INTRODUCTION

The 1986 Nebraska Jail Population Report presents data collected by and reported to the Jail Standards Division of the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice. It describes prisoners held in city and county jails during calendar year 1986. All jails in Nebraska are represented in this report except for the Omaha City Jail, Douglas County Corrections, and Lancaster County Corrections.

The Nebraska Revised Statutes 83-4, 192 (1981 Cum. Supp.) calls for the establishment of a "standardized records and statistical system for criminal detention facilities." Accordingly, the Jail Standards Board established a requirement for local jails to utilize a standardized admission and release form and to submit copies to the Jail Standards Division upon processing. A copy of this form is included on the following page. This document serves as the source document for information for the statewide database used by the Nebraska Crime Commission. The three above-named facilities employ in-house automated information systems and are therefore exempt from the reporting requirement.

The information provides demographic statistics as well as jail use and prisoner flow on a statewide and local level. It must be remembered that inmates in Douglas and Lancaster counties account for approximately half of the total number of inmates in the state. Since they are not included in the report, these statistics reflect the jail population outside these metropolitan areas.

Further information or information more specific to given data or particular facilities and agencies may be available, upon request, from the Jail Standards Division.

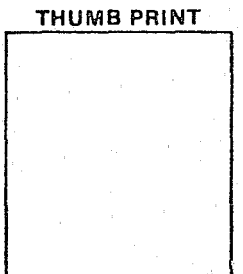

Section I: Nebraska City and County Jails

For the purpose of determining applicability of Standards, local jail facilities are categorized as follows: Type I Holding Facilities (with a 24 hour limit) and Type II Holding Facilities (with a 96 hour limit) serve primarily to detain persons awaiting initial court appearances on criminal charges, while Type III Detention Facilities are typically used to confine either pretrial or sentenced inmates. Most county jails are designed as Type III Detention Facilities. The city jails and some smaller county facilities operate as either Type I or II Holding Facilities.

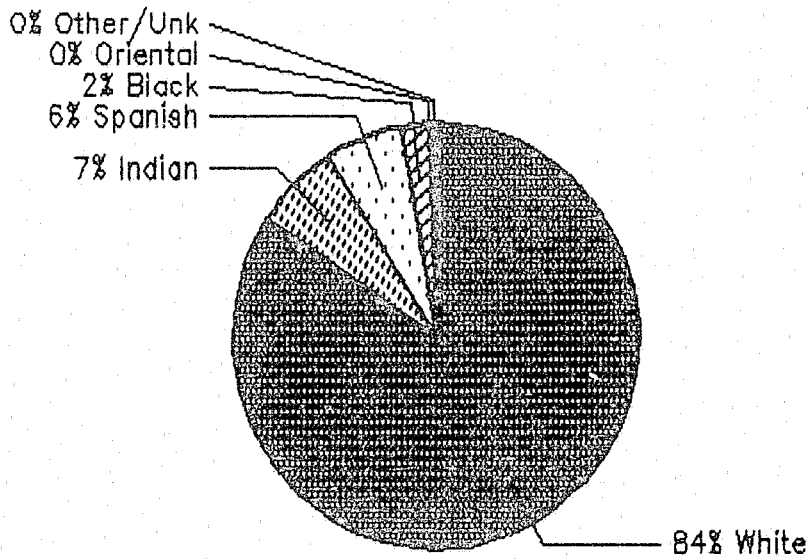

Whites accounted for the largest percentage of admissions for 1986. These numbers are approximately the same as past years.

