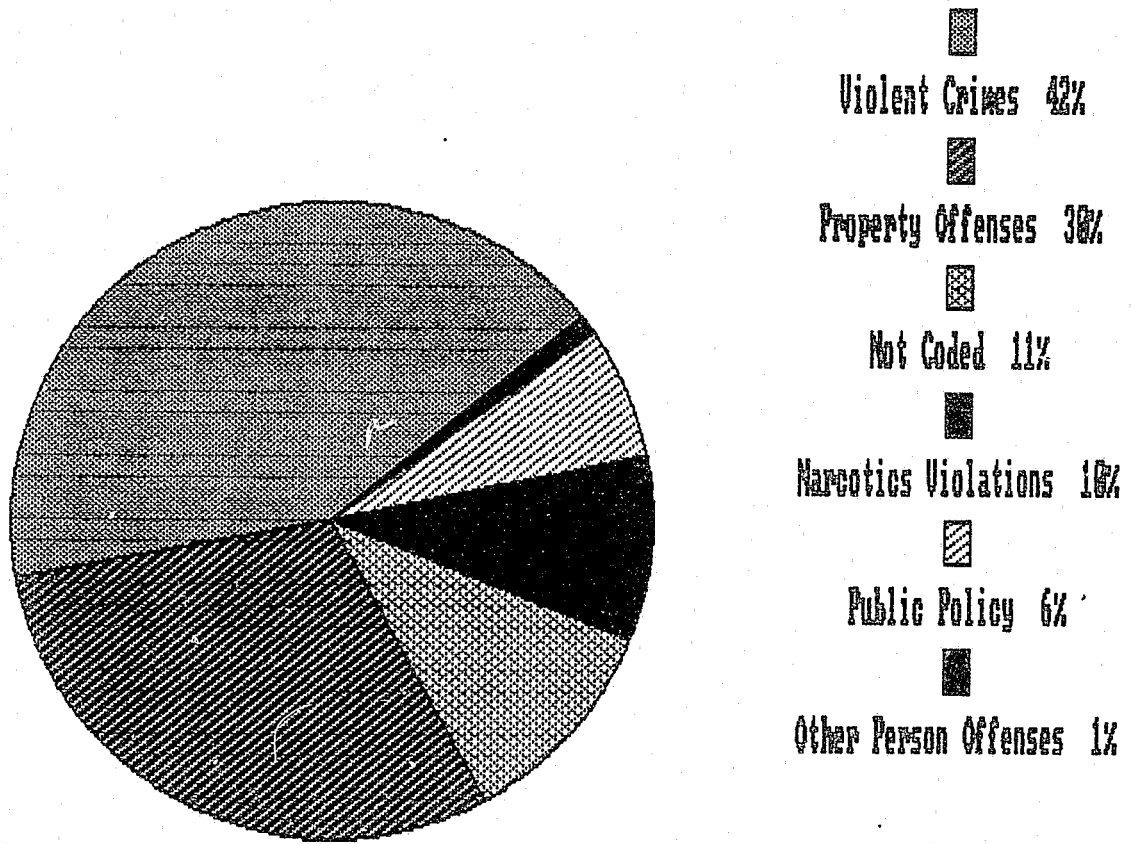

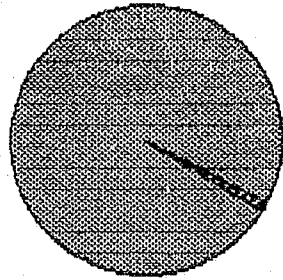

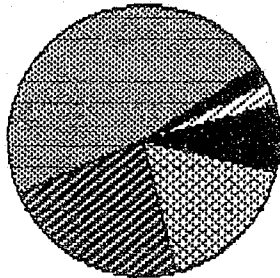

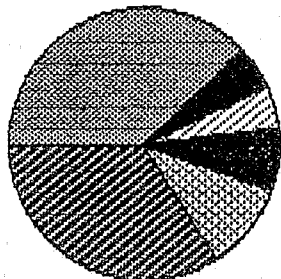

