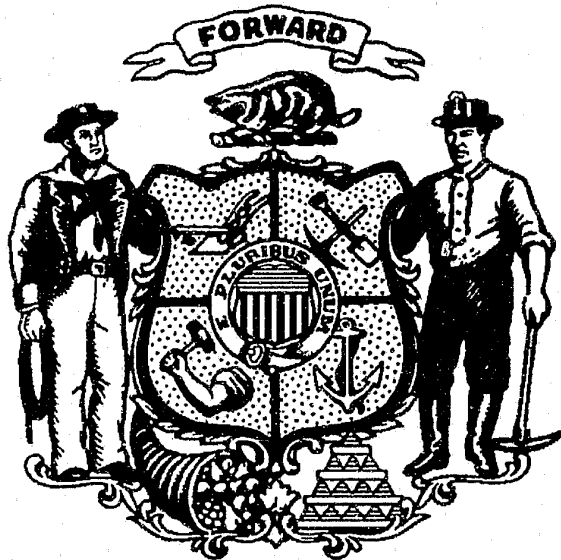

ACQUISITIONS

\* Eight out of 10 men (82.5 percent) and 9 out of 10 women (89.2 percent) in residence were serving new sentences. This category includes offenders who were not under any type of sentence prior to being committed as well as those received as probation violators with or without new sentences. Men and women re-institutionalized with or without new sentences following revocation of parole or mandatory release supervision made up 16.7 and 10.2 percent of the resident population respectively.

\* One-half (51.0 percent) of the men in residence were White while two-fifths (40.7 percent) were Black. The reverse was true in the resident population of women where just over two-fifths (43.8 percent) were White and one-half (51.1 percent) were Black.

\* Unarmed burglary (16.3 percent), other drug violations (8.9 percent), armed robbery (8.4 percent), and first degree sexual assault (7.4 percent) were the crimes for which men in residence had been most frequently sentenced. Women were most often sentenced for forgery (15.1 percent), other drug violations, (14.8 percent), theft (13.3 percent), and first degree murder (6.3 percent).

\* Men classified only as property offenders made up 29.6 percent of the resident population. Three-fifths (58.1 percent) were categorized as assaultive offenders, one-fifth (21.0 percent) as sex offenders, and over one-tenth (13.9 percent) as drug offenders. These three classifications are not mutually exclusive.

\* Two-fifths (41.1 percent) of the women were classified as property offenders, just under two-fifths (38.1 percent) as assaultive offenders, one-fifth (20.1 percent) as drug offenders, and 5.1 percent as sex offenders. The latter three categories are not mutually exclusive.

\* The average (mean) length of sentence for men was 11.1 years; for women, 6.2 years. Offenders serving life sentences, 437 men and 21 women were excluded from these computations.

\* About two-fifths of the men (38.1 percent) and women (37.8 percent) in residence were committed from Milwaukee County. An additional one-fourth of the men (25.7 percent) and one-third of the women (33.0 percent) were committed from Racine, Dane, Kenosha, and Rock Counties.

- \* Men, with an average (mean) age of 30.1 years were two years younger than women who had an average (mean) age of 32.1 years.

- \* Over one-half of the men (53.9 percent) and women (53.2 percent) in residence were born in Wisconsin.

- \* Seven out of 10 men (71.8 percent) and 6 out of 10 (64.0 percent) were found to be without physical, emotional, or developmental disabilities. About one-tenth of the men (11.2 percent) and women (11.5 percent) had some type of physical disability.

- \* A previous record of military service was noted for about one-fifth (16.0 percent) of the men and 7 women.

- \* Two-fifths of the men (36.7 percent) and women (37.8 percent) had a record of high school level education but had not earned diplomas. GED or HED certificates had been earned by three-tenths (28.5 percent) of the men and over one-tenth (15.4 percent) of the women while about one-tenth of the men (12.8 percent) and women (13.0 percent) possessed high diplomas.

- \* Men had been institutionalized for an average (mean) of 26.9 months; women, for 16.9 months.

- \* One-third (33.5 percent) of the men were assigned a maximum security classification after completion of the assessment and evaluation process. An additional one-third (34.0 percent) were classified as either medium or medium-out, about one-fifth (21.2 percent) as minimum, and 4.8 percent were classified as being suitable for special programs. Less than one-tenth (6.5 percent) were unclassified. Over one-fourth (27.2 percent) of the women were classified as maximum, almost one-fourth (23.0 percent) as medium, one-third (33.5 percent) as minimum, and less than one-tenth (8.8 percent) as eligible for special programs. Less than one-tenth (7.5 percent) were unclassified.

- \* Information about alcohol and/or other drug treatment needs, mental health treatment needs, and educational and vocational needs is not available for publication in this bulletin due to problems associated with revisions of both data collections and the reporting system. It will resume with the C-57 for December 31, 1991.
