

TIME SPENT IN CARE BY CHILDREN SERVED IN THE FOSTER CARE PROGRAM in NEW YORK STATE, 1973

This brief examines the active foster care caseload in New York State as of December 31, 1973 with respect to the amount of time spent in care by foster children. In this report "time in care" is synonymous with "length of stay," and refers to the aggregate amount of time in a child's life that he has received foster care services—excluding any interruptions—and not merely the duration of the current placement. This report excludes children assigned to the New York State Training School System but does include 377 out—of—State children in the New York State caseload who have not been separately enumerated. The State total is therefore greater than the sum of the New York City and Upstate caseloads.

The average time in care decreased for each age group from 1969 to 1973. At the same time, there was a significant shift in the age distribution of the children in care. In 1969, ll percent of foster children in this State were under one year of age and 36 percent were under six. Four years later these proportions had dropped to 4 and 23 percent respectively. There was only a slight increase in the percentage of children six to nine years old, but for those over ten the increase was from 46 percent in 1969 to 56 percent in 1973. This caused the median age of foster children to increase from 8.3 years to nearly ll years. Thus the age distribution shifted toward the older children and the normally higher average stays of these children tended to inflate the overall average length of stay.

These two conditions created an apparent paradox. In 1968 the average length of stay of all children in foster care in New York State was 2.85 years. One year later this average had increased to 3.00 years and by the end of 1973, half of all children in care had spent at least 3.56 years in foster care (Table 4). Therefore, although the average length of time in each age group declined, the overall average length of stay increased because more of the caseload was concentrated in the older age groups.

This phenomenon also occurred in New York City where the average age of children in care rose from 9.2 in 1969 to 10.9 in 1973. Consequently, the increased proportion of older children who had been in foster care for longer periods contributed heavily to the increase in the average length of stay. The median length of stay of each individual age group decreased, in some cases substantially (see Table 1), while the overall average rose from 3.57 years in 1969 to 3.97 in 1973.

The situation was slightly different in the rest of the State. Upstate, the change in the average age from 1969 to 1973 (9.0 to 11.1) was accompanied by an increase in the length of stay among children in the 9 to 13 years age group. These factors combined to raise the median length of stay even more dramatically-23 percent, from 2.44 years to 3.00 years.



The overall length of stay in 1973 was nearly a year greater in New York City than Upstate, but the gap has narrowed slightly since 1969. New York City children in every age bracket had spent more time in care than similarly aged children Upstate (Tables 5 and 6). The most obvious disparities between the two regions were for children ages 7 and 8 who, on the average, were in care a year longer in New York City and for those 13 and over for whom the differences ranged from 1.1 to 2.8 years. Forty-six percent of foster children Upstate under 6 years of age had been in care less than 1 full year while the figure for New York City was only 29 percent. About 24 percent of New York City children over age 13 had spent more than 13 years in foster care, but only 15 percent of such children Upstate had been in care that long. Older children are more likely to be in institutions than younger ones.

At the end of 1973, 5 percent of children in foster homes were under 1 year of age and nearly 30 percent were under 6 (see Tables 2 and 3). In contrast, less than 1 percent of institutionalized children had yet to reach their first birthday and only 4 percent were under 6. The median age of foster home children was 9.4 years as compared to 14 years for those in institutional care. It should be noted that the modality of care indicated refers only to the current placement and does not necessarily apply to the child's entire foster care experience.

Forty-three percent of all children living in foster homes in 1973 had received foster care services for 5 years or more and 18 percent for 10 years or more. This contrasts with only 25 and 8 percent of those institutionalized. Among school-age children (6 and over), the difference in length of stay with respect to type of care is even more dramatic. Fifty-nine percent of such children living in foster homes had been in care for over 5 years compared with only 26 percent of those in institutions. The median length of stay of all foster home children was 4.03 years and for those institutionalized, 2.05 years.