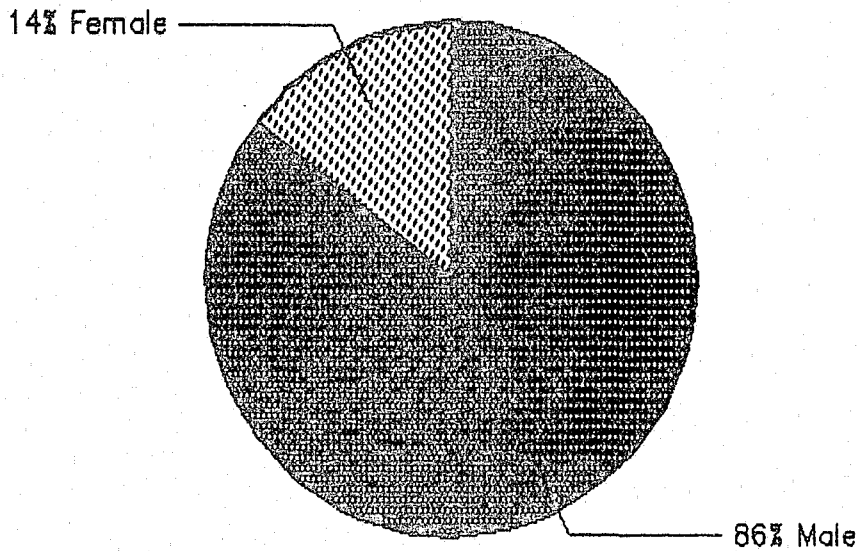

Males accounted for 85.5% of those held in jails outside of Douglas and Lancaster counties. The percentages of males, females, and total juveniles admitted were all within 1% of the figures for 1986. The main difference occurred in the breakdown of the juvenile population. Females were 29.6% of the juveniles in 1986, which is a 7% reduction from the previous year. This proportional change also occurred from 1984 to 1985. The adult population breakdown remained basically the same.



