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GLOSSARY OF TERMS

Adult Arrests by King County Police

An arrest is counted every time an adult is cited for a criminal offense or booked. More specifically:

- 1. It includes all adult bookings, plus
- 2. All adult citations which are classified as criminal non-traffic.
- 3. When an adult is both cited and booked, it is only counted once.

Automated Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS) Unit

An AFIS latent "spinoff" hit is matching a fingerprint in one case that results in further matches/identification within that particular case or obtaining additional fingerprint matches in other cases - whether or not they are directly related.

Bomb Disposal Unit

A Bomb Disposal Unit "response" is counted any time a bomb unit technician is involved in an incident, either as a primary or backup/support unit. This includes some in-house training and all out-of-Department training.

Calls for Service

This includes requests from the public plus on-view incidents. Each <u>event</u> is counted once. For instance, even five units responding to the same event would only count as one request. Also counted are phone reports taken in the Communications Center and in-person reports taken at the precincts or downtown, even if no patrol unit responds.

Data Unit

"Warrants Handled" are any warrants-related Washington Crime Information Center (WACIC) transactions including entry, removal, or quashing.

"Domestic Violence Orders Handled" are any domestic violence-related Washington Crime Information Center (WACIC) transactions including entry, removal, or quashing.

Dispatched Calls for Service

This includes calls received in the Communications Center which result in one or more patrol cars being dispatched.

Juvenile Arrests by King County Police


A juvenile arrest is counted in all situations where an adult would be arrested under similar circumstances. More specifically juvenile arrests include:

- 1. All juveniles who are referred to the juvenile court system (King County Department of Youth Services) due to criminal offenses.
- 2. All juveniles who are cited for criminal non-traffic offenses.
- 3. All juveniles taken into custody and warned by King County Police, then released to parents, relatives, friends or a welfare agency.
- 4. All juveniles who commit criminal offenses who are referred to the adult or criminal court system to be tried as adults. (Historically, this category has applied to less than one percent of our juvenile arrestees.)
- 5. When a juvenile is both cited and referred to the juvenile or the adult court system, only one juvenile arrest is counted.

Marine Unit

A Marine Unit "response" is counted any time a Marine unit is involved in an incident as a primary unit. This can include citizen requests for service, area checks, and maintenance and repair of equipment.








