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## ACQUISITIONS

**INTRODUCTION**

This report summarizes statistical information about the Maricopa County Juvenile Court Center in 1993. This report compares the court activity in 1993 with the activity of the prior four years (1989-1992).

The bulk of this report deals with juvenile delinquency and incorrigibility (status) referrals. Information is obtained from police reports, other referring entities, and from probation officers who interviewed the children and their families. It describes the number and characteristics of delinquency and incorrigible offense cases in 1993 handled by the Maricopa County Juvenile Court.

A child becomes known to the court by a "referral" which alleges that the child has violated the law in some way. It should be noted that many children whose actions or social conditions might warrant action by the Juvenile Court are not referred to the court and are therefore not included in these data. Some children are not referred simply because their illegal actions are not observed or reported, or the child is not apprehended. Furthermore, not all activities of juveniles once reported to the police are subsequently referred to the Juvenile Court. Some police agencies within the county use community counseling programs for children apprehended for minor offenses, followed by release to their parents. Consequently, the data presented in this report cannot be taken as a complete measure of the extent of delinquent behavior in Maricopa County.

When it has been decided by a referring agency that a child's action or social condition warrants intervention by the court, that child is referred, and when a child is referred, the intake division of the Juvenile Court begins the process of diagnosis and recommendation. There are numerous ways in which a referral may be dealt with by the court. However, the best interest of the child, balanced with what is in the best interest of the community, must always be considered.

Children also become known to the court when they are being adopted, when one or both parent's rights are being severed (usually prior to adoption), or when the child may have been neglected, abandoned or abused.

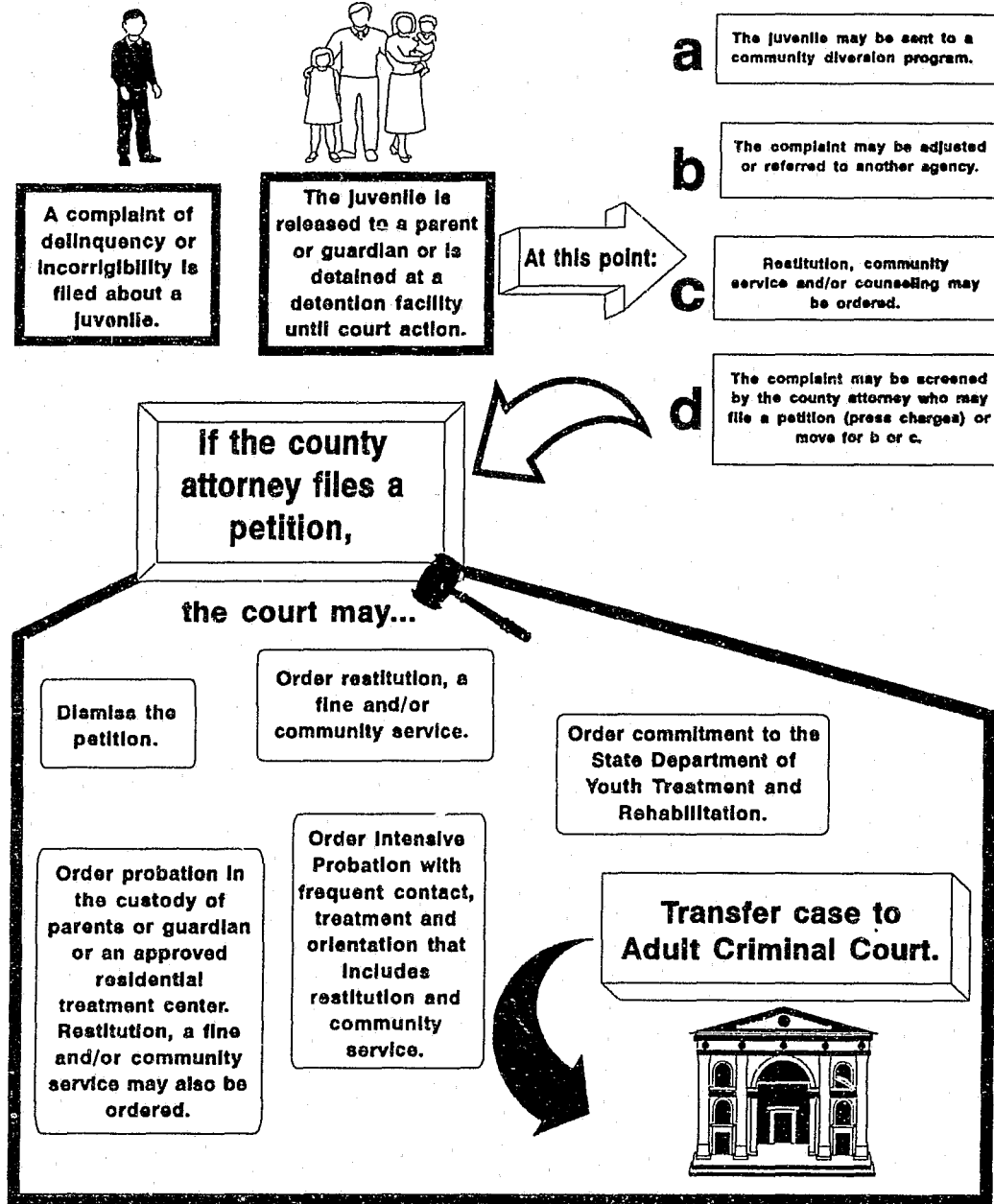

## HOW MARICOPA COUNTY'S JUVENILE JUSTICE SYSTEM WORKS



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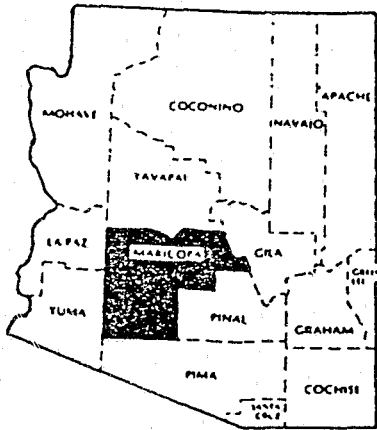

## STATE AND COUNTY STATISTICS

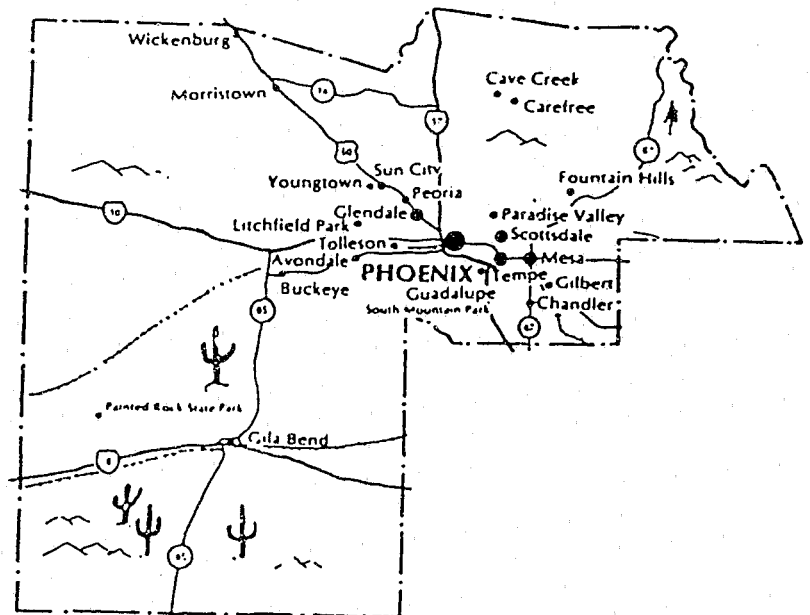
Arizona is geographically the sixth largest state in the nation with 113,642 square miles and a population estimate in 1993 of 3,958,875 in 15 counties. Maricopa County is the seventh most populated county in the nation with 9,204 square miles and a population of 2,291,200. (Department of Economic Security Population Estimates for 1993.)

