Statutory Authority:

The Peace Officers Standards and Training Commission operated under the provisions of the Code of Alabama 1975, Sections 36-21-40 through 36-21-50.

Audit Comments and Findings:

Act No. 494, Acts of Alabama 1976, pages 614 through 619, provided for the establishment of a new system of financial management for the State of Alabama. The new accounting system went into effect on October 1, 1977, and changed the method of classifying receipts and disbursements. Since the change was during this audit period, the 1977-78 exhibits differ from the exhibits of the previous years; however, this change did not affect the consistency of the Commission's statements.

The minutes of the Commission appeared to reflect the official actions of the Commission.

The Commission was funded by appropriations from the Special Education Trust Fund, grants from the Alabama Law Enforcement Planning Agency, funds received through the Comprehensive Employment Training Act (CETA) and from Revenue Sharing Funds.

The Commission maintained only a journal of original entry. The accounting transactions were not summarized in a ledger by object of expenditure or source of revenue. The Commission should keep accounting records which summarize their revenue by source and expenditures by object classification.

The recommendation in the previous report concerning the placing of the Executive Secretary under a faithful performance bond was not implemented. It is again emphasized that furnishing such a bond is in keeping with good business practice and in no way reflects against the present Executive Secretary.

One employee charged an extra day per diem on an expense account for a trip made within the State of Alabama.

Recommendations:

It is again recommended that:

The Executive Secretary be placed under a good and sufficient faithful performance bond.

It is also recommended that:

The accounting records be summarized by object of expenditure and source of revenue.

Charges Against Officials:

A charge of \$20.00 was made for excessive per diem claimed on a travel voucher. The charge was promptly paid when brought to the attention of the proper officials.

CERTIFICATE:

My examination was made in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards and, accordingly, included such tests of the accounting records and such other auditing procedures as I considered necessary in the circumstances.

The Alabama Peace Officers Standards and Training Commission's policy is to operate on the basis of cash receipts and disbursements with limited accrual of expenditures at year end; consequently, certain revenues are recognized when received rather than when earned, and certain expenses are recognized when paid rather than when incurred. Accordingly the accompanying financial statements are not intended to present financial position and results of operations in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles.

In my opinion, the accompanying financial statements present fairly the revenues collected, expenditures paid and fund balances of the Alabama Peace Officers Standards and Training Commission arising from cash transactions and the limited accrual of expenditures at year end for the fiscal years 1976-77 and 1977-78, on a basis consistent with that of the preceding years.
