1975 COUNTY JAIL AND DETENTION FACILITY REPORT

This bulletin makes available state-wide information on adult and juvenile confinements to county detention facilities in Wisconsin during calendar year 1975. Included in the category of county detention facilities are: county jails, Brown County Reforestation Camp, Dane County Huber Center, Green County Alternate Detention Center, Milwaukee House of Correction, and the four juvenile detention centers located in Dane, Green, Milwaukee, and Racine counties. City and village lockup information is included in this publication as Appendix Table 1.

The Wisconsin Division of Corrections, Department of Health and Social Services, has a statutory responsibility for collecting state-wide information on populations held in county and municipal detention facilities. This information currently is aggregated and reported annually by personnel of the various detention facilities who transmit it to the Division of Corrections where it is checked for accuracy and consistency and then assembled for publication.

There has been an increasing demand by planning agencies, local and state government, criminal justice agencies in Wisconsin and other states, and by the general public for more meaningful information about persons confined and detained within county detention facilities. To satisfy these demands, the Division of Corrections has conducted a feasibility study and developed a system design to determine the best and most efficient method of collecting basic admission and release data for adults confined in county jails.

In December 1975, a pilot project was initiated in six county jails to test a specific multi-part data collection instrument, using a revised jail register form as the base. A Jail Information Advisory Committee consisting of representatives from local law enforcement, local government, state planning agencies, and the general public was established to monitor the project and make recommendations.

The goals of the project are:

- 1) to increase the capability to study persons detained and incarcerated within the county detention facilities; and
- 2) to develop a uniform recordkeeping and reporting system to record significant information for the purposes of planning, program development, and program evaluation.

In the design of this revised information system, data elements were defined to insure compliance with jail register requirements under Wisconsin Statute 59.23(2), and that the system would be simple and provide accurate, timely, and meaningful information.

- 1) Data collection does not appreciably increase the workload of county detention facility personnel.
- 2) Privacy rights and confidentiality are protected.
- 3) Useful information is provided on a regular basis.

#### SUMMARY OF 1975 COUNTY JAIL AND DETENTION FACILITY DATA

There were over 88,000 reported confinements in county detention facilities during calendar year 1975, including over 70,000 adult and over 17,000 juvenile confinements (Tables 1 and 5). The term "confinements" is used here specifically because the figures do not represent the number of different individuals confined, but rather, the total number of confinements. It is known that many individuals were confined in county detention facilities more than once during the 1975 calendar year. However, there are no data specifying an unduplicated number of people held.

Each table within this bulletin is categorized by institution of confinement (detaining facility) and sex.

Information on adult confinements presented in Tables 1 and 3 is categorized into two further groupings--number held and number sentenced. Number of adults sentenced is but one type of disposition or status reflecting detentions in county detention facilities. An adult arrested and held in a county jail may have many possible arrest dispositions--being dismissed, fined, given a term of probation, sentenced to a county detention facility, or sentenced to a state correctional facility. During 1975, approximately 20 percent of all adult confinements had been reported as also sentenced to county detention facilities.\*

As might be expected, the more populous counties generally had the greater number of confinements; e.g., during 1975, Milwaukee County institutions accounted for 26 percent of all adult confinements, 28 percent of all adult sentences, and 24 percent of all juvenile detentions. State-wide, females accounted for less than seven percent of total adult confinements, less than four percent of total adult sentences, and less than 31 percent of total juvenile detentions.

Unpublished information obtained from Wisconsin's Crime Information Bureau indicates that during 1975, there were 67,600 juvenile male arrests and 21,986 juvenile female arrests. Association of those statistics with the detention totals in Table 5 shows that more than 24 percent of all the juvenile female arrests resulted in detention. Of juvenile male arrests, approximately 18 percent resulted in detention. Juvenile females thus had a substantially higher detention rate than did juvenile males.

There was more than a five percent decrease in the number of juvenile confinements during calendar year 1975 as compared with the previous year (Table 5). The number of adult confinements increased almost seven percent, while those with actual sentences decreased almost seven percent.

\*The percentage of sentenced cases to the total number of adult confinements can only be approximated because of the lack of uniformity in recordkeeping within the various county jails. In some jails, persons are booked each time they enter the facility. Therefore, a person booked, released on bond, and subsequently sentenced to jail under the original charge would be counted twice in some facilities and only once in others.

Table 2 reports confinements by reason for holding: alcohol violations, drug violations, alleged mental illness (for adults only), and all other types. More than 17 percent of all adult confinements\* and approximately seven percent of all juvenile confinements were for alcohol violations (Tables 2 and 5). Drug violations accounted for less than five percent of total adult confinements and less than three percent of juvenile confinements. There were 350 adult confinements for alleged mental illness, 72 fewer than for 1974 and 146 fewer than for 1973. More than 77 percent of the remaining adult confinements and more than 90 percent of the juvenile confinements were not defined as to reason for holding.

Information in Table 4 relates to length of detention of juveniles in county detention facilities. Of the total number of juvenile confinements, almost 30 percent were for a duration of under one day, approximately 37 percent for one to two days, and the remaining 33 percent for over two days. These percentages were about the same as for 1974. Only six percent of all juvenile detentions lasted over ten days, with the majority (65 percent) occurring in juvenile detention centers. Total state-wide detentions in juvenile detention centers for over ten days (1,070) were about the same in 1975 as in 1974 (1,073). Detentions of short duration most commonly occurred in the county jails. Detention center confinements (Dane, Green, Milwaukee, and Racine Counties) accounted for approximately 38 percent of total juvenile confinements.

The Dane County Huber Center, opened in December 1974, reported 203 sentenced adult males in 1975. The Green County Alternate Detention Center was opened in January 1975 for housing adult females and juveniles. This facility reported one adult female confinement and one male juvenile in 1975.

During the first full week of January 1975, county personnel were asked to make two one-day counts of adults and juveniles confined in their facilities. The counts were taken on specified days, one during the week and the other on a weekend. Exact counts are shown in Tables 3 and 6. Total

one-day counts of juveniles held on both weekday and weekend decreased more than nine percent from counts taken one year previously. Total one-day counts of adults held and adults sentenced increased more than eight percent from counts taken the previous year, with increases appearing in all adult categories.

There were two reported adult natural deaths and six suicides, including one juvenile, in county penal institutions during 1975. Fifty-five people were reported as having escaped from the jail facilities, representing almost a 28 percent increase from 1974. Seventy-four adults with outside privileges under the Huber Law reportedly walked away during the calendar year, a decrease of more than 65 percent from 1974.

There were 74 approved municipal lockups\* in Wisconsin in 1975, with the City of Milwaukee having seven district lockups. Local lockups differ from county detention facilities in that they can only be used to confine unsentenced persons for short periods of time (usually less than 48 hours) until either bond or initial court appearance is made. Persons held awaiting trial are transferred to county detention facilities.

A total of 49,724 confinements was reported in city and village lockups in 1975, of which 43,276 were adult and 6,448 juvenile (Appendix 1). While these figures represent more than a five percent decrease in total municipal confinements from 1974, juvenile municipal confinements increased 10 percent. The district lockups in the City of Milwaukee accounted for 76 percent of all adult confinements and 74 percent of all juvenile confinements. State-wide, females accounted for approximately nine percent of total adult confinements and 20 percent of total juvenile confinements.

\*In 1974 there were 80 approved municipal lockups, although six of them (Appleton, Brandon, Kaukauna, Kiel, Tigerton and Weyauwega) reported no confinements for that year. The six municipal lockups were not approved as holding facilities for calendar year 1975.

There were two reported adult suicides and no reported escapes in lockups during 1975.
