**State of Arkansas  
Annual Crime Summary  
January-December 1996**

Slightly more than 118,000 index crimes were reported to law enforcement agencies throughout Arkansas during the year, an increase of 1% compared to last year.

For this period of 1996, violent crime (murder, rape, robbery and aggravated assault) decreased 4% compared to 1995. Murder showed the largest decrease (-15%), followed by robbery (-8%), and aggravated assault (-4%). The only violent crime showing an increase was rape (+13%).

Property crime (burglary, theft, motor vehicle theft and arson) has increased 2% compared to last year. The number of thefts alone increased from 69,589 in 1995 to 72,789 in 1996, an increase of 5%. Burglary and motor vehicle theft are down 3%.

Compared to 1995, total arrests increased 4%, from 195,060 in 1995 to 202,490 in 1996. Arrests for violent crime offenses increased only 1%. Driving under the influence (DUI) arrests decreased 3% and arrests for weapon possession decreased 16%. The largest increases were for drug arrests; a 7% increase overall, with sale of marijuana arrests up 14%; marijuana possession arrests up 17%, and cocaine possession arrests up 14%.

The value of property stolen in connection with index crimes amounted to \$107 million resulting in an increase from last year of 3%. Recovered property for 1996 amounted to \$45.4 million resulting in a recovery rate of 42%. The value of stolen motor vehicles was \$48.4 million with \$36.3 million recovered, a recovery rate of 75%.

Although burglary offenses decreased 3% from 1995, the value of stolen property taken during this crime increased slightly with the main increase occurring in day time residential burglary, up 4%.

There were 313 assaults on law enforcement officers, a decrease of 25% from 1995. Forty percent (40%) of the officers sustained injuries compared to 48% in 1995. Almost one-third of the assaults occurred during a response to a disturbance call.