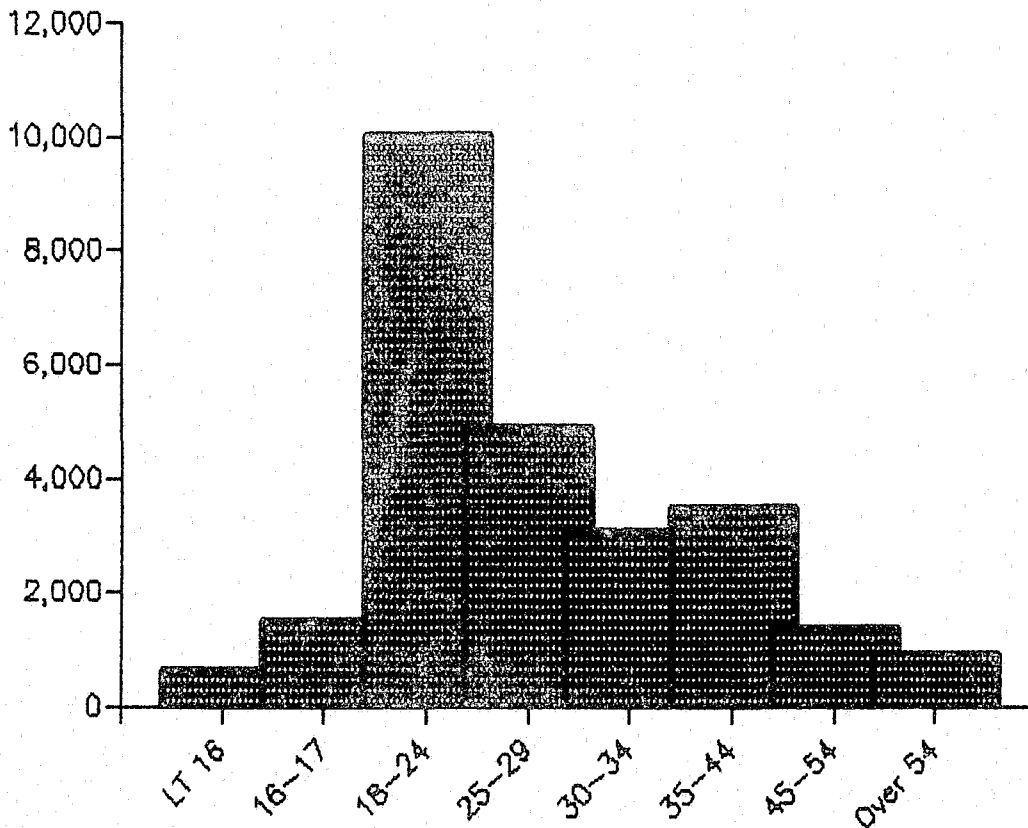

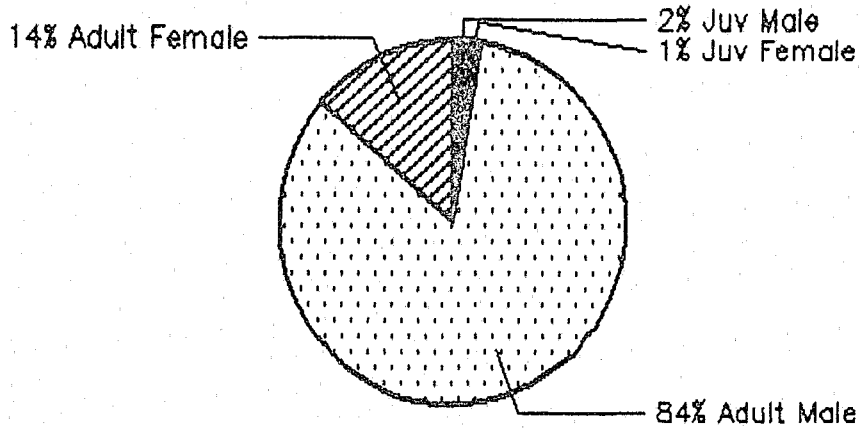

In this case, "Juvenile" is taken as under 16. This parallels the proscribed sight and sound separation requirement.

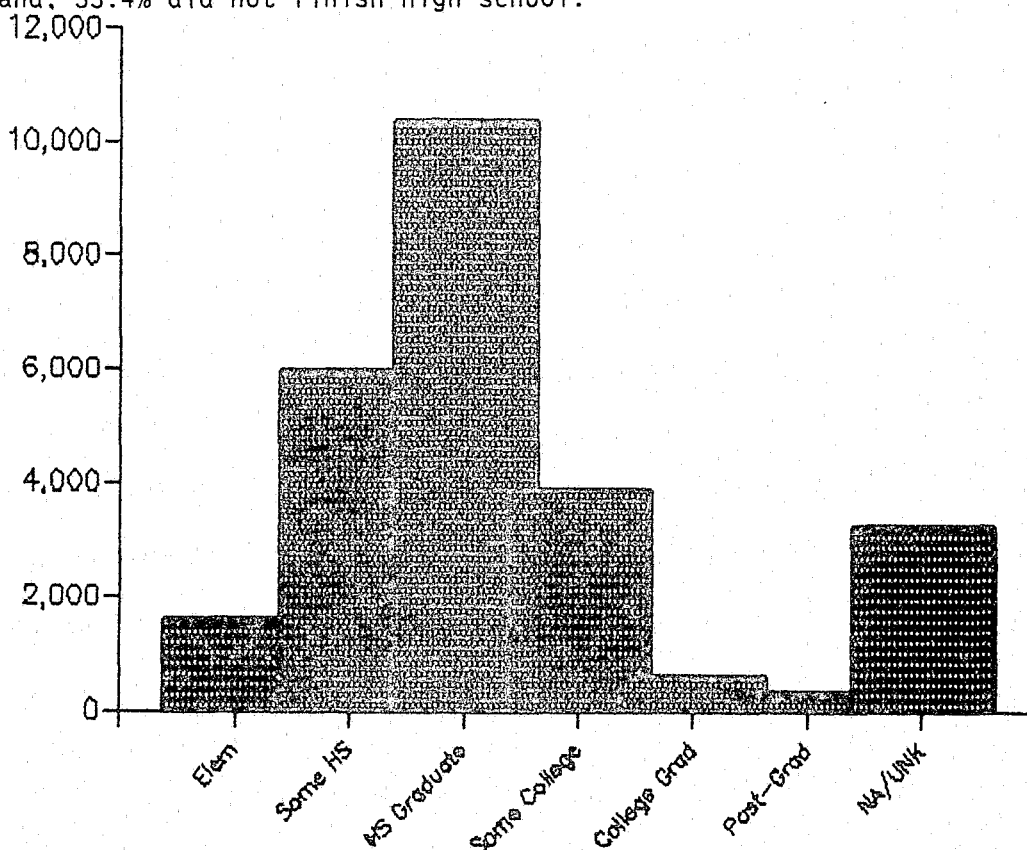

Of those admitted and for whom information was available, 66.6% had at least a high school education, of whom 21% had some college. On the other hand, 33.4% did not finish high school.