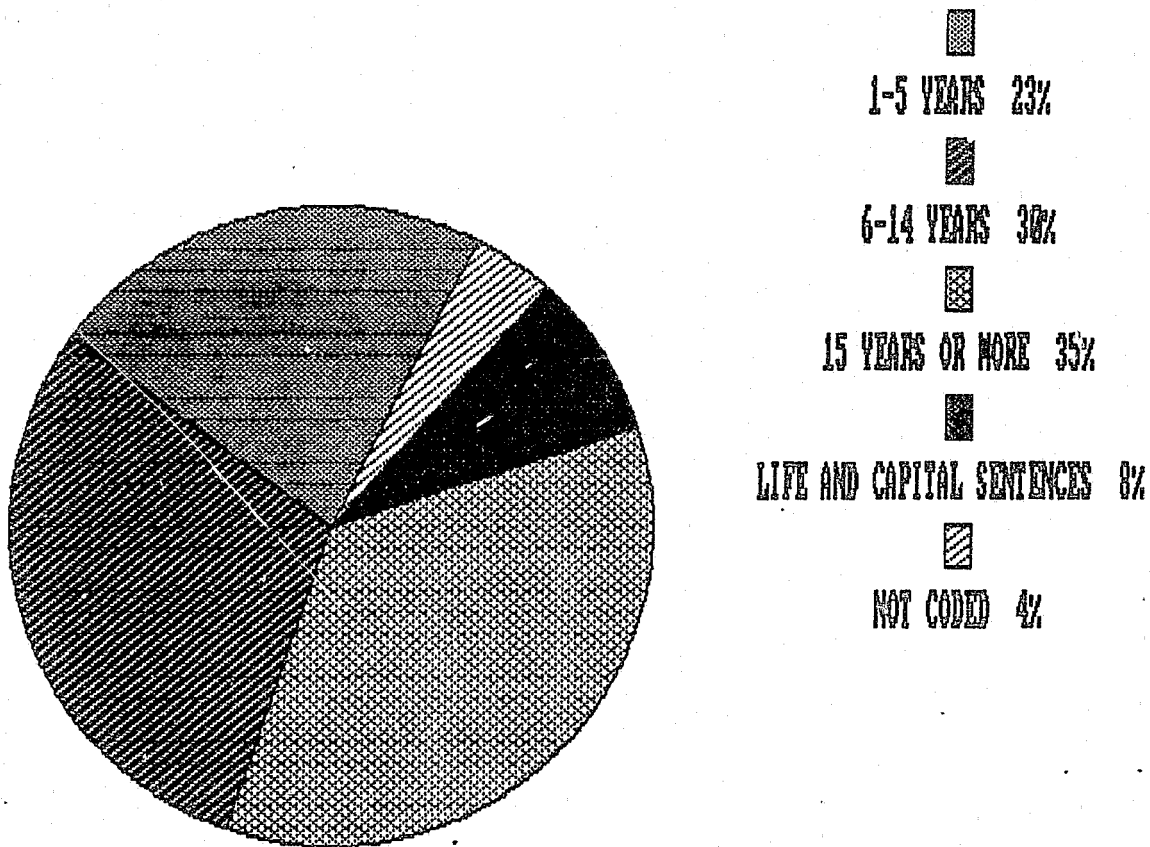

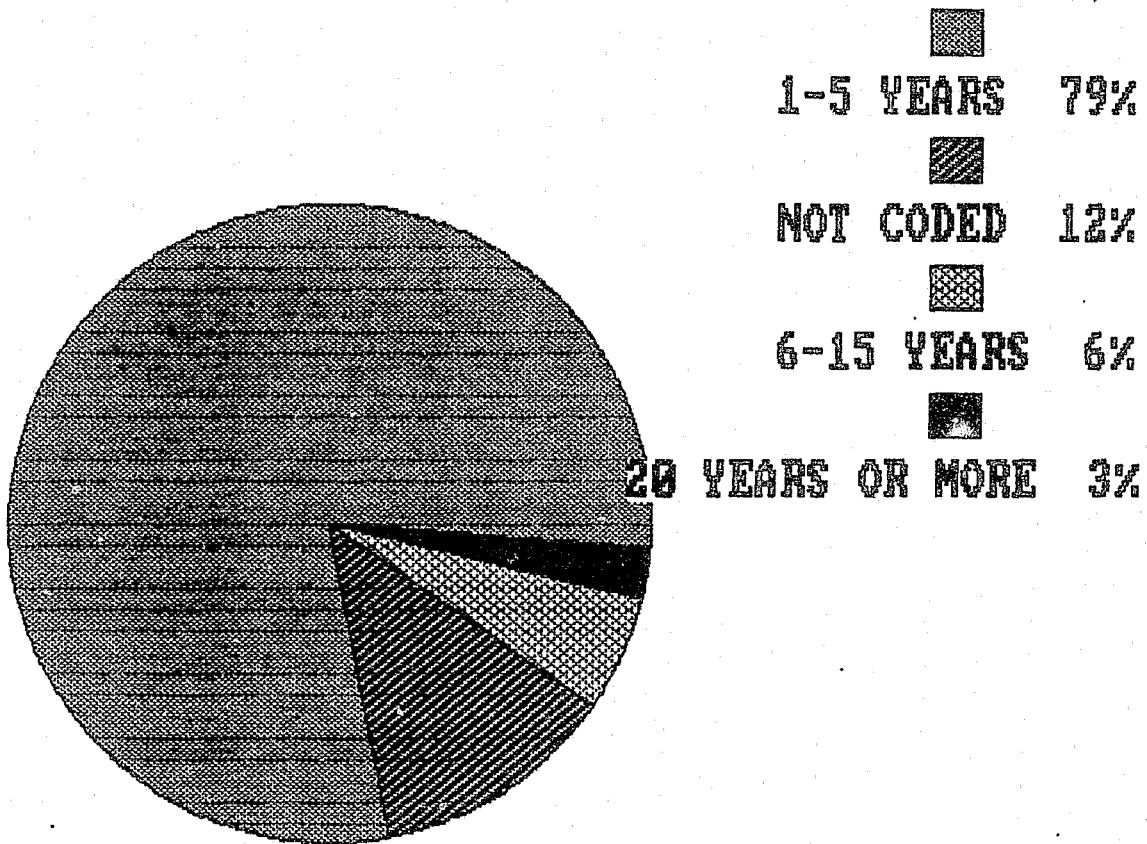

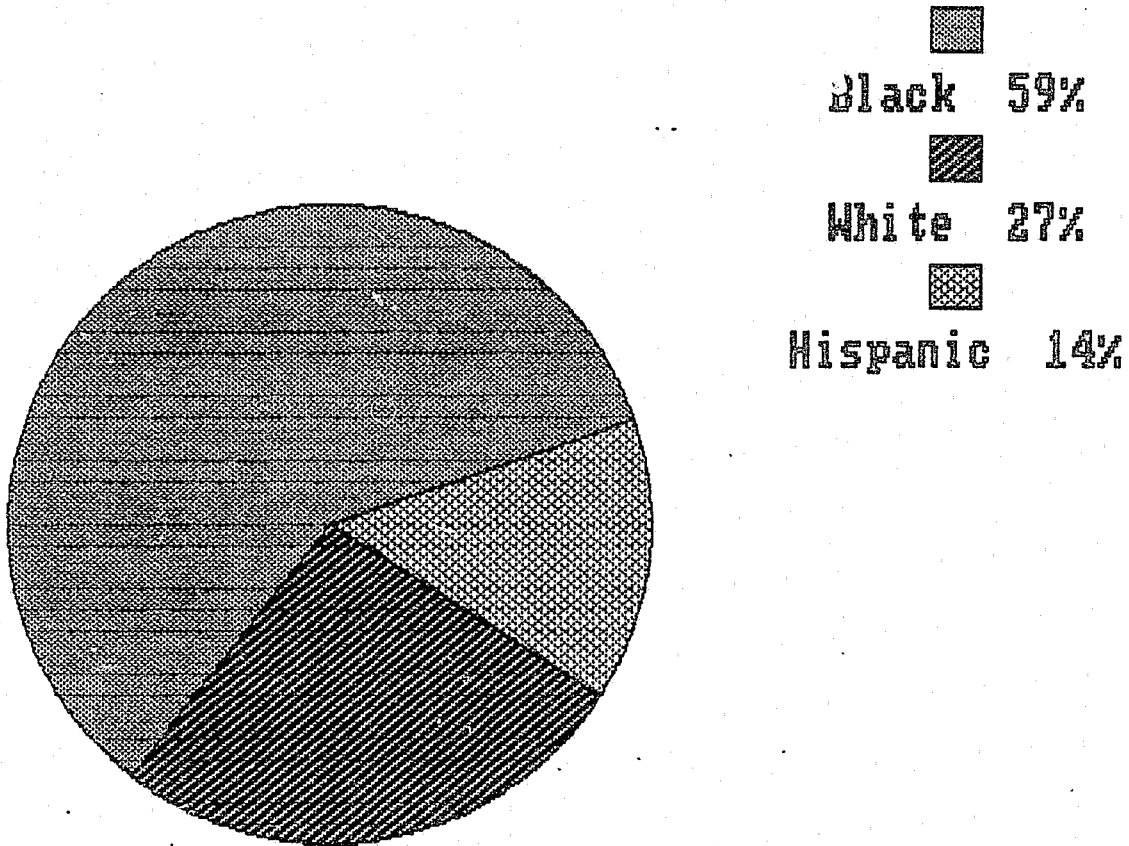

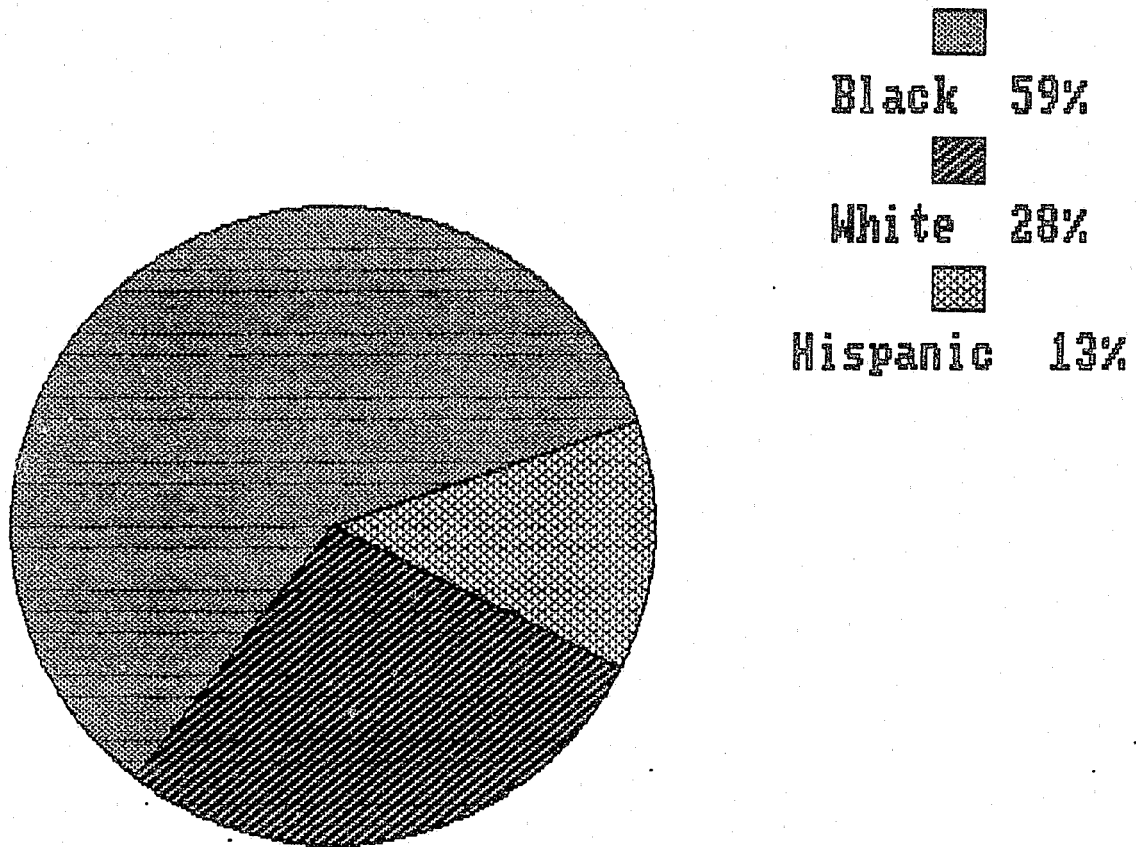

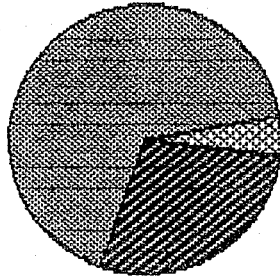

