Foreword

Bias-motivated crime is a phenomenon that touches all segments of society. It exacts an immeasurable toll on its victims who are targeted solely because of hatred toward their race, religion, ethnicity, or sexual orientation. While the true impact of these acts on victims cannot be measured statistically, information concerning the nature, volume, and scope of the acts can lead to an awareness that prompts responsible action against them.

The law enforcement community recognizes that valid information is central to developing effective measures to deal with hate crime. Agencies across the country have initiated local data collection programs in response to this need, and the results of their efforts are presented in this publication. Participation in the data collection program is growing steadily as more agencies find the resources to provide the needed information on their jurisdictions' experience and help complete the nationwide hate crime picture. The statistics in this publication demonstrate the remarkable strides already made; they give us valuable insight not before available. As the collection progresses, our ability to assess and form strategies to combat hate crime will likewise progress.

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INTRODUCTION

In response to the passage of the Hate Crime Statistics Act of 1990, the Attorney General designated the FBI's Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) Program to develop a data collection system for its 16,000 voluntary law enforcement agency participants. With the cooperation and assistance of several local and state law enforcement agencies already experienced in the investigation of hate crimes and the collection of related information, comprehensive guidelines for the collection of hate crime data were established.

Collection Design

The collection is designed to capture information about the type of bias serving as the motivating factor, the location of the crime, and various personal descriptors pertaining to both victims and offenders. In developing this reporting program, many issues were considered. For example, it was

recognized that hate crimes are not separate distinct offenses, but rather traditional crimes motivated by the offender's bias. An offender may, for example, commit an assault because of his/her bias against the victim's religion, race, ethnicity, or sexual orientation. It was, therefore, not necessary to create whole new crime categories. To the contrary, hate crime data could be collected by merely capturing additional information about crimes already being reported to UCR. Additionally, bias motivations to be reported would be those specifically addressed by the enabling Act, i.e., prejudice against a race, religion, sexual orientation, or ethnic group. Because of the difficulty of ascertaining the offender's subjective motivation, bias would be reported when the law enforcement investigation revealed sufficient objective facts to lead a reasonable and prudent person to conclude that the offender's actions were motivated, in whole or in part, by bias.

The Hate Crime Statistics Program has been endorsed by the International Association of Chiefs of Police, the National Sheriffs' Association, the UCR Data Providers' Advisory Policy Board, the International Association of Directors of Law Enforcement Standards and Training, and the Association of State Uniform Crime Reporting Programs. These endorsements were crucial to the successful implementation of the program, for without law enforcement's voluntary data collection and support any effort would be futile.

Training

Since the development of the hate crime data collection program, UCR has conducted 46 training conferences nationwide to instruct law enforcement on the methodology used in the investigation and reporting of hate crime. Conference attendees, representing each of the 50 states and the District of Columbia, were from 906 separate city, county, state, and federal agencies. Included among them were agencies serving populations over 100,000, which represent approximately 79 percent of the United States population, and state UCR Programs. State Program personnel will, in turn, conduct training for their constituent agencies.

Program Plans

The FBI plans to publish annual reports focused specifically on bias-motivated criminal behavior, along with other topical studies highlighting unique aspects of hate crime. Although the Hate Crime Statistics Act expires after 5 years, the FBI considers the statistics collection to be a permanent addition to the UCR Program.

Participation

Ever increasing numbers of law enforcement agencies and state UCR Programs have become actively involved in the collection of hate crime data. In 1992, the FBI received data submissions from approximately 6,200 law enforcement agencies in 41 states and the District of Columbia. The number of agencies reporting within each state is shown in Section II of this publication. Reports from these agencies, while not sufficient to allow valid national or regional measures of the volume and types of crimes motivated by hate, offer perspectives on the general nature of hate crime occurrences.

