### ABSTRACT

Finding educational materials that are suitable for adjudicated juvenile delinquents with learning disabilities is a difficult task. There is a wealth of materials but few appropriate for the older delinquent with learning disabilities. This paper, based on a recent research and development study, addresses the issue of some appropriate resource materials for the juvenile delinquent with learning disabilities. It contains a materials preference check-list which identifies materials that had positive effects with the project's sample population. The remediation program was an academic treatment model in which 134 delinquents, ranging in age from 12 to 18 years, participated.

Appropriate Resource Materials For The Juvenile  
Delinquent With Learning Disabilities

Prologue

In 1976, the Association for Children with Learning Disabilities (ACLD) and the National Center for State Courts (NCSC) received grant awards to study the relationship between Learning Disabilities and Juvenile Delinquency. ACLD and NCSC conducted a research and development program on a national scope with the ultimate objective being to provide information that will help in the development of an informed policy on the subject of learning disabilities and delinquency prevention. Selected sites for the development program were Baltimore, Maryland; Indianapolis, Indiana; and Phoenix, Arizona.

The primary objectives were as follows:

1. Determination and comparison of the prevalence of LD between adjudicated delinquent and officially non-delinquent sample populations of 12 to 15 year old boys;
2. A remediation (treatment) program for an at-random selected group of adjudicated delinquents identified as having characteristics of learning disabilities;
3. An evaluation of the effectiveness of the remediation program.

The ACLD grant award was to conduct the development (remediation) component of the overall plan. The remediation program was based on an academic treatment model in the basic skill areas designed to ameliorate the effects of LD.

Selection of educational resource materials for the site programs was a difficult task because at the time of selection, the functional levels of the population were unknown. It was necessary to select a varied library to avoid over-representation in any area. As in most remediation programs, certain materials proved more useful than others.

### Method

Once the sites were operational, i.e., staff hired, materials selected, student population identified, remediation began as scheduled. Extensive resource materials had been acquired giving staff a diverse selection of materials from which to select. Following an experimentation period with materials, each LD Specialist began utilizing the items that worked most effectively with each particular student.

After approximately six months of remediation, staff were requested to fill out a form (Appendix A) rating the materials used most frequently in each area of remediation. The procedures were for the Specialists to list the five most frequently utilized remediation materials for each basic skill area as listed. The ratings were on a scale of one to five - five indicating the maximum. Three columns were on each form: Indispensable, Client Popularity, and LDS favorite. This allowed the LD Specialist the opportunity to rate resource materials in order of preference, effectiveness and use. This rating form provided space for the students to rate the materials. The following list categorizes the materials used by skill areas in the order of materials found to be most appropriate. Following the list is a brief description of the listed materials with an asterisk preceding the item.

(Indianapolis Site)

Individual Corrective English, McCormick-Mathers Publishers

A skills development program in a traditional workbook format with remedial English exercises.

(Phoenix Site)

Proving the Rule Series, Argus Communications

Stories relating to young people's involvement in their community with suggestions for writing at the end of each story. This "lifeline" series has been prepared by the members of the Schools Council Moral Education Curriculum Project.

## Written Language, Syntax

(Baltimore Site)

Thought Tracking, Ann Arbor Publishers, Inc.

This programmed self-instructional material provides practice in skills of cues and comprehension. Whole words are selected visually rather than letters. The selected words, as they are held in mind, build into tracks of thought. The selected vocabulary and tasks are suitable for all ages and will increase visual accuracy and sequential thought.

(Indianapolis Site)

Modern English, Heath & Company

Features a multitude of example sentences and exercises that help develop good habits of using English accurately and correctly. Fundamentals of usage, grammar, sentence structure, vocabulary training, and spelling are stressed.

(Phoenix Site)

The Mature Student's Guide to Reading and Composition, SRA

This guide helps develop reading, writing and survival skills for junior and senior high students. It teaches reading and writing concurrently.

## Written Language, Abstract

(Baltimore Site)

Allyn & Bacon Literature Series, Allyn & Bacon

An exceptional series combining the best short story literature with exciting original illustrations. It includes major authors from America and around the world and is great as an introduction to the format of the short story. Skill building questions and activities follow each selection.