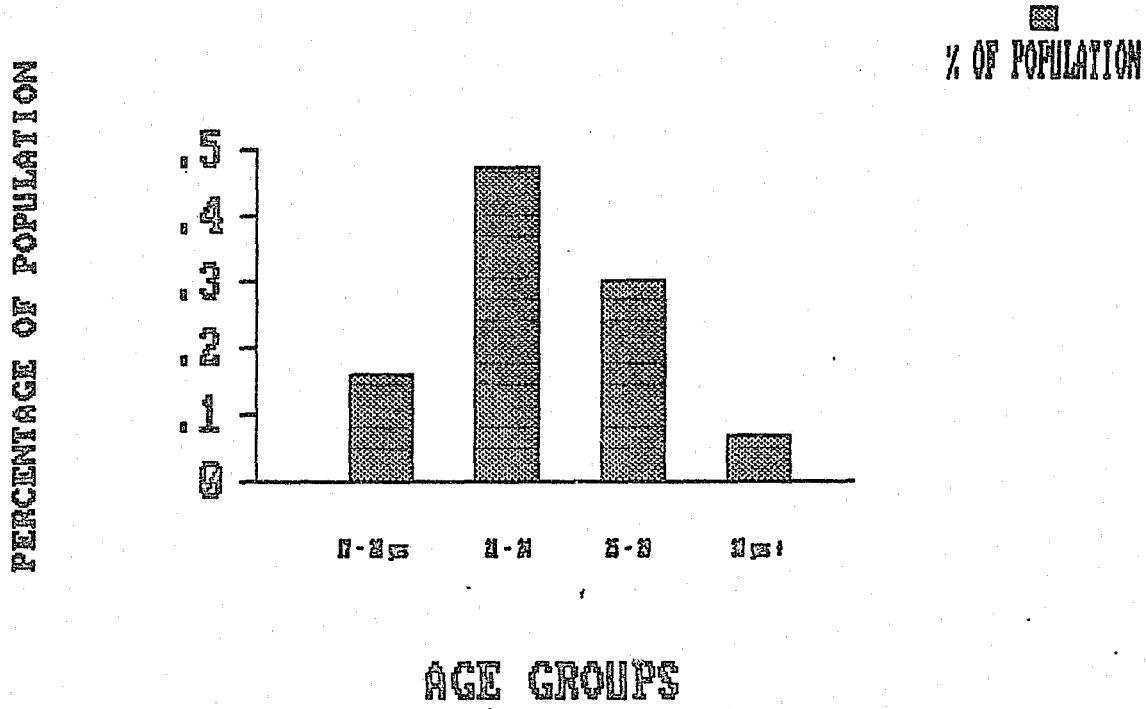

Twenty-six (26%) of Prison Complex offenders are aged 25-29. This figure is very similar for the various units throughout the complex. Exceptions include Clinton Men's Unit, where the majority of offenders are over 50 years of age, and the Vroom Readjustment Unit with only 50% aged 29 or younger.