The collection of hate crime statistics at the national level will increase awareness and understanding of the problem, and in turn, will result in constructive improvement. Law enforcement will be better able to quantify their resource needs and perform a better job of allocating resources to the areas of greatest need. Historically, law enforcement has demonstrated progressive, professional competence in approaching criminal problems. Their response to the hate crime legislation is no exception, and participating law enforcement agencies are commended for their efforts in addressing this issue.

This report identifies the state-level agency that serves as the UCR state Program administrator in 44 states and the District of Columbia (see Appendix). Individual law enforcement agencies in these states submit their crime reports to the FBI through the state agency. Some states have not yet instituted statewide hate crime collections. Overall, the FBI generally supports those states which have defined realistic plans

calling for reporting of hate crimes. In states where no plan exists, the FBI will continue to work directly with the law enforcement agencies in the state as is done in the six states not having state UCR Programs. The majority of the non-participating law enforcement agencies and states have cited governmental budgetary constraints and/or lack of personnel resources as reasons for not participating. It must be emphasized that

estimated startup times are somewhat longer for those states planning to incorporate hate crime data into their National Incident-Based Reporting Systems (NIBRS) than for states collecting data under the current summary system. The FBI believes that the tremendous amount of detailed and reliable data provided by NIBRS will more than compensate for the short- term delay.

METHODOLOGY

Presented throughout this publication are tables and narrative comments addressing the volume and type of bias-motivated criminal incidents reported to the FBI during 1992. Criminal incidents can involve more than one offense, victim, or offender. For counting purposes, one offense is counted for each victim of a "crime against person." One offense is counted for each distinct operation of "crime against property," regardless of the number of victims. The total number of victims in a given incident is the sum of victims associated with each offense that took place within the incident.

In Section I of this publication are statistics on reported criminal incidents that evidenced bias motivation. Included in the data collection are the offenses of murder and nonnegligent manslaughter; forcible rape; robbery; aggravated assault; burglary; larceny-theft; motor vehicle theft; arson; simple assault; intimidation; and destruction/damage/vandalism of property. The bias categories, as listed in the Hate Crime Statistics Act, are race, religion, ethnicity/national origin, and sexual orientation.

Notification of hate crime incidents is received by the FBI's Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) Program from city, county, and state law enforcement agencies through various types of media ranging from paper reporting forms to floppy disks and magnetic tapes. Individual reports are submitted for each hate crime incident coming to the attention of law enforcement agencies participating in the UCR Program. Quarterly reports are used to advise that no hate crimes occurred within the reporting jurisdiction. Reports are sent through state-level UCR Programs (see Appendix) or directly to the

FBI from agencies in states without Programs or whose state Programs have not begun collection.

Data for 1992 were supplied by 6,181 law enforcement agencies representing over 129 million United States inhabitants or approximately 51 percent of the Nation's population. The following table shows the number of agencies represented within each population group and the extent of population coverage.

Section I contains tables showing data for 5,168 agencies supplying all the information required for tabulation. Over 1,000 agencies in Minnesota and Pennsylvania, while participating, could not furnish complete information concerning incidents within their jurisdictions. These two states recorded 843 incidents not tabulated in any of the presentations in Section I. The total number of hate crime incidents reported to the FBI in 1992 was 7.466. (See Table 13.)

Section II contains tables showing participation levels by state and counts of hate crime incidents reported by individual law enforcement agencies across the country. Caution should be exercised in attempting direct comparisons of hate crime totals among agencies due to the many variables affecting the volume and type of crime from place to place.

SECTION I Hate Crime Statistics, 1992

Incidents

During 1992, 7,466 bias-motivated criminal incidents were reported to the FBI by approximately 6,200 law enforcement agencies in 41 states and the District of Columbia. Sixty-three percent of the incidents were motivated by racial bias; 15 percent by religious bias; 12 percent by sexual-orientation bias; and the remainder by ethnicity/national origin bias.

Complete information was received concerning 6,623 incidents. Those 6,623 incidents involved 8,106 separate offenses, 8,310 victims, and 7,913 known offenders. Most of the incidents (84 percent) involved only one victim and a single offense type (98 percent). Fewer than one-third, however, involved only one victim and one offender.