Approximately 57.9% of the state's population resides in Maricopa County. There are 249 residents per square mile. Nationwide, Maricopa County has the seventh largest population. Phoenix is the county seat.

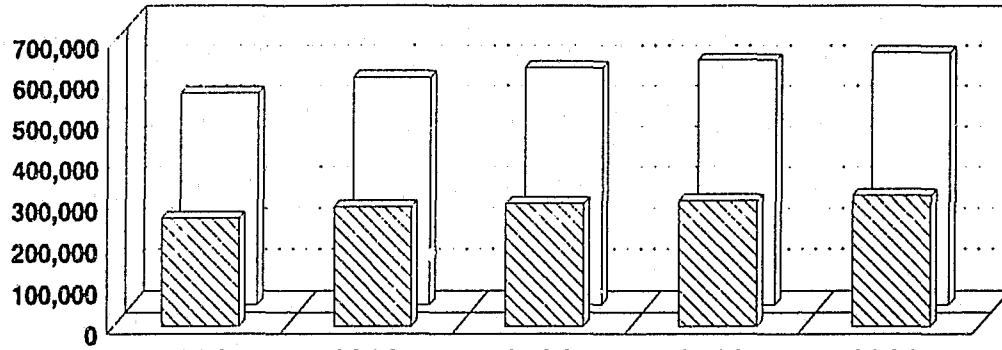

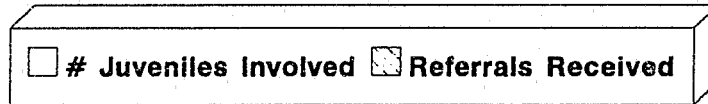

In any given year, about 6% of the juvenile population (between the ages of 8 and 17) of Maricopa County is referred at least once to the Court Center. That's about one juvenile in every 15 at risk.

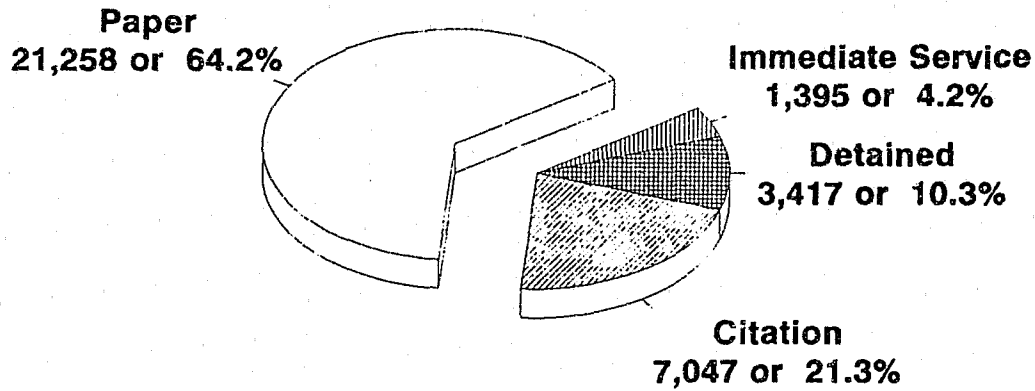
In 1993, there were 33,117 referrals generated by 20,947 juveniles.

This is an increase of 20.4% from 1989 in the number of juveniles referred to the court, and a 26.2% increase in the number of referrals.

Referrals in 1993 show an increase of 20% over last year (1992) which can be attributed to a 152% increase in the number of curfew violations.