# YOUTH COMPLEX ON DECEMBER 31, 1986



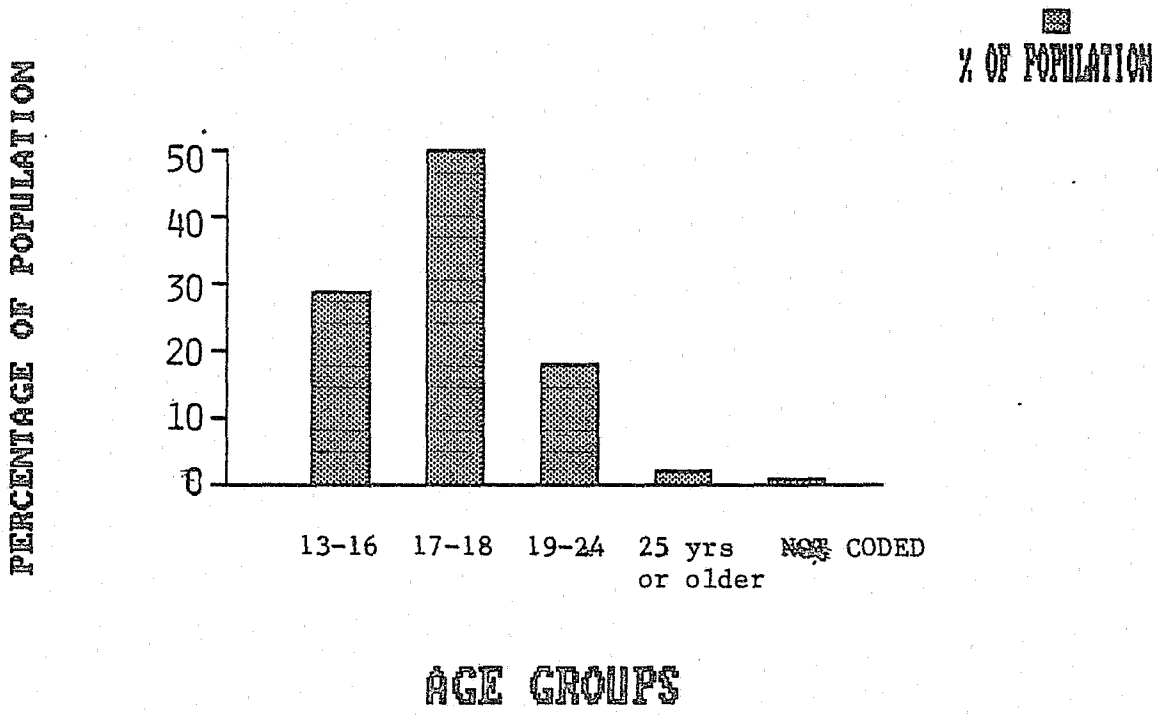

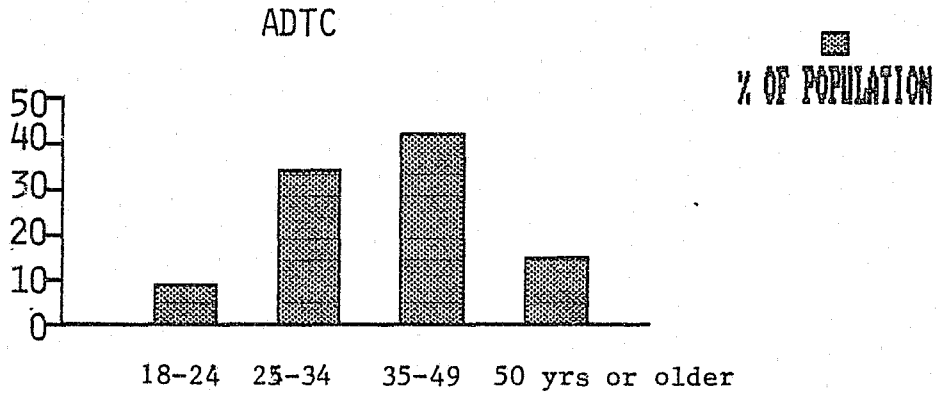

