COMMITMENTS TO COUNTY AND CITY
JAILS AND CITY JAIL FARMS
YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 1976

During fiscal year 1976 there were 137,597 commitments to county and city jails and city jail farms, which represented a 7.7 percent decline in commitments from fiscal year 1975 when 149,092 persons were committed.

Race and Sex:

Of the total commitments 67 percent were white and 33 percent were non-white. The racial balance from fiscal 1975 to fiscal 1976 showed no significant change.

Age:

There were 5,361 commitments of persons under 18 years of age. Compared to the previous year this represented a drop of 1,212 or 18.4 percent from this age group. The age group having the highest frequency rate was again 20-24 years of age, which accounted for 23.8 percent of the commitments.

Offenses:

An analysis of the offenses for fiscal year 1976 shows that those against decency, peace and good order were most frequent (45,530 or 33.1 percent); offenses against property were second, with 27,937 or 20.3 percent; and violations of traffic and vehicle laws were third with 25,717 commitments. In fiscal year 1975 it is significant to note that violations of traffic and vehicle laws were second and offenses against property were third. Within the refined breakdown of offenses, the two most common were drunkenness/drunk and disorderly, accounting once again for one-fourth of all commitments (34,173 or 24.8 percent), and driving under the influence of intoxicants (14,685 or 10.7 percent of all commitments). Incarceration in jail due to violation of the narcotic drug laws numbered 5,992 or 4.4 percent of the total commitments. This represented a 13.1 percent decrease from fiscal year 1975.

Type of Offense:

Of the total commitments, more than half were charged with misdemeanors (70,174 or 51 percent), which indicated a 15.9 percent decline in this type of commitment from fiscal year 1975. The persons committed on local ordinances ("other offenses") numbered 34,689 (25.2 percent) while 32,730 (23.8 percent) were in under felony offenses.

Place Committed From:

Virginia counties accounted for 55.4 percent of the jail commitments, and the cities 44.6 percent. Of the 76,233 commitments by counties, Fairfax had by far the largest number, with 9,328. Arlington, with 3,763, and Henrico, with 3,572, represented the second and third largest number of county commitments, respectively. Of the 61,364 city commitments, Norfolk accounted for 11,904, while Roanoke had 9,110 and Richmond, 6,253.

Average Number of Days in Jail Per Commitment:

The average length of stay in jail per commitment during fiscal 1976 was 13.6 days, compared to an average of 10.3 days in fiscal 1975.

Average Daily Population of Jails:

The average daily population of the jails during the fiscal year 1976 was 5,126, compared to 4,217 in fiscal 1975.

APPENDIX I
EXPLANATION OF COVERAGE

A separate commitment is reported each time a person is confined in jail on a charge of having violated a law or ordinance, for being inebriate or insane, as a material witness in a criminal case, for investigation, for protection, or for any other legal reason. The confinement may be before or after adjudication of the case in which the prisoner is involved. A person who is recommitted after being released on bond or otherwise released, is reported each time the person is placed in jail.

APPENDIX II
DATA SOURCE

The statistics contained in this report were obtained from the Forms DC-J6, Record of Prisoners Confined in Jail. These forms are submitted monthly by the individual jails and jail farms to the Department of Corrections, Bureau of Institutional Services, Jails Reimbursement Section. The primary function of these documents is to serve as a basis for determining costs of operation and amount of State reimbursement for local jails and city jail farms. To serve the secondary function, that of providing statistical data, the forms are then transmitted to the Bureau of Electronic Data Processing, Production Section, which edits the pertinent data and computer processes them. The resulting computer prints are then used by the Reporting Section to compile statistical reports. All prisoner day figures, calculated by the individual jails, are manually edited by the Jails Reimbursement Section, and are not computer processed.