## Delinquent & Incurrigible



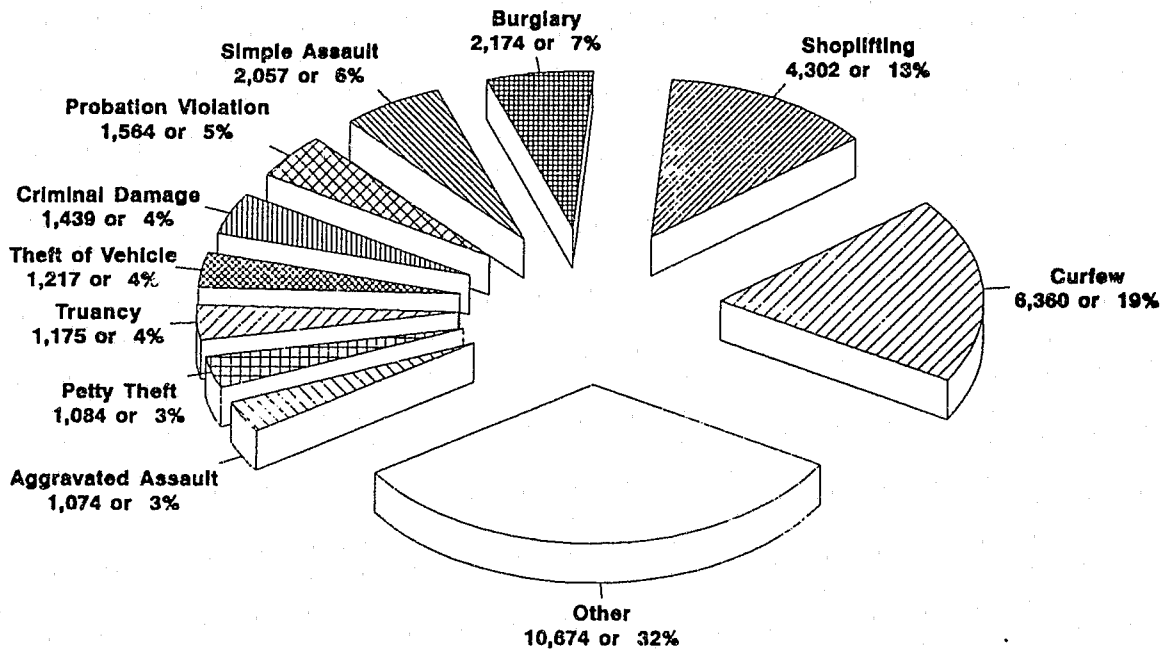

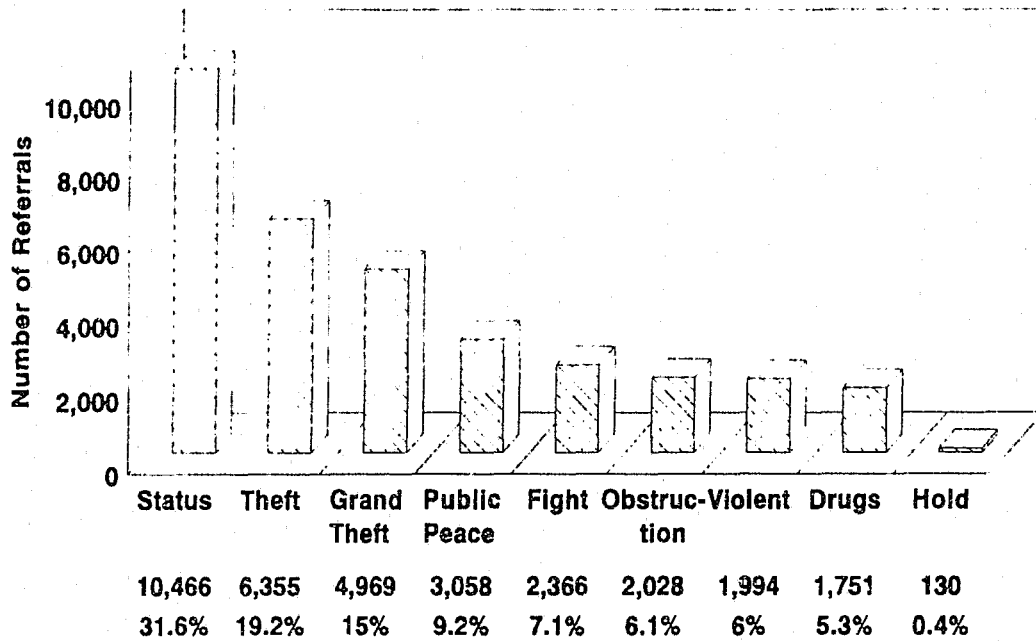

Referrals are categorized as to their severity according to the offense. This order was established by the Maricopa County Juvenile Court Center and is unique to this Court Center. Property crimes (Felony/Grand Theft and Misdemeanor/Theft) account for 34.2% of all referrals.

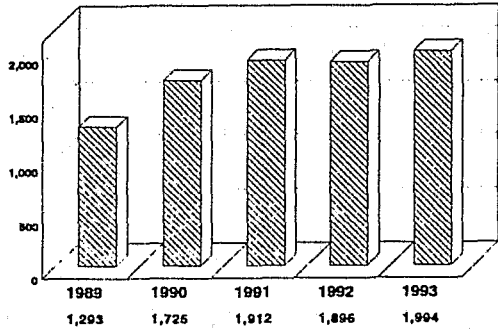
Incurrigible (status) offenses were 31.6%, Public Order (Peace and Obstructing) 15.4%, Person crimes (Felony/Violent and Misdemeanor/Fight) 13.2%, Drug law violations (Felony and Misdemeanor) were 5.3%, and Administrative (Hold) were 0.4% of 31,117 total referrals for 1993.



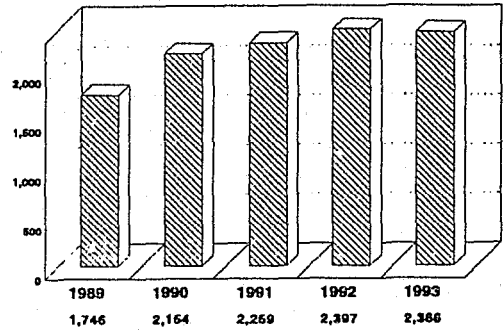

SEVERITY OF REFERRAL 1989-1993

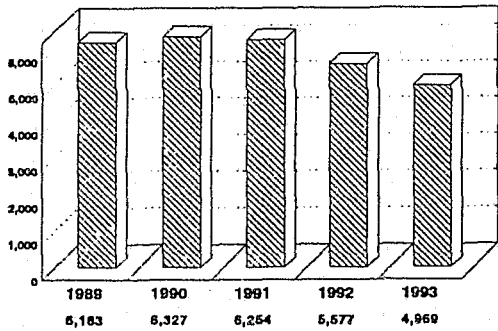
**Violent Referrals**



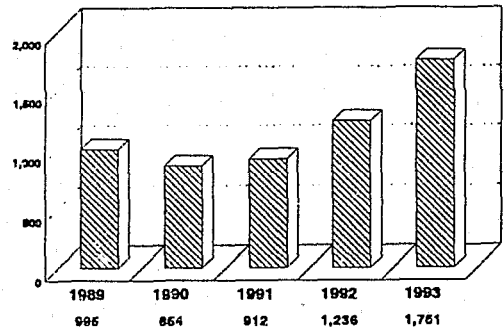
**Fight Referrals**



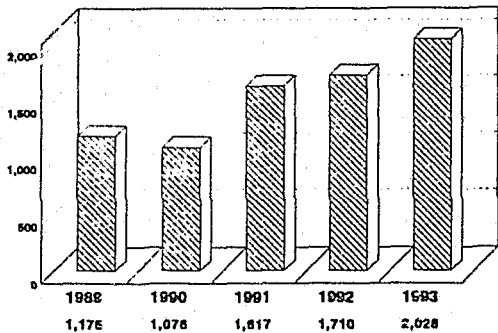
**Grand Theft Referrals**



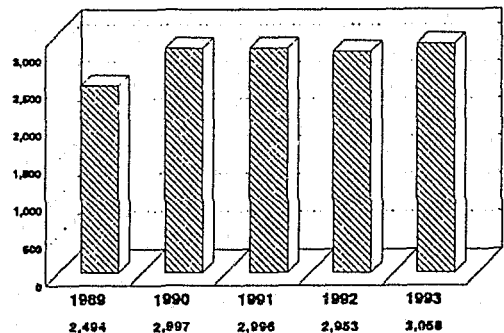
**Drug Referrals**



**Obstruction Referrals**

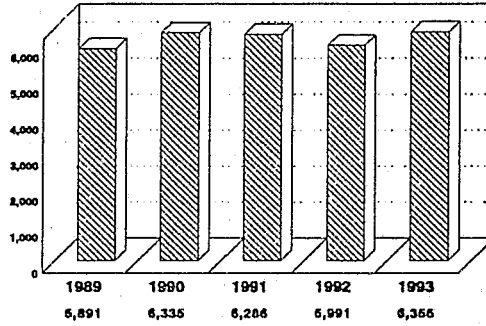

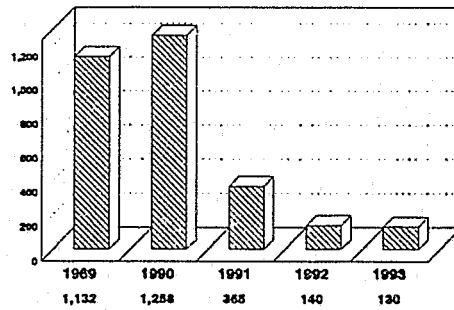

# Source of Referral

## Top 5 Referring Agencies



Delinquent and incorrigible (status) cases are referred to the court by law enforcement agencies, social service agencies, schools, parents, and probation officers. Law enforcement agencies are the primary source of referral. Overall, about 90% of all cases in 1993 were referred by law enforcement agencies.

The law enforcement agency that contributes the most referrals to the Juvenile Court is the Phoenix Police Department. In 1993, Phoenix sent 15,972 referrals, which accounts for 48% of all referrals received. Phoenix, Mesa, Chandler, Glendale and Tempe Police Departments comprise the top five sources of referrals received, accounting for 76% of all referrals to the Juvenile Court Center in 1993.

