RELATING TO SUBSTANCE ABUSE IN SOUTH CAROLINA

I. INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this report is to provide managers, planners, evaluators, and other users a useful display of substance abuse arrest data for South Carolina. No attempt is made herein to present suggested approaches to analyzing the data, nor are any conclusions concerning the meaning of the data provided.

This report is a continuation of the UCR Report Series published by this Division beginning in 1975. The initial study dealt with 1974 arrest data reported to the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division. This report deals with 1975, 1976, 1977, and 1978 arrests from the same source and offers a county by county comparison of arrests for these years. By comparing the 1975, 1976, 1977 and 1978 arrest data, a determination as to what trend is developing within certain substance abuse related arrest areas can be made.

Five other sections are contained in this report. The next section, State Substance Abuse Arrest Tables, presents arrest data by regions, counties within regions, and state totals for each major substance abuse related arrest area. The third section, Arrest Rate Tables, provides tables with information contained in section two, but displayed as arrest rates per 10,000 population. The fourth section, Possession, Sale and/or Manufacturing Arrest Tables, contains tables that present drug arrests for possession separately from drug arrests for sale/manufacture for all counties. The fifth section, Aggregated Substance Abuse Arrest Tables, presents aggregated substance arrest data as

well as a comparison of substance arrests to all other arrests for 1975 through 1978. The last section provides bar graphs that display state totals for selected categories of substance related arrests.

Readers of this report should be cognizant of the fact that the enclosed data represent the number of reported* arrests, not the number of occurrences of an offense or the number of convictions. In order to clarify the different arrest categories that are dealt with, the following definitions are offered in the same order that the tables are presented.

Opiates - Includes all arrests for violations of state and local laws relating to the unlawful possession, sale, use, growing, manufacturing, and making of narcotic drugs including opium and cocaine and their derivatives (morphine, heroin, cocaine).

Marijuana - Relates to the unlawful possession, sale, use, growing, manufacturing and making of marijuana.

Synthetics - Relates to the unlawful possession, sale, use, manufacturing and making of synthetic narcotics--manufactured narcotics which can cause true drug addiction (demerol, methadone).

Other Drugs - Relates to the unlawful possession, sale, use, manufacturing, and making of other dangerous non-narcotic drugs (barbituates, benzodrine).

Liquor Laws - With the exception of drunkenness and driving under the influence, liquor law violations of state and local laws are placed in this class. They include the following:

*Not all law enforcement agencies report UCR arrest data, although the number that do not report in a given year is small.

Manufacture, sale, transporting, furnishing, processing, etc.

intoxicating liquor

Maintaining unlawful drinking places

Advertising and soliciting orders for intoxicating liquor

Bootlegging

Furnishing liquor to a minor or intemperate persons

Using a vehicle for illegal transportation of liquor

Drinking on train or public conveyance

All attempts to commit any of the above

Driving Under Influence - This category is limited to the driving or operating of any vehicle or common carrier while drunk or under the influence of liquor or narcotics. It includes the following:

Operating a motor vehicle while intoxicated

Operating an engine, train, streetcar, boat, etc., while
intoxicated

Public Drunkenness - Included in this category are all offenses of drunkenness or intoxication with the exception of driving under the influence; it includes drunkenness, drunk and disorderly, common or habitual drunkard, and intoxication.

Disorderly Conduct* - This category is included because frequently disorderly conduct is directly related to the ingestion of alcoholic beverages or drugs. In this category are placed all charges of committing a breach of the peace which includes the following:

*Disorderly Conduct and Vagrancy Arrests are not included in the substance related arrests aggregates given in Section Five of this report.

Affray, unlawful assembly, disturbing the peace, disturbing meetings, disorderly conduct in state institutions at court, at fairs, on trains or public conveyances, etc., prize fights, blasphemy, profanity, and obscene language, desecrating flags, refusing to assist an officer, and all attempts to commit any of the above.

Vagrancy - Persons prosecuted on the charge of being a "suspicious character or person, etc." are included in this category. Includes vagrancy, begging, loitering (persons 18 or over), and vagabondage.

The above definitions are taken from the Uniform Crime Reporting Handbook, published by the Federal Bureau of Investigation, United States Department of Justice.

For those tables that provide a breakdown of "youth" and "adult" arrests, "youth" is defined as persons 17 years of age and younger, and "adult" is persons 18 years of age and older.

Readers interested in UCR information other than that contained within this report are referred to Crime in South Carolina, 1978, released by the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division in April, 1979.

The bar graphs are presented for the 10 arrest categories for youths and adults. These graphs are helpful in visualizing trends in arrest data over a four-year period.

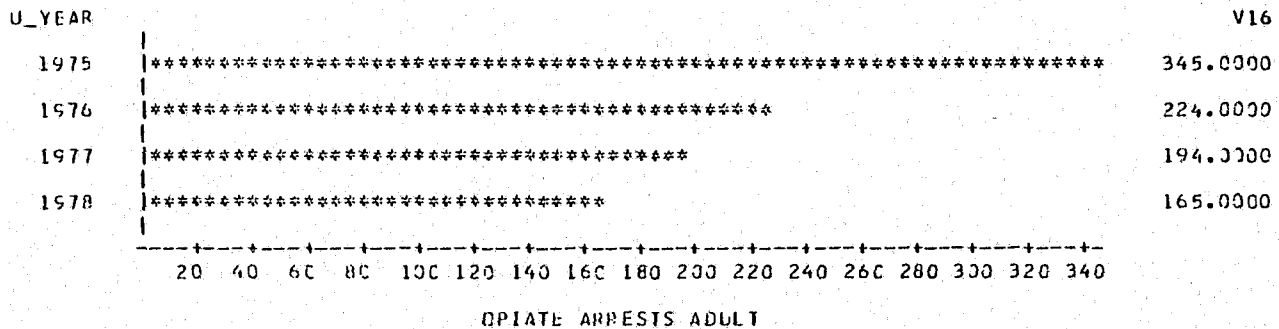

 BAR CHART OF VALUES

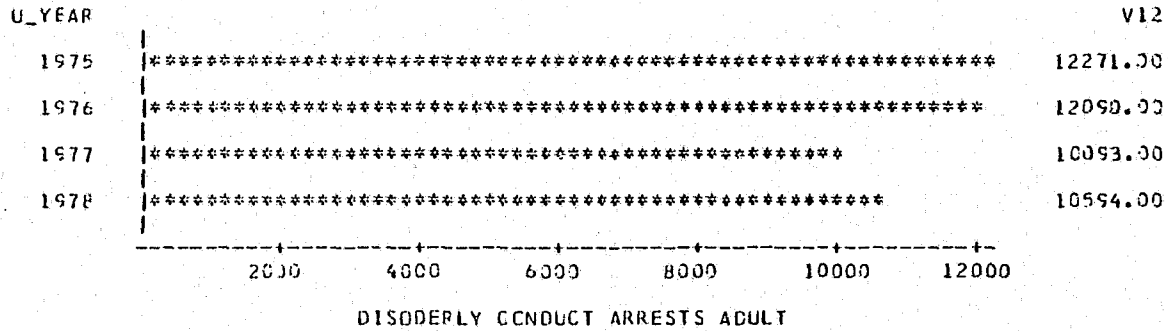