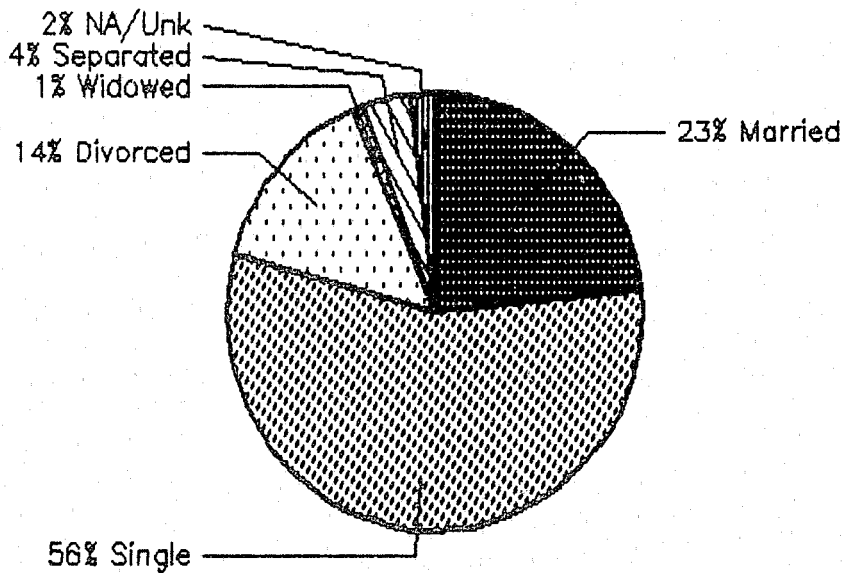

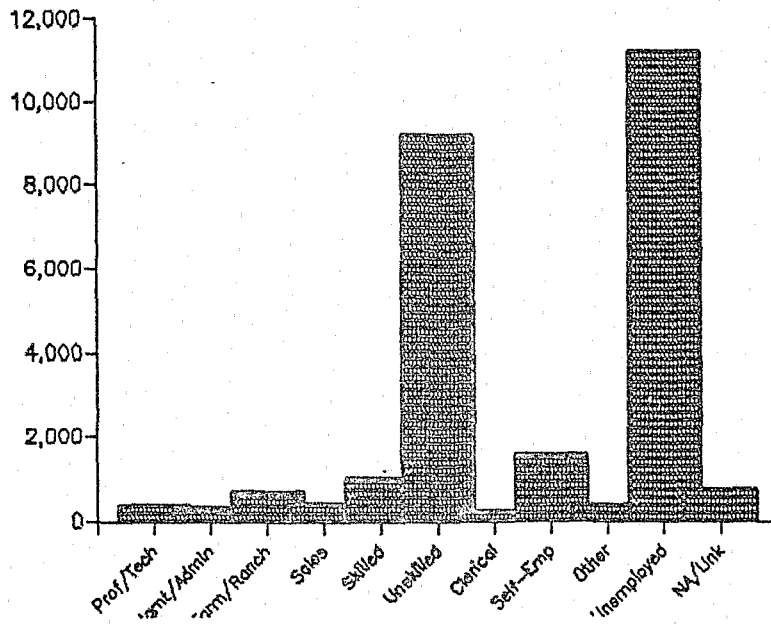

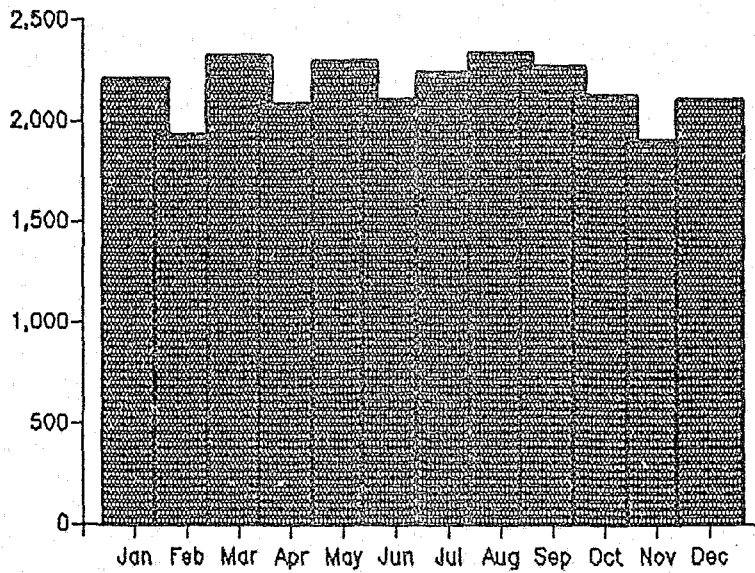
Those unemployed accounted for 43.2% held in jails as compared to 37.2% in 1985. The given occupations of those admitted have not changed much since 1984. The only significant differences being skilled labor dropped from 8.8% to 3.8% and unskilled labor increased from 31.4% to 35.5%. The figure for unemployed rose 1.7%. These changes followed those of 1985.