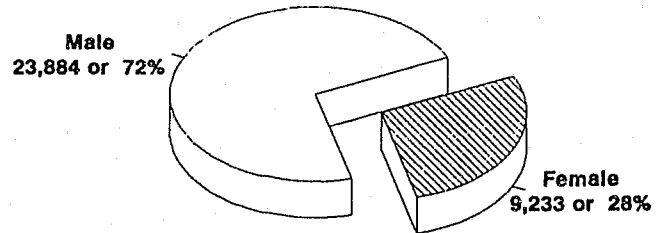

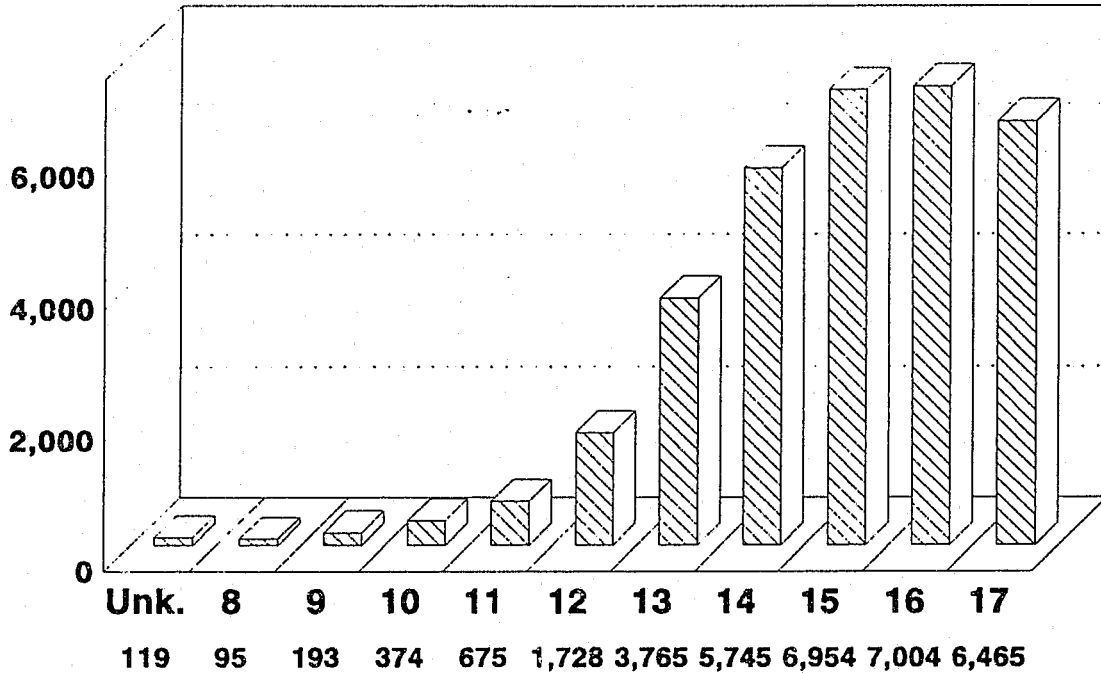

Once a juvenile reaches the age of 18, the Juvenile Court loses all jurisdiction. Those juveniles ages 15 to 17 account for 62% of the total referrals received by the Juvenile Court.



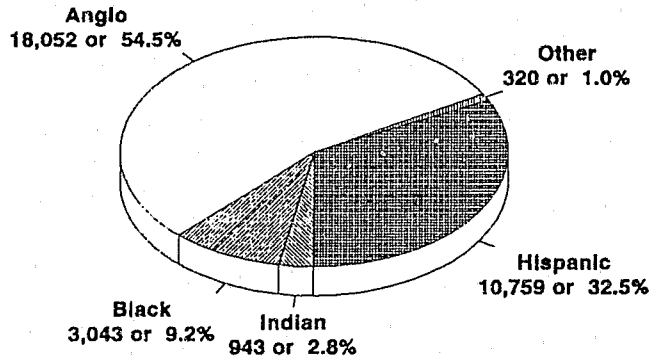

Ethnicity of Referred

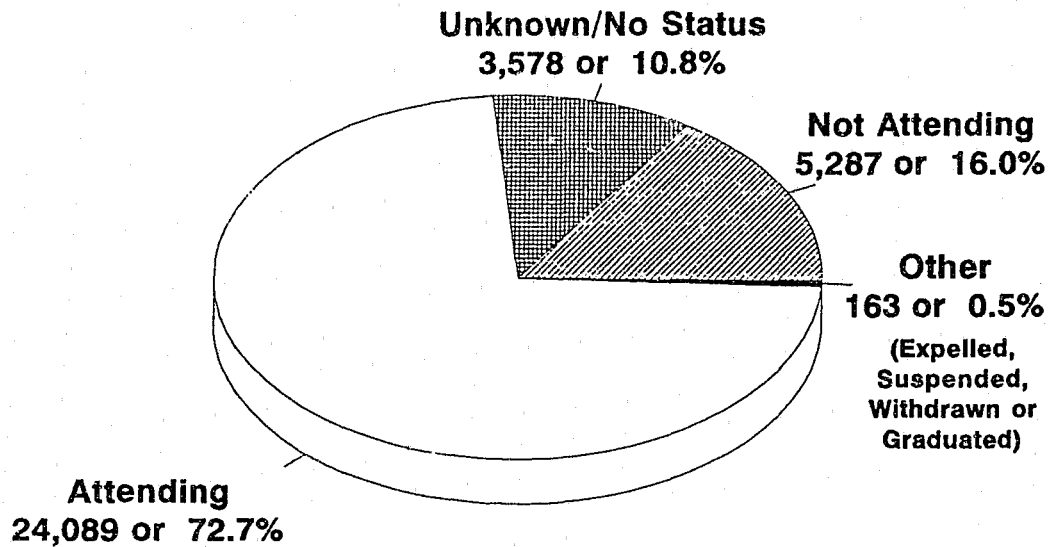

## School Status of Referred



At receipt of referral, 72.7% or about 3 of every 4 juveniles were attending school. An additional 16.0% were reported as not attending school at time of referral, while the school status of 10.8% was unknown or had no status.