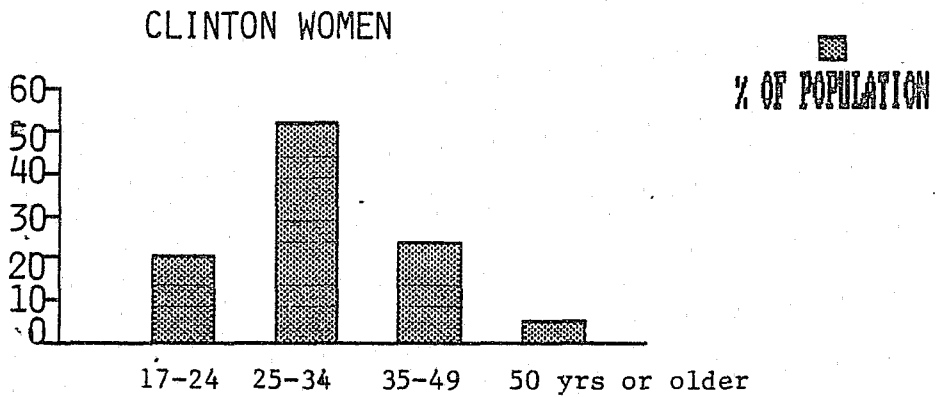

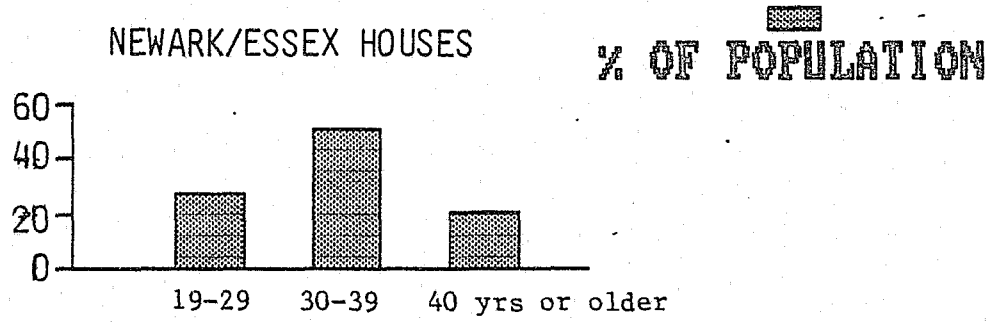
PERCENTAGE OF POPULATION

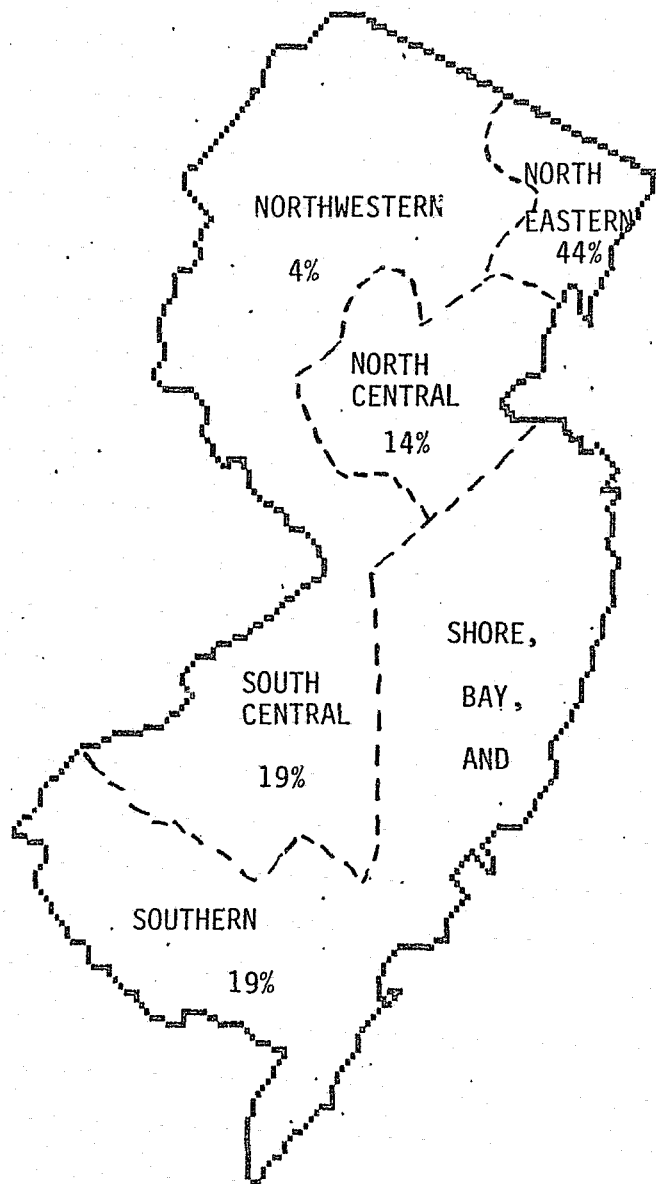