Seven of every 10 incidents involved crimes against persons, and 8 of every 10 were directed at individuals (See Tables 2

and 4). Of the total incidents directed at individuals, 15 percent involved crimes against property, i.e., the vandalism of an individual's car or home.

Offenses

Crimes against persons composed 74 percent of the 8,106 offenses reported. (See Table 2.) Intimidation was the single most frequently reported hate crime among all offenses measured, accounting for 37 percent of the total. Following were damage/destruction/vandalism of property, 23 percent; simple assault, 19 percent; and aggravated assault, 17 percent.

Seventeen persons were murdered in hate-motivated incidents. (See Table 7.) While bias against ethnic groups, i.e., Hispanic or other national origin, motivated fewer hate crime offenses than any other bias-type, it resulted in the highest number of

murders -- 8. Anti-Hispanic offenses alone accounted for 6 of the 8 homicides in this category. Of the remaining murders, 7 were motivated by racial bias, 1 was motivated by religious bias, and 1 by sexual-orientation bias.

Victims

Eighty-five percent of the 8,310 reported hate crime victims were individuals, while the remaining 15 percent were businesses, religious organizations, or varied other targets.

Of the 8,310 victims in 1992, 72 percent were targets of crimes against persons. Six of every 10 victims were attacked because of their race, with bias against blacks accounting for 35 percent of the total. Only crimes motivated by religious bias showed a higher percentage of crimes against property rather than persons. Sixty-one percent of incidents involving victims targeted because of their religion were crimes against property. (See Table 11.)

Offenders

Law enforcement agencies reported 7,913 known offenders to be associated with the 6,623 incidents recorded in 1992. Fifty-three percent of the known offenders were white, and 42 percent were black. (See Table 12.) Offenders were unknown for 2,821 or 36 percent of the incidents.

Eighty-five percent of the known offenders were reported in connection with assaults (aggravated and simple assault and intimidation). Unlike crimes against property, victims or witnesses of crimes against persons are frequently able to assist with the identification of offenders. While crimes against property accounted for 31 percent of all hate crime incidents reported, they accounted for only 14 percent of known offenders. (See Table 2.)

Considering the types of bias involved, 9 of every 10 white offenders were identified in connection with anti-black offenses. Similarly, 9 of every 10 black offenders identified were associated with anti-white offenses. (See Table 9.) Law enforcement agencies were least likely to be able to identify offenders of religious bias crimes. In 1992, only 391 offenders were identified in connection with 1,162 incidents. In most cases where religious bias was the motivating factor, the offenses were crimes against property for which clearance rates are historically lower.

Locations

Twenty-five percent of hate crime incidents in 1992 occurred in residences. Following closely were highways, roads, alleys, or streets accounting for 23 percent. The remaining incidents were widely distributed among varied locations. (See Table 5.)

SECTION II Jurisdictional Hate Crime Statistics, 1992

Nearly 6,200 law enforcement agencies covering about 51 percent of the Nation's population or 129 million inhabitants supplied information for inclusion in this publication. The number of reporting agencies by state, along with their corresponding population coverage, is shown in Table 13. Also indicated is the number of agencies recording hate crimes during 1992, as well as those reporting no occurrences within their jurisdictions. Hate crime occurrences were recorded by 26 percent of the participating agencies, while the remainder reported that no bias crimes were brought to their attention.

The individual jurisdictional figures are presented in five tables delineating city, suburban county, rural county, university/ college, and state law enforcement agencies. In order to be included in the tables, a law enforcement agency must have submitted data for at least one quarter of calendar year 1992. The figures, therefore, may not represent complete 12-month totals for every agency listed. Due to the many variable factors affecting the nature and volume of crime, care must be exercised in making any comparisons among agencies, even where agencies reported for comparable timeframes. All factors must be considered before valid comparisons can be achieved.