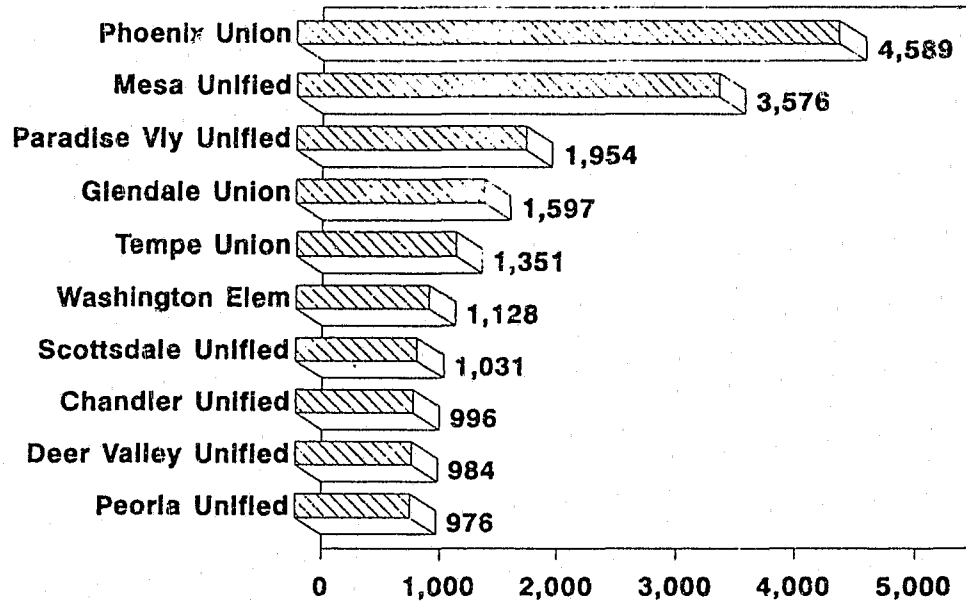

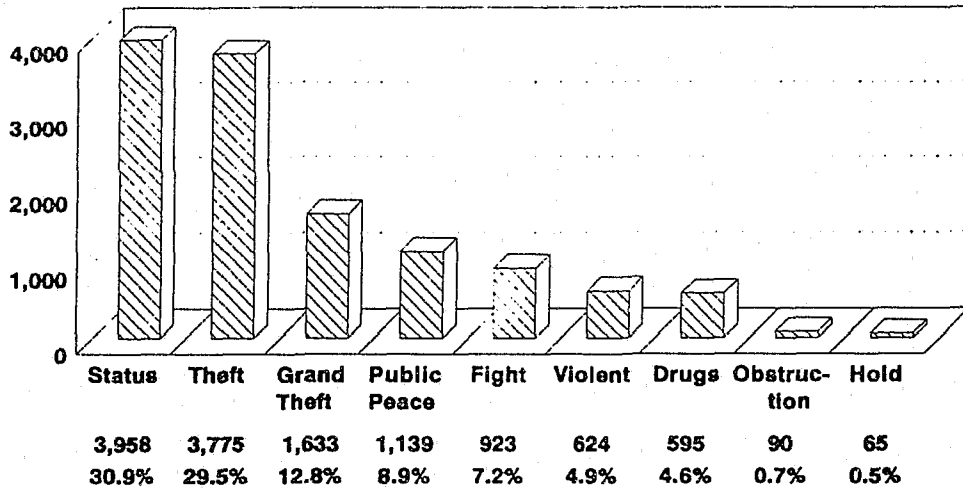

## Juveniles Brought to Detention Screening and Juveniles Detained



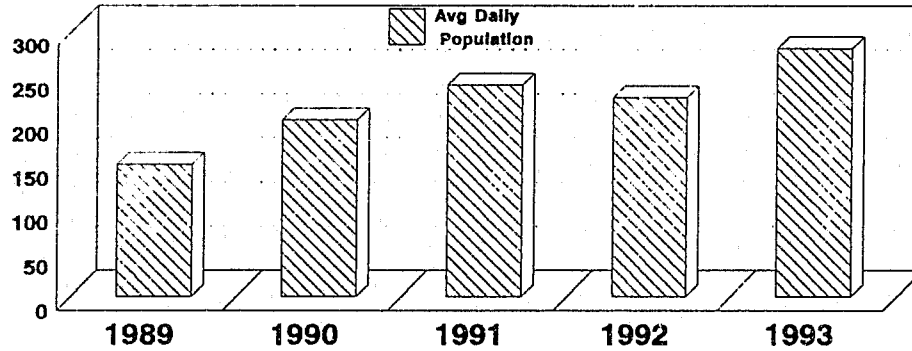

During 1993, there were 8,376 requests for detention. This resulted in detention of a juvenile 7,273 times, or 86.8% of the requests. A request for detention may occur when a Police Officer believes, for the safety of the community or the juvenile, that physical detention may be required. The juvenile is taken to either of the two Maricopa County Juvenile Detention Centers and interviewed by an Intake Screening Officer.

Based upon Supreme Court Rules and the Court Center's administrative criteria, the Intake Screening Officer has the option to release the juvenile to the parents or physically detain the juvenile pending court action. Intake Screeners are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. If the juvenile is detained, a petition must be filed by the County Attorney, and a detention hearing held within 24 hours.

In 1993, 7,273 juveniles were detained. Of those, 3,417 were detained for delinquent or incorrigible acts, and the remainder of 3,856 juveniles were detained for such reasons as: court holds, courtesy holds, family counseling, family crisis, FOJ (from other jurisdiction), warrants, and home detention.

The average daily population in detention (including both facilities) was 281 juveniles. The average (mean) length of stay was 13.3 days. Length of stay does not have a normal distribution. Most juveniles stay less than 13 days while those who stay longer remain much longer than the 1993 average might suggest. The cost of a juvenile per day in detention was

\$68.53 in 1993. The reduction in cost is the result of over-crowding in detention in 1993.

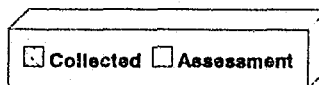
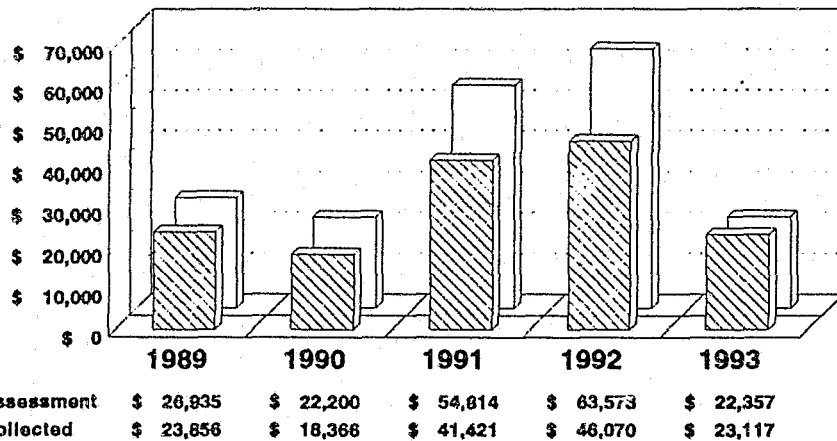

Placement assessments in 1993 have decreased 65% over 1992 by \$41,216.

