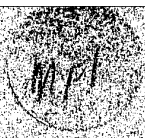

APPENDIX: Procedure and Definitions Used in Creating the Abstract

Issues published: Two annual issues (fiscal-year and calendar-year) and two quarterly issues (January-March, July -September) are published each year.

Coverage: Persons placed onto supervised parole, supervised probation, and certain cases of deferred prosecution. Excluded are unsupervised paroles, and persons given suspended sentences without probation supervision.

Conditions causing a person to be counted in the Abstract:

Section 1- Entries onto supervision. Includes persons whose supervision began during the period covered by the report. Persons already under supervision but who received a new case during the period are not counted as new entries. The case-begin and case-end dates are used to determine this. If the offender has more than one case, then the "initiation case" (the earliest of the cases beginning in the period covered) is used to determine crime, county, etc.)

Section 2- Removals from supervision. Includes persons whose supervision ended during the period due to expiration of their term (completion), early termination, revocation, or death (but not by absconding or deferral).

Section 3- Supervised population at year-end. Counts only persons who had one or more active cases on the last day of the period (even if on deferred or suspended status). This group of reports thus provide a "snapshot" of the population under supervision on one day.

Definitions of terms (Column headings and row labels)

Probation/parole dual (Reports 1A,1B,1C,1D,1E,1F,2A,3A,3B,3C, 3D)

Intensive probation/dual. Includes all clients supervised in-state under intensive supervision with a probation case. Some of these may be dual supervision (i.e. have both a probation and a parole case)

Total probation/dual. Includes all probation and dual supervision clients supervised in-state. Also includes clients already counted as intensive probation/dual.

Intensive parole/dual. Includes parole intensive cases and dual supervision intensive cases, including those dual cases already counted under intensive probation/dual.

Total parole dual. Includes all parole and dual supervision clients supervised in-state. Also includes clients already counted as intensive parole/dual.

Total clients in-state. Includes parole, probation, and dual cases, whether or not intensive. It is not the sum of previous columns, because a client can appear in more than one of them but can only be counted once in this column.

All clients (includes out-of-state). All probationers and parolees whether supervised in North Carolina or not.

Supervision length (Report 1B). The supervision period imposed by the court.

Crime (Reports 1C,2C,3B,3G,3H,3I). If more than one crime, then the most serious one based on the length of the maximum imposed prison sentence.

County of Conviction (Reports 1D,3C,3H,3J) The county associated with the crime, as described above.

Supervision level.

A. Entries (Report 1A) The initial supervision level assigned, usually based on the offender's first assessment. If the supervision period begins as an intensive case then the offender is counted as being in the intensive supervision level.

B. Removals and C. Under supervision (Reports 2B,3A,3F, 3K) The supervision level at the time the Abstract was generated (Note: each of these reports is in two parts. One part includes just probation and dual cases; the other just parole and dual.)

Time under supervision (Reports 2D,2E) The total time the offender was under requirement for supervision, from the first case-begin date to the last completion or termination date, including time spent in deferred or suspended status.
