INTRCDOUCTION

THE TABLES WHICH FOLLOW DESCRIBE THE COURT COMMITMENTS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION DURING 1974. THEY ARE DERIVED FROM THE COMPUTERIZED DATA BASE DEVELOPED BY THE CORRECTION AND PAROLE MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM AND PREPARED BY THE RESEARCH UNIT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION ON THE MASSACHUSETTS STATE COLLEGE COMPUTER NETWORK.

THIS REPORT IS INTENDED TO GIVE AN OVERVIEW OF COMMITMENT, CRIMINAL HISTORY AND BACKGROUND DATA ON ADMISSIONS FROM COURTS TO MCI-WALPOLE, CONCORD AND FRAMINGHAM. IT IS INTENDED AS A BASIC REFERENCE DOCUMENT TO ANSWER QUESTIONS SUCH AS:  
HOW DOES AGE AT COMMITMENT COMPARE BETWEEN WALPOLE AND CONCORD.  
HOW EXTENSIVE IS THE CRIMINAL HISTORY OF CONCORD COMMITMENTS.  
HOW MANY FIRST OFFENDERS WERE COMMITTED TO WALPOLE, TO FRAMINGHAM.  
ON THE OTHER HAND, IT IS INTENDED THAT PERSONS WITH SPECIAL INFORMATION NEEDS WILL AVAIL THEMSELVES OF THIS DATA. FOR INSTANCE, IT MAY BE USEFUL TO KNOW HOW MANY PERSONS WERE COMMITTED FROM THE SPRINGFIELD AREA AND SOME DATA ABOUT DRUG USE BY THOSE PERSONS FOR PLANNING PURPOSES. THIS SORT OF QUESTION CAN BE EASILY ANSWERED BY THE RESEARCH UNIT AND WOULD BE HANDLED AS AN INFORMATION REQUEST. IN OTHER WORDS, THIS REPORT IS NOT EXPECTED TO MEET EVERY INFORMATION NEED, BUT IT DOES PROVIDE AN INDICATION OF THE RANGE OF DATA THAT IS AVAILABLE IN COMPUTERIZED FORM.

EACH OF THESE TABLES HAS A SEPARATE VARIABLE CROSSTABULATED AGAINST INSTITUTION COMMITTED TO. THE NUMBER OF MISSING OBSERVATIONS LINE AFTER EACH TABLE DEFINES THE NUMBER OF CASES FOR WHICH DATA WAS UNAVAILABLE FOR THE VARIABLE.

A GLOSSARY OF TERMS IS INCLUDED AT THE END OF THIS REPORT. ANY QUESTIONS SHOULD BE DIRECTED TO THE RESEARCH UNIT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION.

LAST ADDRESS BY PLANNING DISTRICT, PAGE 8: MUNICIPALITIES WERE GROUPED ACCORDING TO THE SUB-STATE PLANNING DISTRICTS DELINEATED BY THE EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF HUMAN SERVICES. METRO AREA REFERS TO THE BOSTON AREA.