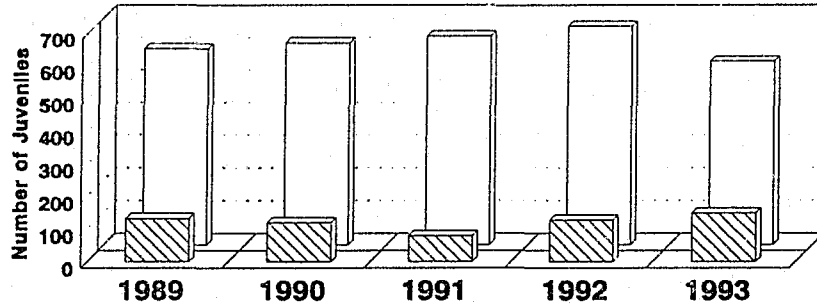

### Placement Fees Assessment and Collection

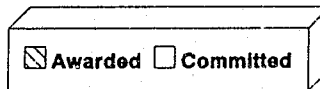

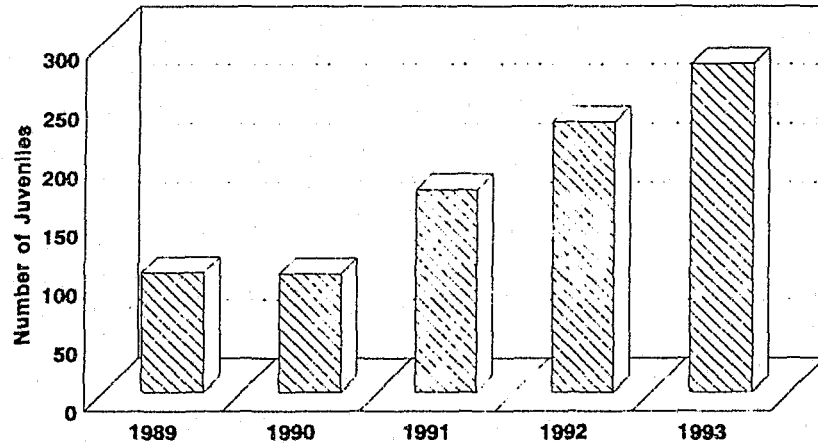

Originally in 1993 there were 281 juveniles transferred to Adult Court, one case was appealed.

A transfer hearing (or remand) is held on the motion of the County Attorney.

The Juvenile Court has the exclusive responsibility for making the decision to remand a juvenile for transfer for adult criminal prosecution.

The number of transfers to adult criminal court in 1993 increased by 21% over 1992 for a total of 280 juveniles being transferred. The number of prior complaints or referrals has decreased slightly from 8.8 in 1991 to 8.2 in 1993.

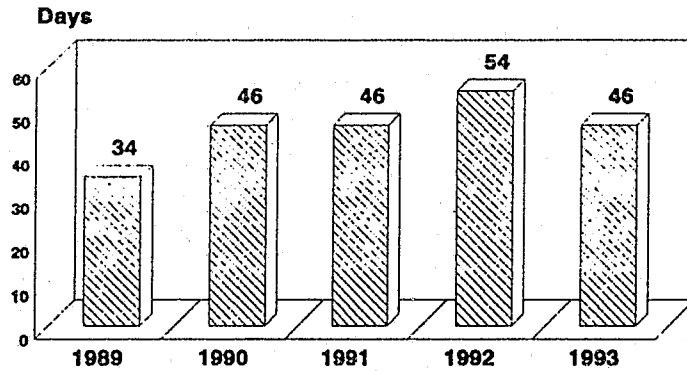

## Intake Caseload Cite-In First Set

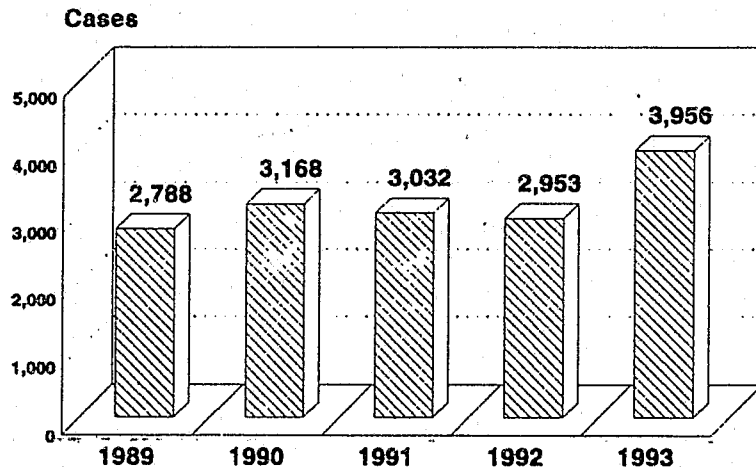


Average Number of Days from Complaint to Cite-In.

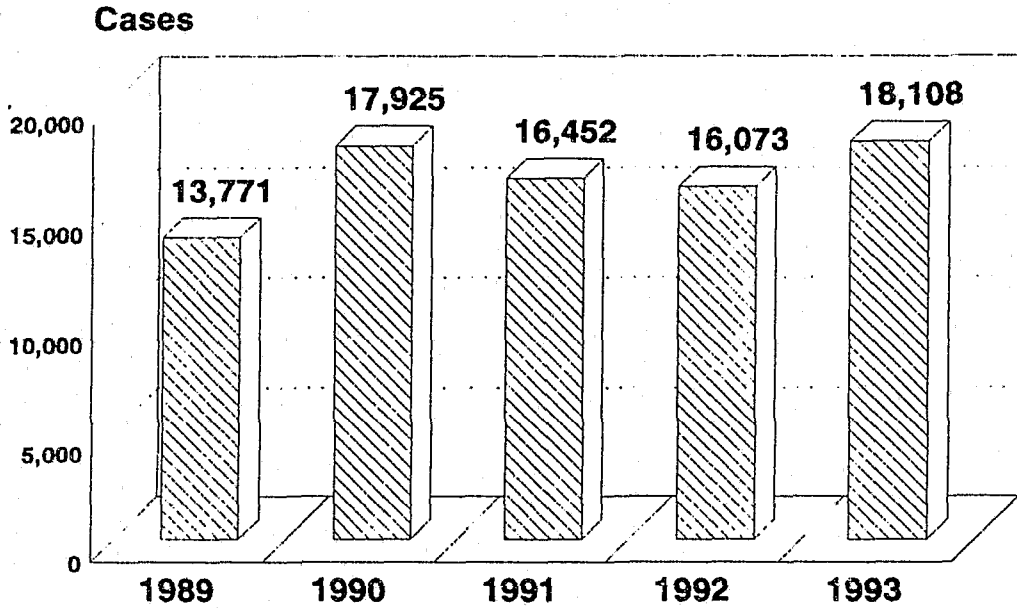
The intake cite-in is the interview of the referred juvenile and parent(s) at the Juvenile Court by an Intake Officer. Generally, these juveniles are first and second referral misdemeanors or status offenders. The Intake Officer has the discretion to handle the referral without initiating a formal court process.

The above graph shows the average number of days to first cite-in, measuring how quickly the Intake Division is able to get to the caseload assigned. In 1993, it took 46 days, the same as in 1990 and 1991. It took 54 days in 1992. A second measure is the number of pending (unfinished) cases is shown in the graph to the right. There were 3,956 pending cases in 1993, a 34% increase from 2,953 pending cases in 1992.

