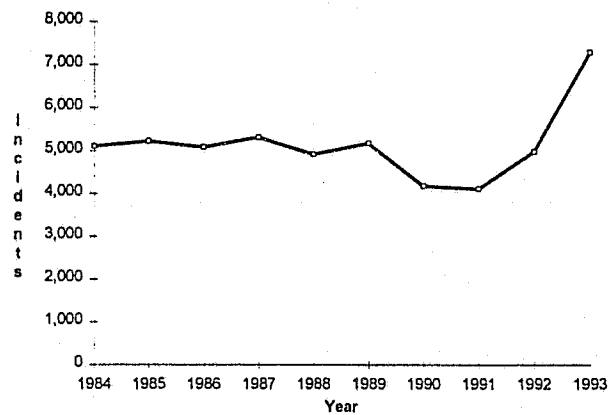
INMATE INCIDENTS

During Calendar Year 1993:

TOTAL NUMBER OF INCIDENTS

There were 6,243 inmate incidents in the California Department of Corrections institutions and camps. The number of incidents increased 1,261 (25.3%) from the total of 4,982 in 1992.

Calendar Year 1984 through 1993

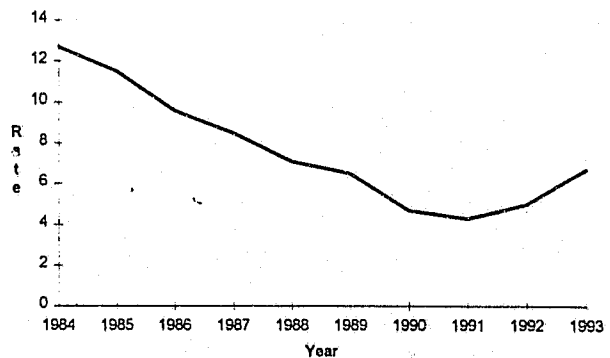


RATE OF INCIDENTS

The rate of incidents increased from 5.0 in 1992 to 5.7 in 1993.

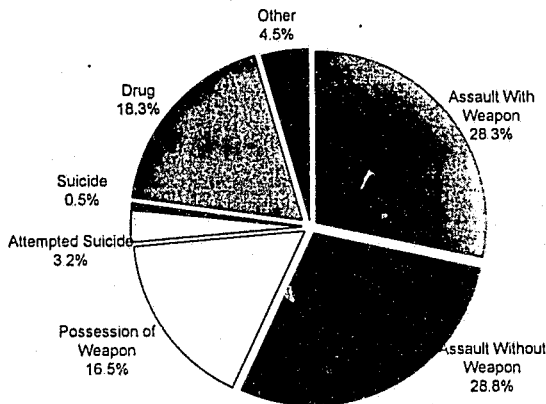
Since 1984, the rate of incidents has steadily decreased from 12.7 in 1984 to 5.7 in 1993.

TYPE OF INCIDENTS

Assaults accounted for 3,563 (57.1%) of the total incidents. Assaults with a weapon accounted for 1,767 (28.3%), assaults without a weapon 1,796 (28.8%).

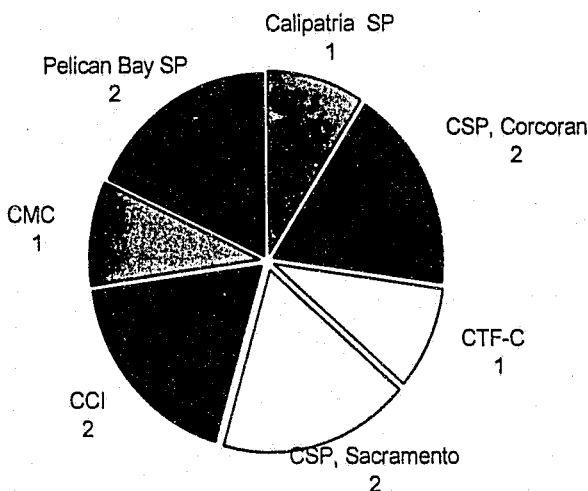
Assault incidents increased from 2,822 in 1992 to 3,563 in 1993. The increase was closely distributed between assaults with and without a weapon.

Drug incidents accounted for 1,141 (18.3%) of the total incidents.

Marijuana accounted for 685 (60.0%) of the drug incidents, Opiates 297 (26.0%) and Other Drugs 159 (13.9%).

Drug incidents increased from 863 in 1992 to 1,141 in 1993.

FATAL ASSAULTS

Eleven male inmates were fatally assaulted in 1993. The number of fatalities increased from 9 in 1992 to 11 in 1993.

The number of inmates stabbed to death decreased from 32 in 1972 to zero in 1993.

There have been 15 fatal assaults on staff since 1970. The last one occurred in 1985.

INMATE INCIDENTS

NUMBER OF ASSAULTS ON STAFF

In 1993, there were 1,416 assaults on staff. Of these, 501 (35.4%) involved the use of weapons by inmates.

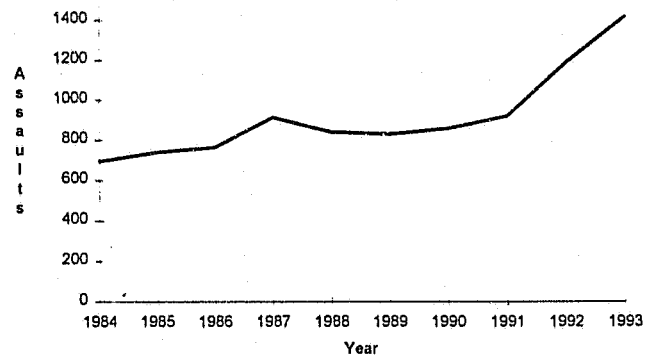
Assaults on staff increased from 1,188 in 1992 to 1,416 in 1993.

Assaults on staff at Pelican Bay increased from 136 in 1992 to 191 in 1993.

Assaults on staff at Folsom decreased from 115 in 1986 to 23 in 1993.

Assaults on staff at CIW have steadily decreased from 60 in 1986 to 5 in 1993.

RATE OF ASSAULTS ON STAFF

The rate of inmate assaults on staff has steadily decreased from 1.7 per 100 average daily institution population in 1984 to 1.3 in 1993.

The rate of inmate assaults on staff increased from 1.2 in 1992 to 1.3 in 1993.

Calendar Year 1984 through 1993

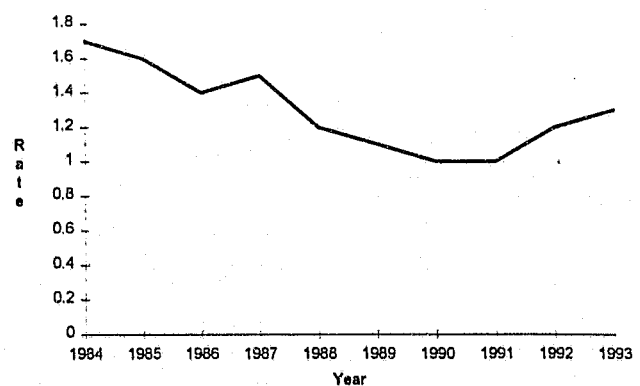