Admissions were fairly steady during the year with the peak being in August and the low being in February.

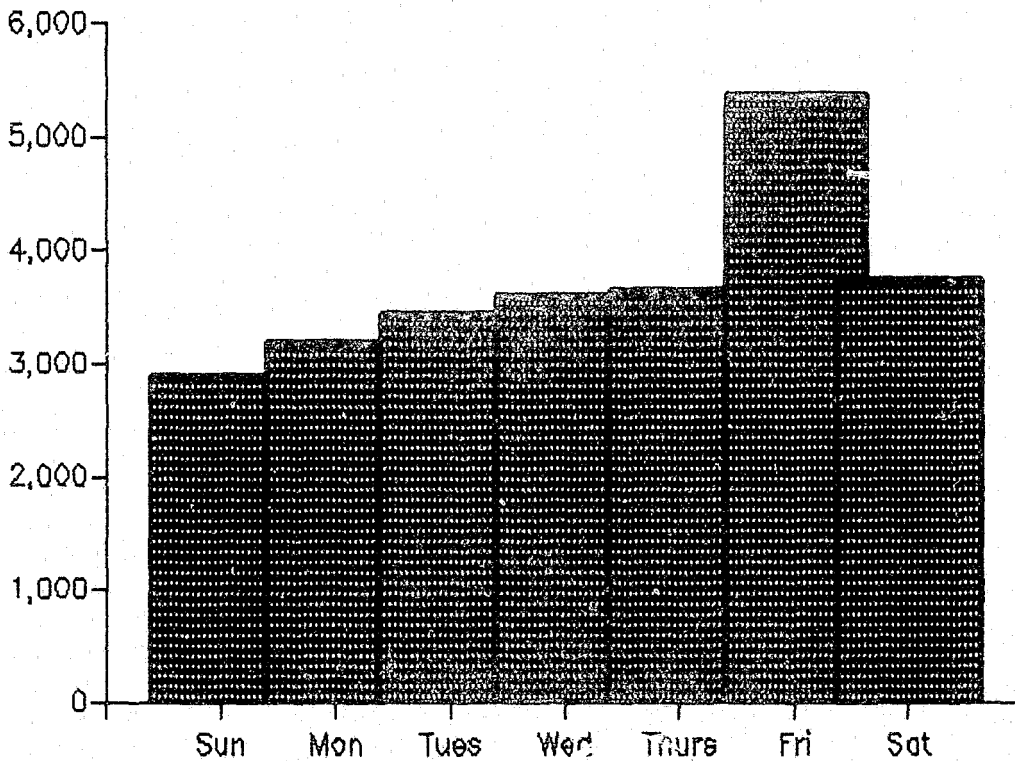

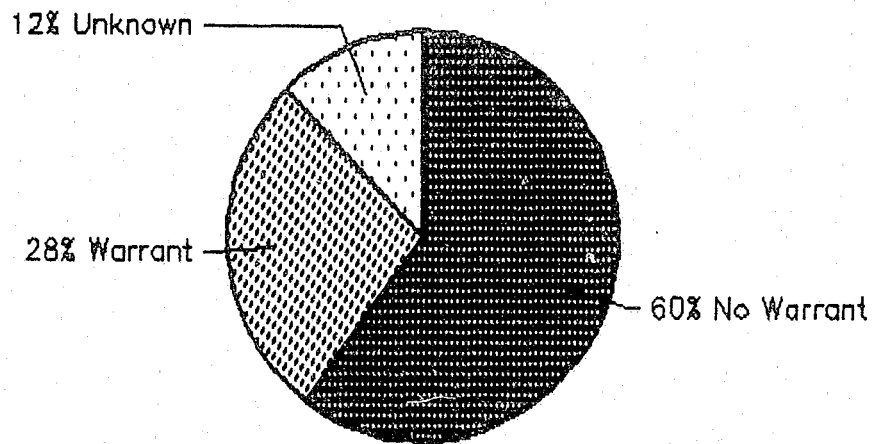

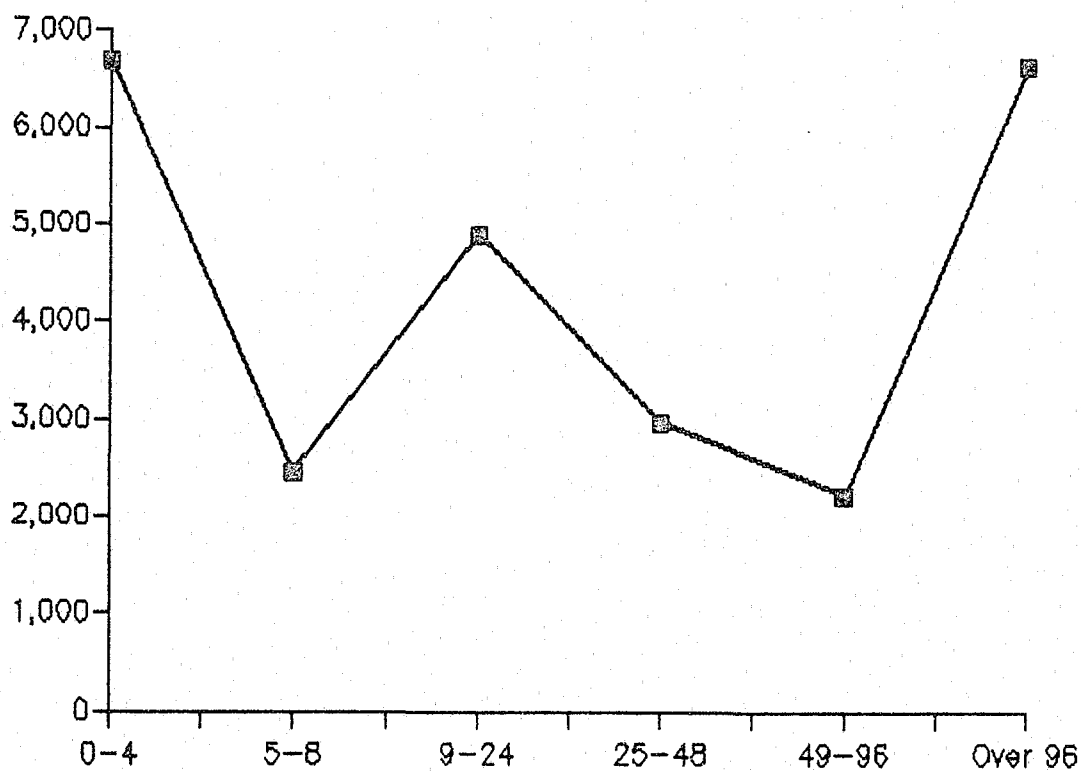

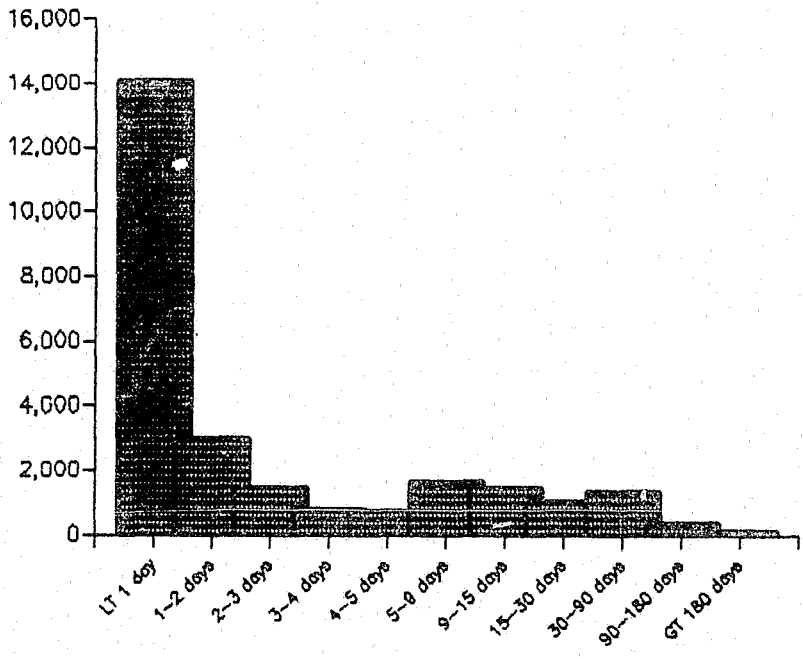

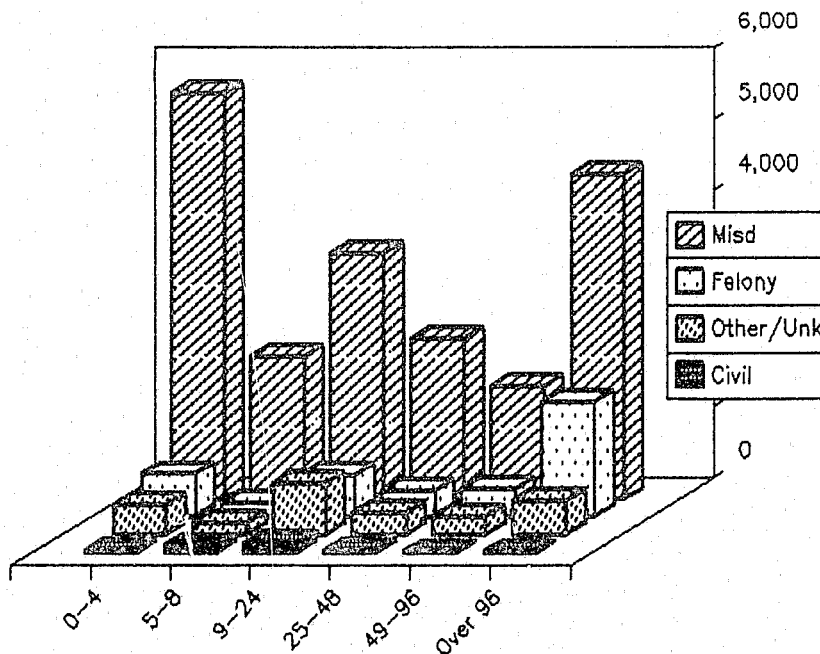

