COUNTY DETENTION FACILITIES:  
INMATE PROFILE SUMMARY  
JUNE - 1989

ABSTRACT

The County Detention Facilities Summary provides a monthly profile of Florida's detention facilities inmate population. Average daily population figures for June, 1989 are collapsed into male and female categories for both adult and juvenile inmates. These population figures are also categorized into felony, misdemeanor and "other" subcategories in order to facilitate interpretation. Within both felony and misdemeanor subcategories the number of inmates held for trial or sentencing and those detained or sentenced for violation of probation are presented for June, 1989. The "other" subcategory documents the number of parole violators, state inmates, undocumented aliens, holdings for other jurisdictions and individuals detained under the Baker (mental health) and Myers (alcoholism) Acts. In addition, the average daily population figures, the incarceration rates for each county, the number of overcrowded county detention facilities and the pretrial inmate levels for each facility are included in this report. County detention facilities with amended capacities since May, 1989 are denoted in Table 3.

COUNTY DETENTION FACILITIES:  
PROFILE DATA SUMMARY  
JUNE - 1989

Average Daily Population

On the average, there were 33,026 inmates in Florida's county detention facilities during the month of June, 1989. This figure represents the the highest daily average recorded since the Florida Department of Corrections began collecting data on inmates held in county detention facilities. The statewide average daily population (ADP) totals for June, 1989 include 28,972 adult males (87.7%), 3,387 adult females (10.2%), and 667 juvenile offenders (2.0%). The overall distribution of male and female inmates has remained fairly constant in county detention facilities for the past four years. The following provides an analysis of the inmate population for June, 1989:

- \* 75.5% of the inmate population were incarcerated for felony offenses, while 19.5 percent were detained for misdemeanor crimes.
- \* Offenders held for trial represented 61.9% of the inmate population and 22.3 percent were sentenced on either felony or misdemeanor crimes.
- \* Inmates detained for violation of probation represented 8.1% of the inmate population.
- \* The remaining 7.7% were various groups as listed in Table 1.

Incarceration Rates

In June of 1989, the statewide county detention facility incarceration rate was 2.5 per 1,000 county residents based

on the population estimate for 1989. Incarceration rates range from a low of 0.9 in Calhoun and Charlotte Counties to a high of 10.9 per 1,000 population in Hamilton County. Hamilton County's extremely high incarceration rate is the direct result of holding a large proportion of their inmate population for the U.S. Marshals Service. Several other counties may also be experiencing high incarceration rates due to the contracting of bed space.

#### Overcrowding: Capacity Versus Population

In June, 1989, 38 percent (26) of the counties in the State of Florida had average daily inmate populations which exceeded their Department of Corrections (DC) rated capacity. Twenty three percent (16) of Florida's counties had average daily inmate populations that were between 1 and 25 percent over their DC rated capacity, 10.4 percent (7) had inmate daily averages that were between 26 and 50 percent over capacity, and 2.99 percent (2) of the counties had average daily inmate populations which exceeded the rated capacity by more than 50 percent. Forty two (62.6 percent) of Florida's counties were at or below capacity.

#### Pretrial Population Levels

During the month of June, 1989, 20,464 of the inmates housed in county detention facilities were classified as awaiting trial. Of these 20,464 offenders, 86.6% percent were awaiting trial for felony offenses while 13.4 were detained for misdemeanor violations.




**INCARCERATION RATES PER 1,000



**JUNE - 1989**








