

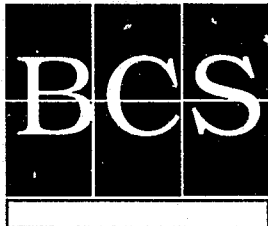

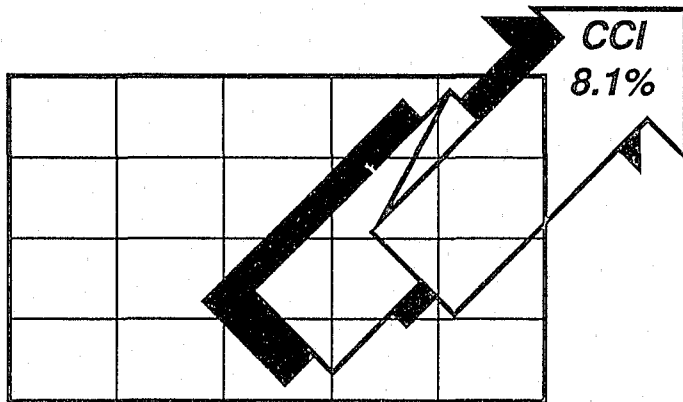

CRIME 1989 IN SELECTED CALIFORNIA LAW ENFORCEMENT JURISDICTIONS JANUARY THROUGH JUNE

This report compares preliminary counts of crimes reported by 49 of the 51 California law enforcement agencies serving populations of 100,000 or more for the first six months of 1989 with those of the same period in 1988. This crime information represents approximately 64 percent of the total crime information reported in the state. **Data used in this report are not adjusted by population.** Statewide adjusted data (rates) appear in annual *Crime and Delinquency in California* publications.

NCJRS

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The **CALIFORNIA CRIME ACQUISITIONS INDEX (CCI)** offenses are willful homicide, forcible rape, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, and motor vehicle theft. In the first six months of 1989, the number of reported offenses was up 8.1 percent from the same period in 1988.

HIGHLIGHTS

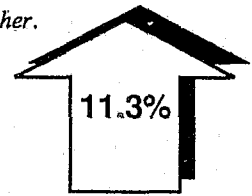
- The largest increase was in motor vehicle theft crimes (15.5 percent).
- Only forcible rape crimes decreased (2.9 percent).
- Thirty-four of the selected agencies reported increases in the total California Crime Index offenses.

The CALIFORNIA CRIME INDEX



WILLFUL HOMICIDE - *The willful (nonnegligent) killing of one human being by another. Murder and nonnegligent manslaughter are included.*

The number of willful homicides reported for the first six months of 1989 increased 11.3 percent compared to the same period in 1988.



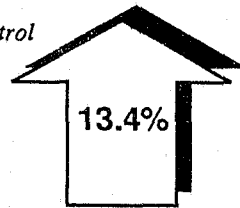
FORCIBLE RAPE - *The carnal knowledge of a female forcibly and against her will. Assaults or attempts to commit rape by force or threat of force are included.*

Forcible rapes reported decreased 2.9 percent in the first half of 1989 compared to the same period in 1988.



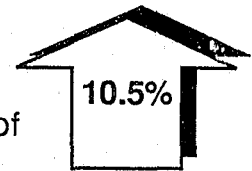
ROBBERY - *The taking or attempting to take anything of value from the care, custody, or control of a person or persons by force or threat of force or violence and/or by putting the victim in fear.*

In the first six months of 1989, reported robberies increased 13.4 percent compared to the same period in 1988.



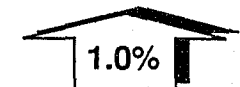
AGGRAVATED ASSAULT - *The unlawful attack by one person upon another for the purpose of inflicting severe or aggravated bodily injury. This type of assault usually is accompanied by the use of a weapon or by means likely to produce death or great bodily harm.*

The number of aggravated assaults reported in the first six months of 1989 increased 10.5 percent compared to the same period in 1988.



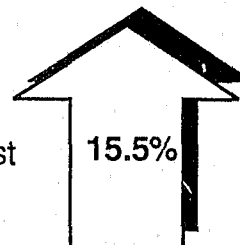
BURGLARY - *The unlawful entry of a structure to commit a felony or theft. Attempted forcible entry is included.*

In the first six months of 1989, reported burglaries increased 1.0 percent compared to the same period in 1988.



MOTOR VEHICLE THEFT - *The theft or attempted theft of a motor vehicle.*

A 15.5 percent increase in motor vehicle theft was reported in the first half of 1989 compared to the same period in 1988.
