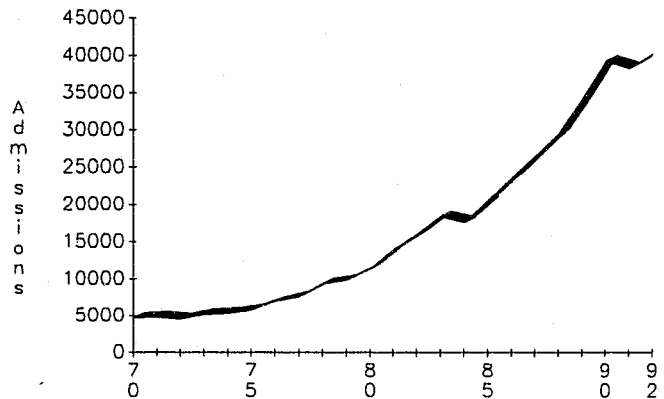
FELON NEW ADMISSIONS

During Calendar Year 1992, the number of California Department of Corrections felon new admissions increased from 26,515 in 1987 to 40,158 in 1992.

Felon new admissions increased 152.1% since 1982, 51.5% since 1987 and 5.0% since 1991.

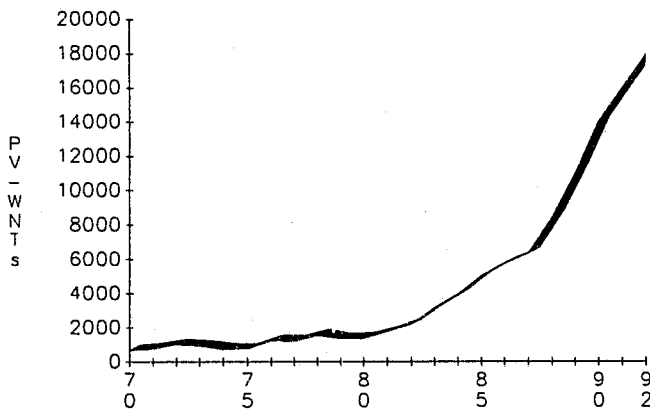
- o The number of male felon new admissions was 36,519 and the number of female felon new admissions was 3,639.

PAROLE VIOLATORS RETURNED WITH A NEW TERM

During Calendar Year 1992, Parole Violators Returned With a New Term (PV-WNTs), reached an all time high of 17,939.

- o This represents an increase of 704.1% since 1982, 180.7% since 1987 and 12.0% since 1991.
- o There were 16,862 male PV-WNTs and 1,077 female PV-WNTs.