# Intake Caseload New Referrals Received



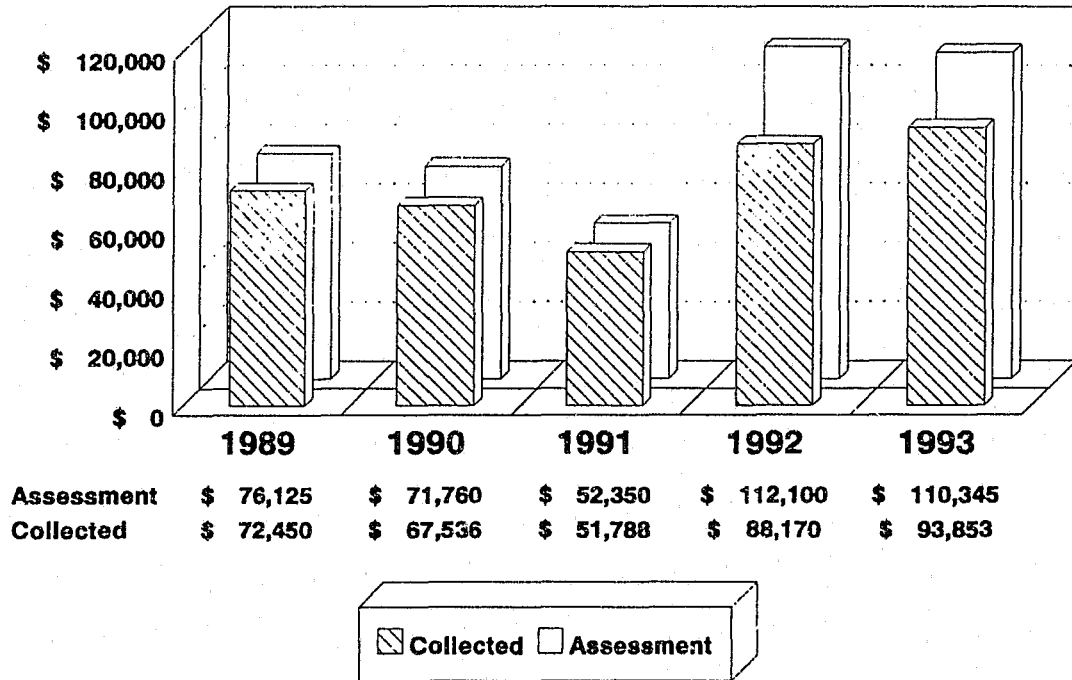
Referrals (complaints) where no formal petition is filed may be adjusted by the Intake Officer after the initial interview with the juvenile and parent(s). If the juvenile has acknowledged involvement in the alleged offense, the matter will not be adjusted until specific conditions established by the Probation Officer are met. Conditions of adjust may include referral to community agencies for family counseling, individual

counseling, specialized education, and awareness programs such as alcohol and drug abuse, restitution to victims, voluntary work hours in the community, and other similar options.

The number of New Referrals Received has shown an increase from 16,073 in 1992 to 18,108 New Referrals in 1993, a 32% increase in the last 5 years.

# PIC-ACT

## Assessment and Collection



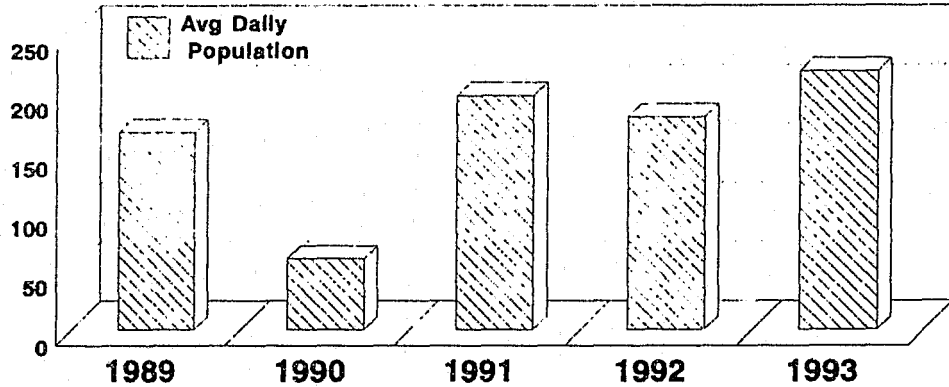
The Progressively Increasing Consequences Act (PIC-ACT) became effective through legislative action on July 1, 1984. If after conducting an intake interview with the alleged juvenile offender and parent(s), and the juvenile acknowledges responsibility for the delinquent act or alcohol offense, the Juvenile Probation Officer may adjust the delinquency complaint once the juvenile has complied with specific conditions.

Assessments made for Intake Services in 1993 have decreased 1.6% over 1992 to \$110,345, and collections have

increased 6.5% over 1992 to \$93,853 for 1993.

This legislation concentrates on first and second time offenders in hopes of eliminating future delinquent behavior patterns before they become firmly established. The development of PIC-ACT centers on the debate of whether holding youthful offenders more accountable for their delinquent behavior will result in a lower incidence of recidivism. Programs sponsored under PIC-ACT are currently in operation in all fifteen counties in Arizona.

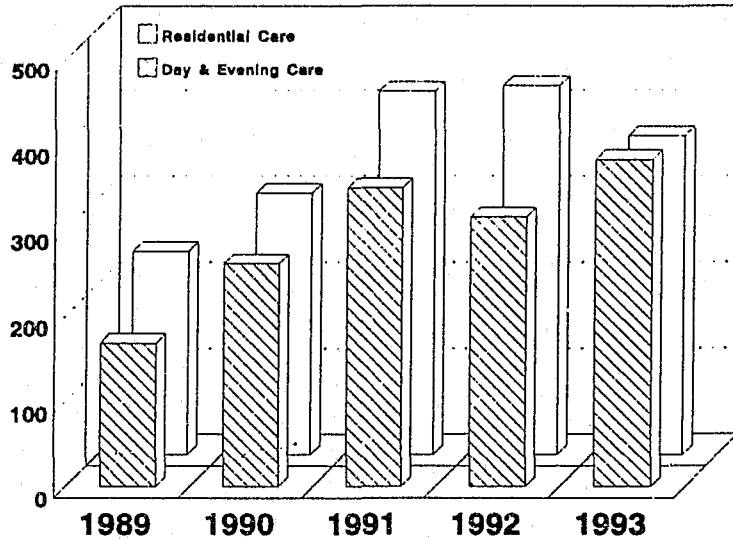

Home Detention is an alternative between structured institutional detention and unconditional release back into the community. Juveniles originally held in the juvenile detention facility, but being allowed to return home pending Court, may be assigned to Home Detention. In this program, the juvenile's freedom is greatly restricted and the Home Detention staff maintain frequent and close contact with the juvenile on an unannounced basis to assure

compliance with the conditions of release.

As compared to 1992, juveniles placed on Home Detention increased slightly from 1,640 to 1,839 in 1993. Juveniles released, also increased from 1,618 in 1992 to 1,796 in 1993. The average daily population in Home Detention is 219 juveniles with an average length of stay of 37.9 days in 1993.