Those released fell into two major categories. Sentences were completed for 21.1% while 40.1% were released on bond. Detainees released to some authority accounted for 12.8%.



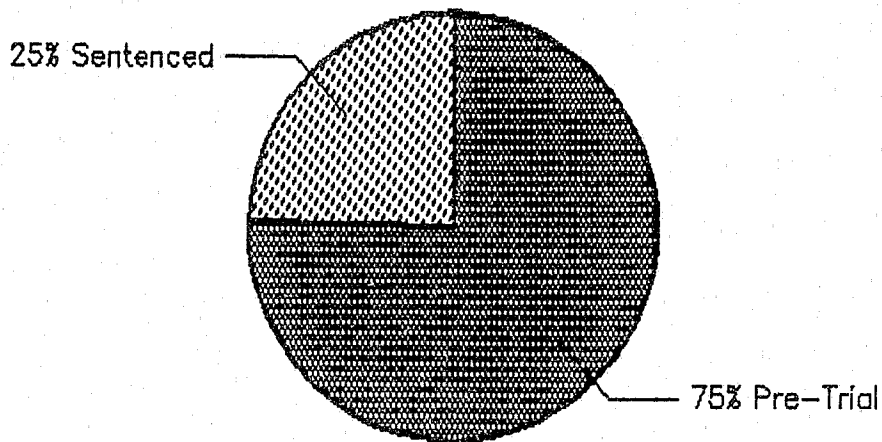

As the next table shows, the number of admissions was not consistent with time served.

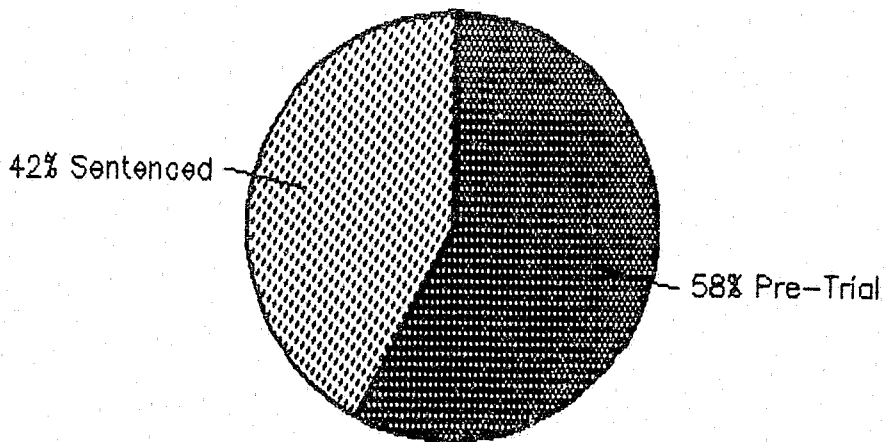

Although 75.4% of those admitted were pretrial, they accounted for 57.6% of the total days served. Those sentenced averaged 16.7 days and those in pretrial averaged 7.6 days. These are both increases of 1.6 days over last year. This yielded a total of 251,420 days served. This was a 16.5% increase from 1985.