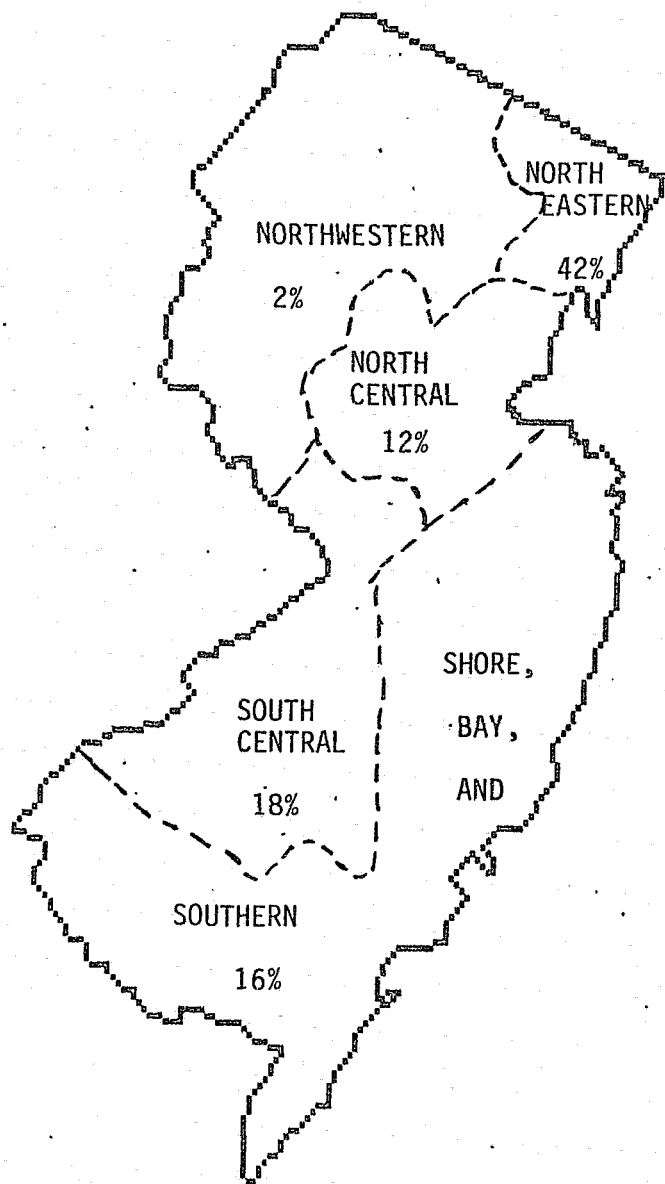

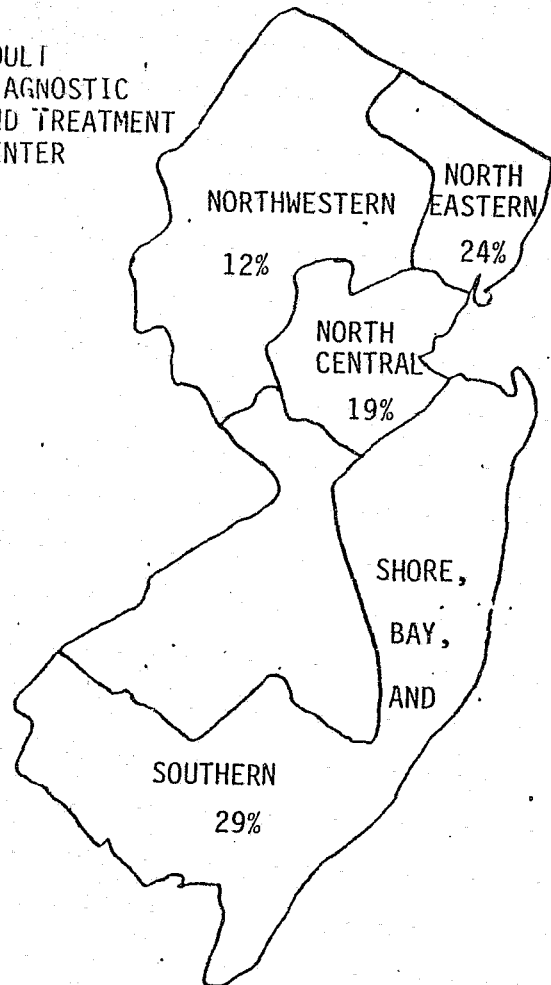

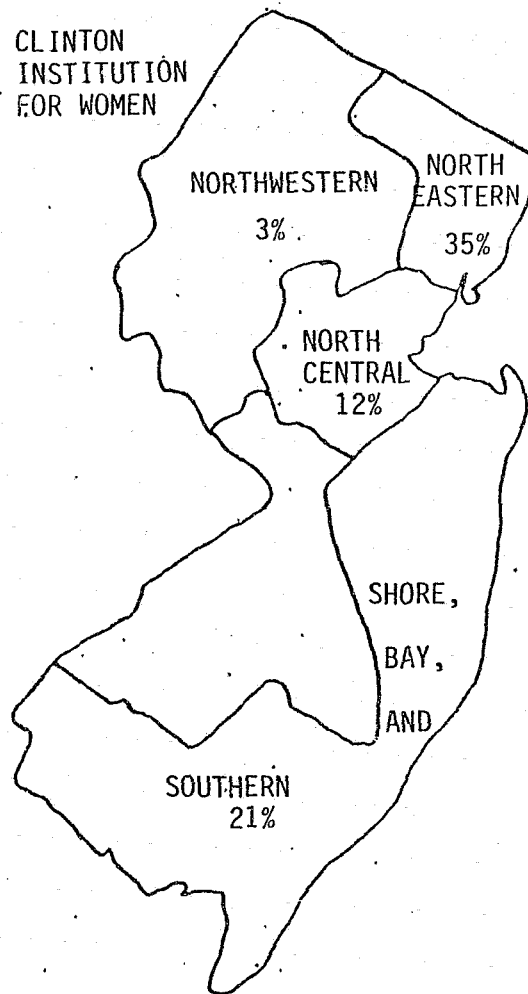

