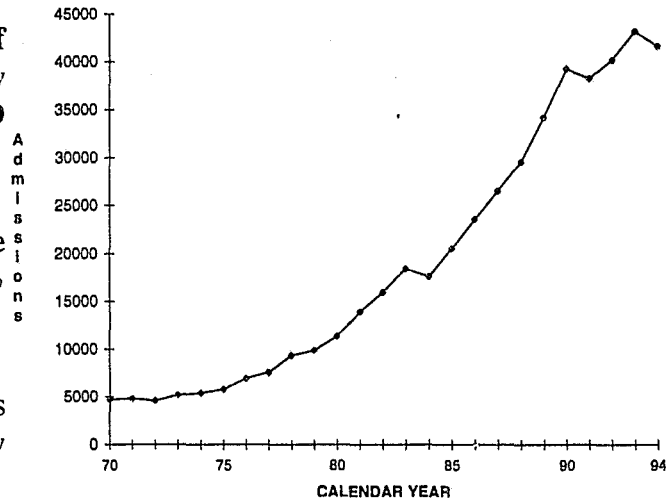
FELON NEW ADMISSIONS

During Calendar Year 1994, the number of California Department of Corrections felon new admissions decreased to 41,580 from 43,149 during 1993.

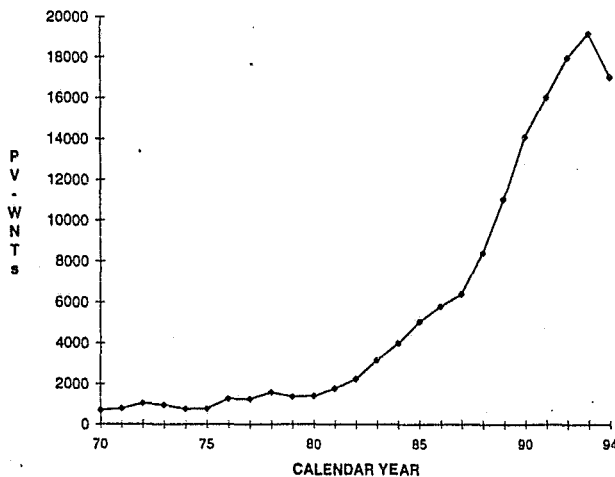
Felon new admissions increased 136.2% since 1984, 21.5% since 1989 and decreased 3.6% since 1993.

- The number of male felon new admissions was 37,545 and the number of female felon new admissions was 4,035.

**PAROLE VIOLATORS RETURNED
 WITH A NEW TERM**

During Calendar Year 1994, Parole Violators Returned With a New Term (PV-WNTs) decreased to 17,009 during 1994.

- This represents an increase of 326.5% since 1984, 54.1% since 1989 and decreased 11.2% since 1993.
- There were 15,767 male PV-WNTs and 1,242 female PV-WNTs.
