## APRIL 1993 MONTHLY REPORT

The institution and Parole Population Movements report reflects male and female inmate and parole movements as of the date they were posted to the Offender Based Information System (OBIS). Report categories that are not self-explanatory are defined as follows:

<b>Released to CYA Parole</b>	Effective January 1, 1988, CYA took over parole supervision of W&IC 1731.5(c) cases.
<b>Total Received</b>	New admissions, parole returns and all inmates returned from temporary release from an institution.
<b>Total Released</b>	Inmates who were paroled, discharged, died or who were temporarily released from an institution.
<b>Total Received/Released</b>	The difference between the total number of inmates received in the institutions and the total number of inmates released from the institutions during the specified time period.
