ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES^{1/} DECEMBER 1992 (Preliminary Data)

INMATE POPULATION The inmate population in DOCS facilities rose by 3,874 inmates (+6.7%) from end of December 1991 to 1992. The number of state ready inmates stood at 1,340 at the close of December 1992 compared to 2,355 at the close of December 1991, down 1,015 (-43.1%). At the close of the twelfth term of 1992, pending felony cases stood at 24,754, up 1.3% from the previous year. The number of felons convicted but still awaiting sentence stood at 9,842. These cases could represent additional commitments to DOCS. A reduction in these backlogs would result in an accelerated increase in the DOCS inmate population.

<u>ADMISSIONS</u> Total admissions for January - December 1992 at 32,230 were 8.0% above the 29,831 recorded during this period in 1991. Court commitments increased by 1,038 (+4.3%) from 24,115 to 25,153. Returned parole violators increased by 1,240 (+39.8%) while conditional release violators increased by 47 (+18.6%). Other admissions rose from 2,344 to 2,418 (+3.2%). The 12 month average increased in all admission categories.


Releases There were 28,342 inmates released from DOCS facilities during January-December 1992 which was 1,473 (5.5%) more than the 26,869 released in 1991. Paroles accounted for 20,302 of the releases compared to 19,394 for January-December 1991, up 908 (+4.7%). Conditional releases at 3,505 were 5.1% higher than in 1991, while releases at expiration of sentence declined by 82. Other releases increased from 3,363 to 3,839. The 12 month average showed releases increasing in the parole, conditional release and other release categories and decreasing in the expiration of sentence category.

ADMISSIONS TO FACILITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONAL SERVICES 1991 AND 1992