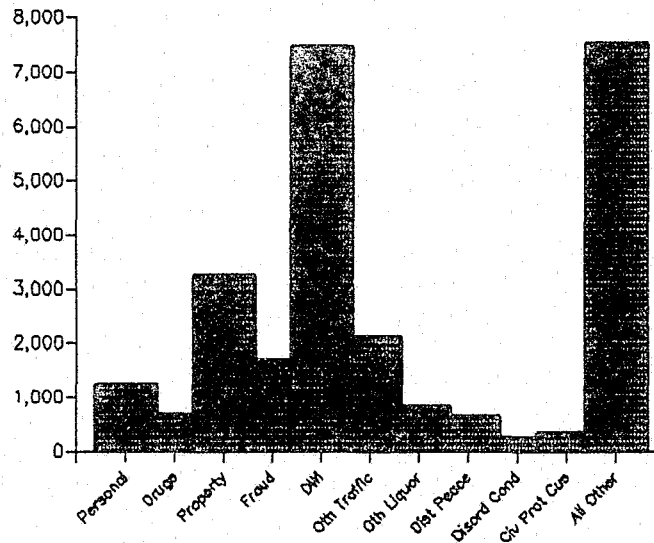

By far the most common category of offense was for DWI at 28.8%, a 1.9% decrease from 1985. The next most common were property crimes (12.5%).

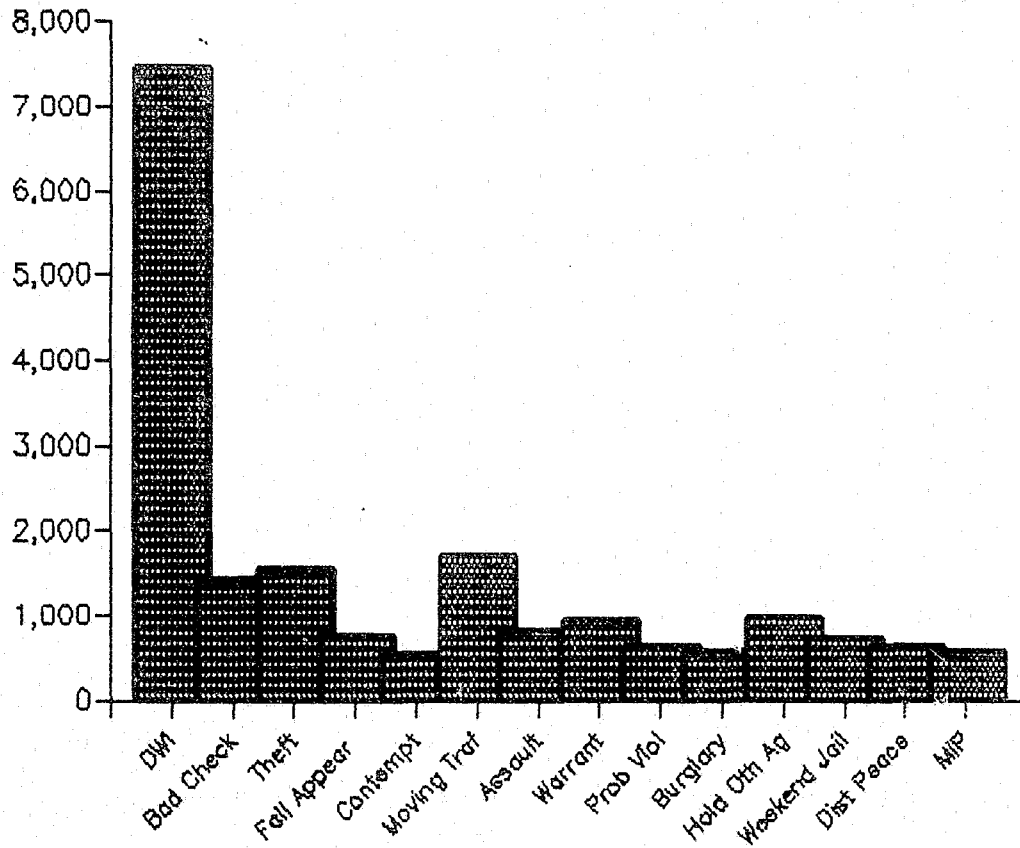
