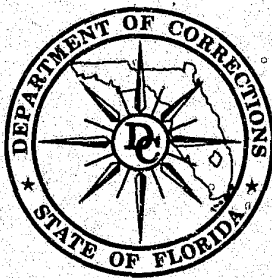

## County Detention Facilities

APRIL 1995

### Inmate Profile Summary

This County Detention Facilities Summary provides a monthly profile of Florida's detention facility inmate populations. Monthly Average Daily Population (ADP) figures include male, female, adult and juvenile inmates.

These population figures are arranged into felony, misdemeanor and "other" subcategories in Table 1. "Other" includes the number of parole violators, state inmates, undocumented aliens, holdings for other jurisdictions and individuals detained under the Baker (mental health) and Myers (alcoholism) Acts. Within both felony and misdemeanor subcategories, the number of inmates sentenced, held for trial or sentencing, and those detained or sentenced for violation of probation are listed.

Table 2 features the Average Daily Population and incarceration rate in each county. Table 3 lists the capacity of each county detention facility in Florida, including its percentage over or under capacity. County detention facilities with amended capacities since March 1995 are also noted in Table 3. Table 4 lists the number and percent of felony and misdemeanor pretrial inmates at each detention facility.

The 1995 Jail Population Summary at the end of this report lists detention center totals for the year to date.

**COUNTY DETENTION FACILITIES  
PROFILE SUMMARY  
April 1995**

**Average Daily Population**

On the average, there were 40,149 inmates in Florida's county detention facilities during the month of April 1995. This figure represents a 1.1 percent increase in the inmate population from that reported for March 1995. The statewide average daily (ADP) totals for April 1995 include 34,780 adult males (86.7%), 4,265 adult females (10.6%), 1,060 juvenile males (2.6%) and 44 juvenile females (.1%). The overall distribution of male and female inmates has remained constant in county detention facilities for the past six years. The following provides an analysis of the inmate population for April 1995:

**APRIL 1995 JAIL POPULATION RECAP**

\* 73.2% of the total inmate population were incarcerated for felony offenses, while 20.6% were detained for misdemeanor crimes. All others confined amounted to 6.2% of the total population.

\* Juveniles accounted for only 1,104 or 2.7% of the overall inmate population, with the majority (1,060) being male. Most juveniles (98.5%) were charged with felonies.

\* The majority (89.3% or 35,840) of those incarcerated in county detention facilities in March were male.

\* Offenders held for trial represented 57.1% of the inmate population.

### Incarceration Rates

In April 1995, the statewide county detention incarceration rate was 2.9 per 1,000 county residents based on the population estimates for 1994. Incarceration rates ranged from a low of 1.0 in Union County, to a high of 8.9 in Wakulla County. Wakulla County's high incarceration rate is the direct result of holding a large portion of their inmate population for the U. S. Marshal's Service. Other counties may also be experiencing high incarceration rates due to the contracting of bed space for state and federal inmates.

### Overcrowding: Capacity vs. Population

In March 1995, 13 of 105 facilities reporting had average daily inmate populations which exceeded their Department of Corrections (DC) rated capacity. The percent over capacity ranged from a low of 1.1% (Santa Rosa County Jail) to a high of 47.2% (Osceola County Jail). The remaining 92 facilities were at or below capacity.

### Pretrial Population Levels

During the month of April 1995, 22,926 of the inmates housed in county detention facilities were classified as awaiting trial. Of these, 19,099 offenders (83.3%) were awaiting trial for felony offenses while 3,827 (16.7%) were detained for misdemeanor violations. Of the 66 counties reporting, 43 had over half of their jail populations awaiting trial.