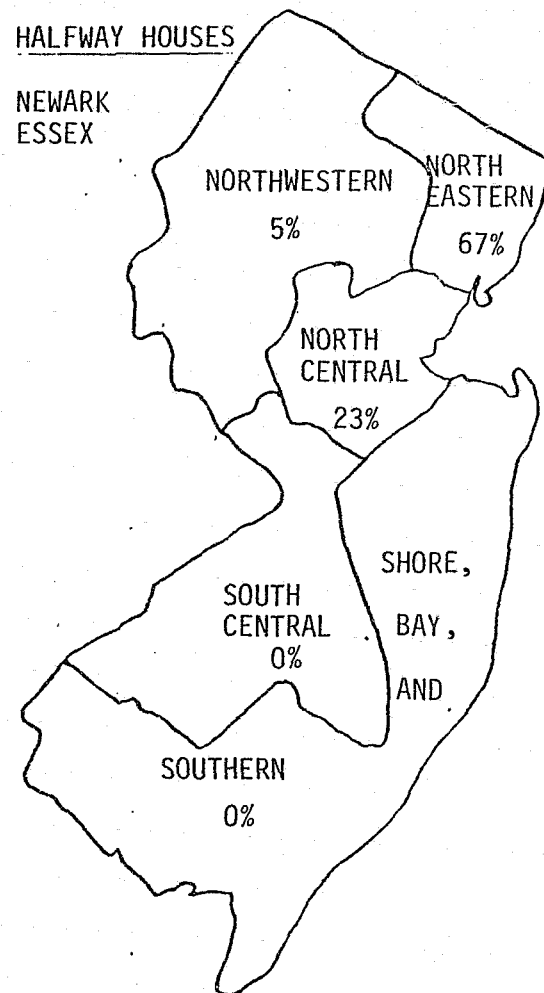

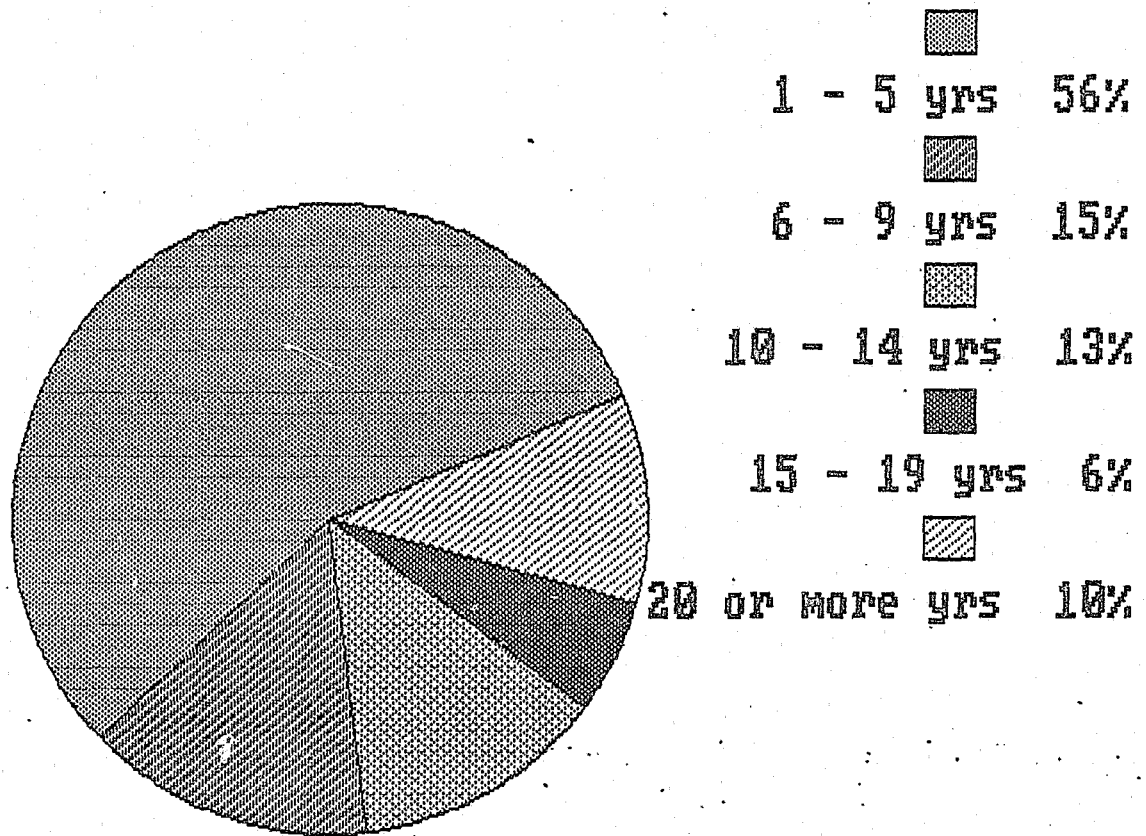

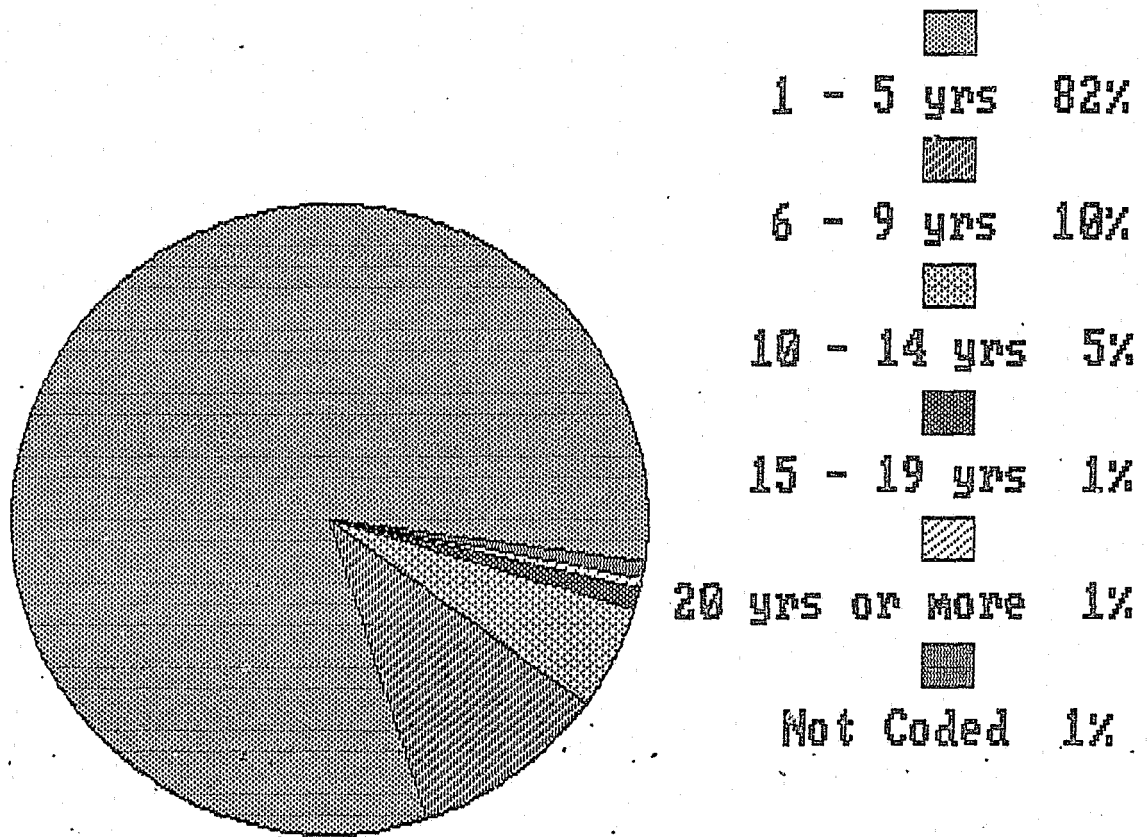