(Indianapolis Site)

Double Action Anthology, Scholastic Book Services

For junior and senior high students whose skills and vocabulary levels are at 3.0 to 5.0. This book of short stories is sequentially-graded and each is accompanied by pre- and post-reading exercises which encourage the student's writing.

(Phoenix Site)

Written Language Cards, DLM

Two boxes of cards picturing people with cartoon-type dialogue or thought balloons for students to write appropriate responses. One box concerns social awareness about school and work situations that appeal to students of more mature interests and experiences. In the careers box students will be encouraged to think and write creatively about a variety of careers.

## Computation, Math

(Baltimore Site)

Math Around Us, Scott Foresman & Co.

At each grade level this is a complete, self-contained basic math program. The texts are consumable and non-consumable. The supplementary materials are varied and include a chart for analyzing student weaknesses and prescribing material for teaching and practice.

(Indianapolis Site)

Taskmaster Math Pak, Taskmaster, Inc.

These are packs of re-usable wipe-clean cards with self-correcting math tasks which are easy for the student to use. It is basic drill with a difference. The boxes are graded according to ability and/or grade level.

(Phoenix Site)

The I Hate Math Book, Creative Publications

This paperback book, for teachers and students, is designed as a series of easy, interesting learning experiences. They involve tricks,

events and experiments, and require few tools or materials. Definitely exciting for students who dislike math, don't understand it, or are bored by it.

### Math Concepts

(Baltimore Site)

The Answer Is - What's The Problem, DLM

This series of three books tells students the answer and requires them to identify the problem. Each page is divided into five flip cards. The answers are printed on the top flip card of each page, and the corresponding problems are presented at random in the remaining flip cards. Students flip through the book to find problems which will match the answers. Books are designed for those who understand the four math processes.

(Indianapolis Site)

Banking, Budgeting and Employment, Frank Richards

A two-part work text presenting in simplified form the terminology and procedure of Banking, Budgeting and Employment. It includes such common forms as are encountered in everyday life.

(Phoenix Site)

Cuisenaire Rods, Creative Publications

These rods are manipulative aids for modeling math concepts at any point in the learning process. A key to their success is the use of color and length as their only distinguishable characteristics. Students physically represent number relationships by assigning any number name to one of the rods, and once doing so, finding names for all the remaining rods relating to it.

### Problem Solving Math

(Baltimore Site)

Using Dollars and Sense, Fearon Publishers, Inc.

A text workbook in the Pacemaker Practical Arithmetic series presented at a 3.0 reading level. It provides a logical progression through lessons and exercises based on concrete situations involving the use of money.

(Indianapolis Site)

Figure It Out, Follett Publishing Co.

A practical program that teaches basic arithmetic and how to work with money and measurements. These paperbacks feature daily living examples such as purchasing groceries, tires, gas, cars, and computing interest rates on loans.

(Phoenix Site)  
Thinklab Kit, SRA

These kits develop problem-solving and thinking skills for students from second graders to adults. They are designed to exercise student's insight, creativity, and reasoning abilities through activities which are sequenced by difficulty. These kits are non-consumable and develop skills of thinking, comprehension, and problem solving in a variety of curriculum areas.

Discussion

Materials used most extensively and rated most popular by LD Specialists were those emphasizing (a) basic concepts; (b) high interest, low vocabulary; and (c) visual and audio aids such as activity cards and the Voxcom. All resource materials utilized in the remediation program are listed by site and publisher in Appendix C.

The LD Specialists had the flexibility to select or make materials for each juvenile's needs. Therefore, the Specialists had various options to write and implement an optimum program. This facet of the program was a very positive one as well as critical to the success of the remediation program.

There were several factors that no doubt influenced the selection of preferential materials. During the final phase of the study, materials were purchased on the recommendation of staff on an individual basis. Consequently, in many instances, only one copy of certain materials was purchased. Naturally, this described material would probably have received a rating from only one LD Specialist. Also, some materials, regardless of how effective they were, might have been used by only one Specialist or be unavailable - in that event, there would again be only a "1" rating. Then too, as evidenced in the ratings list of materials, use or effectiveness

of like materials varied from site to site.

A final note for administrators. Procedural guidelines for resource material rating and selection are important. Standard forms and methods for rating materials lead to continuity of effective programs.