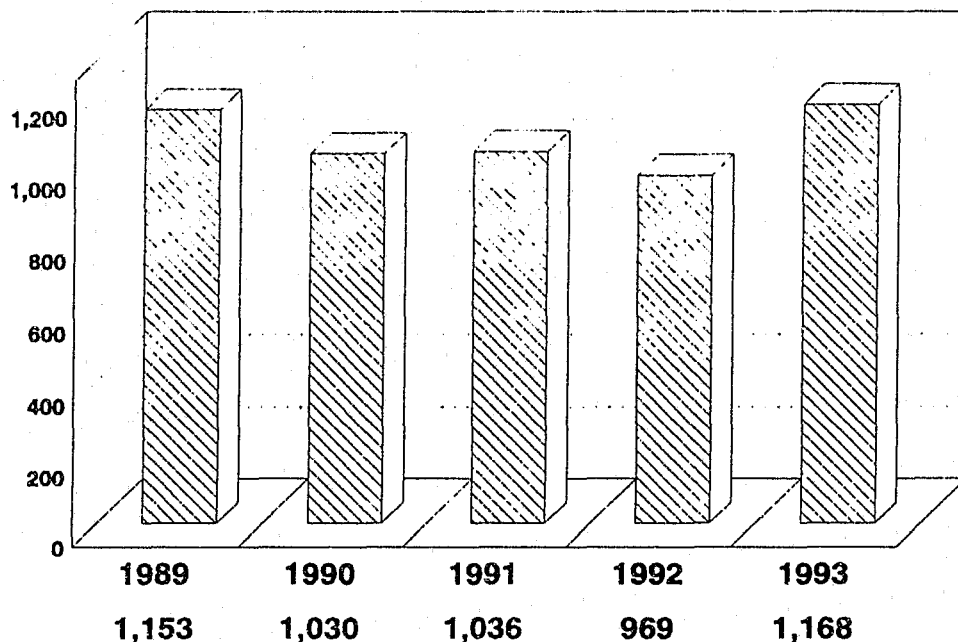

The number of juveniles in Placement during 1993 was 371 juveniles in Residential Care and 381 juveniles in Day and Evening Care.

Residential placement has increased by 57% from 1989 to 1993, with a peak of 430 juveniles in 1992. Day and Evening Care has increased 154% in the same 5 years.



# Diversion Programs



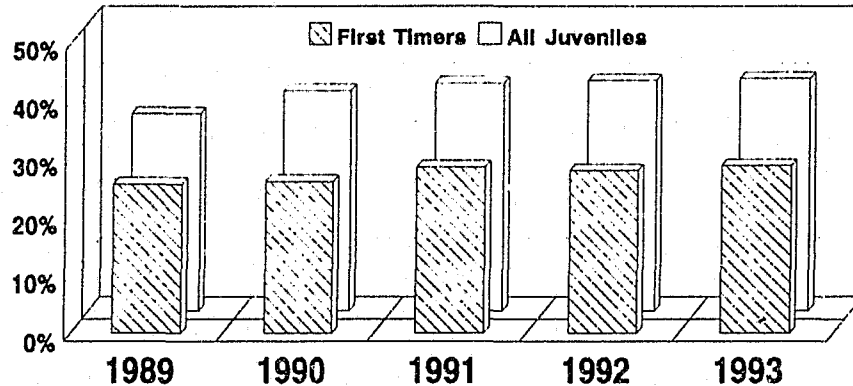
Diversion programs are established and supervised by various municipalities for the needs of some first time offenders in their communities. These programs are developed by agreement with the Court Center as provided by statute.

Several municipalities within Maricopa County have designed First Offender Programs to work with juveniles in the community.

Cities such as Phoenix, Mesa, Tempe, Glendale, Peoria, Scottsdale, Williams Air Force Base, Chandler, and Gilbert have various types of diversion programs for the first time offender.

The number of juveniles assigned to diversion programs in 1993 has not changed much from the number of juveniles assigned in 1989. 1992 had the lowest in the past 5 years with 969 juveniles.

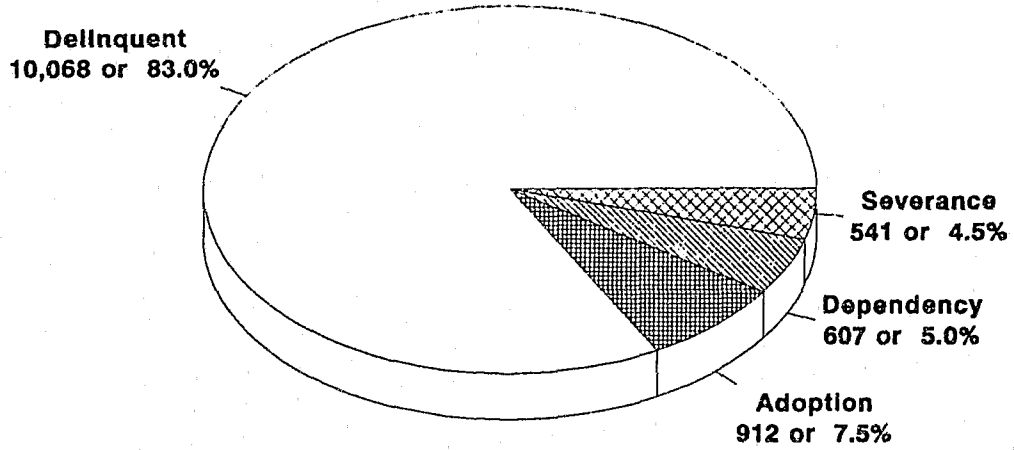

In this table, recidivism is defined as the probability of a subsequent referral within one year of the initial referral, i.e., the probability of a subsequent arrest (guilt may not have been determined). Administrative offenses (Holds), and technical probation violations (i.e., no law violation charged) are not counted as initial referrals or subsequent referrals. Juveniles 17 years or older at the initial referral, are not considered. As soon as a juvenile reaches the age of 18, the Juvenile Court loses all jurisdiction over that person.

Two samples are used above. The sample called "First Timers" utilized only the first referral to Juvenile Court as the initial referral, while "All Juveniles" utilize any referral except an administrative offense or probation violation.

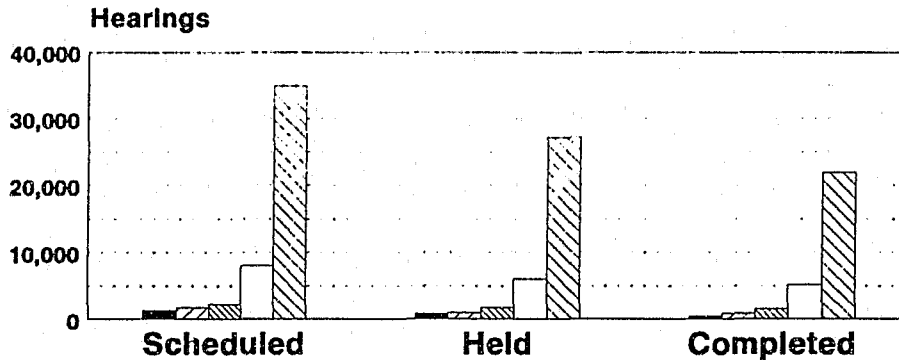
Juveniles recidivating has been gradually increasing over the past five years. In 1993, approximately 29% of all First Time Offenders recidivate, and approximately 40% of All Juveniles recidivate.

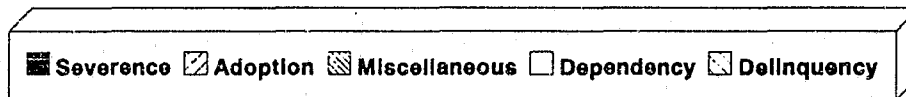

A Scheduled hearing is set before a particular judicial officer on a particular day and time, though for many hearings (advisories for instance) several may be "stacked" at the same time. A hearing categorized as Held, is one with a recorded start and end time. A Completed hearing is one showing a result of completed, under advisement, or conditional

(applying to dispositions).

In 1993, a total of 48,253 hearings were scheduled, 36,744 hearings were held, and 29,903 hearings were completed. Approximately 72% of these hearings were for delinquency matters.
