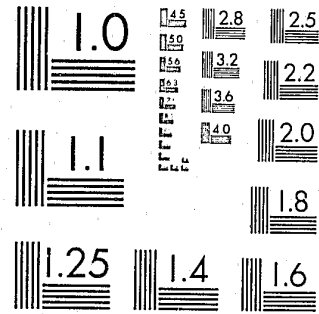

Mr. BROOKS (for himself, Mr. FOUNTAIN, and Mr. HORTON) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Government Operations

A BILL

To amend the Inspector General Act of 1978 to establish offices of inspector general in certain departments and agencies, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SHORT TITLE

4 SECTION 1. This Act may be cited as the "Inspector
5 General Act Amendments of 1980".

6 ESTABLISHMENT

7 SEC. 2. (a) Section 2(1) of the Inspector General Act of
8 1978 is amended—

1 (1) by inserting "the Department of Defense," im-
2 mediately after "the Department of Education,";

3 (2) by inserting "the Department of Justice," im-
4 mediately after "Interior,";

5 (3) by inserting "the Department of State," im-
6 mediately after "Labor,";

7 (4) by inserting "the Department of the Treas-
8 ury," immediately after "Transportation,"; and

9 (5) by inserting "the International Development
10 Cooperation Agency," immediately after "General
11 Services Administration,".

12 (b) Paragraph (1) of section 11 of the Inspector General
13 Act of 1978 is amended—

14 (1) by inserting "Defense," immediately after
15 "Education,";

16 (2) by inserting "State," immediately after
17 "Labor,";

18 (3) by striking out "or Transportation" and insert-
19 ing in lieu thereof "Transportation, or the Treasury,
20 the Attorney General,"; and

21 (4) by inserting "the International Development
22 Cooperation Agency," immediately after "General
23 Services,".

24 (c) Paragraph (2) of section 11 of the Inspector General
25 Act of 1978 is amended—

1 (1) by inserting "Defense (including the Depart-
2 ments of the Army, Navy, and Air Force)," immedi-
3 ately after "Education,";

4 (2) by inserting "Justice," immediately after "In-
5 terior,";

6 (3) by inserting "State," immediately after
7 "Labor,";

8 (4) by striking out "or Transportation" and insert-
9 ing in lieu thereof "Transportation, or the Treasury";
10 and

11 (5) by inserting "the International Development
12 Cooperation Agency (including the Agency for Interna-
13 tional Development)," immediately after "General
14 Services Administration,".

15 TRANSFERS

16 SEC. 3. Section 9(a)(1) of the Inspector General Act of
17 1978 is amended by striking out "and" at the end of subpar-
18 agraphs (L) and (M) and by inserting at the end thereof the
19 following new subparagraphs:

20 "(N) of the Department of Defense, the of-
21 fices of that department referred to as the 'De-
22 fense Contract Audit Agency', the 'Defense Audit
23 Service', and the 'Office of Inspector General,
24 Defense Logistics Agency', and that portion of
25 the office referred to as the 'Defense Investigative

1 Service' which has responsibility for the investiga-
2 tion of alleged criminal violations and program
3 abuse;

4 "(O) of the Department of Justice, the offices
5 of that department referred to as the 'Office of
6 Professional Responsibility', the 'Internal Audit
7 Staff, Justice Management Division', the 'Evalu-
8 ation Staff, Justice Management Division', and the
9 'Office of Audit and Investigations, Law Enforce-
10 ment Assistance Administration';

11 "(P) of the Department of State, that portion
12 of the office of that department referred to as the
13 'Office of the Inspector General of the Foreign
14 Service' which is engaged in auditing and investi-
15 gative activities;

16 "(Q) of the Department of the Treasury, the
17 offices of that department referred to as the
18 'Office of Inspector General, Office of the Secre-
19 tary', the 'Office of Audit, Office of the Secre-
20 tary', the 'Internal Audits Division, Customs
21 Service', the 'Internal Audit Division, Bureau of
22 Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms', the 'Office of
23 Audit, Bureau of Printing and Engraving', the
24 'Office of Assistant Comptroller for Auditing,
25 Bureau of Government Financial Operations', the

1 'Internal Audit Staff, Bureau of the Mint', the
2 'Division of Internal Audit, Bureau of Public
3 Debt', the 'Office of Inspections and Audits,
4 Office of Comptroller of the Currency', the 'Inter-
5 nal Audit Staff, Federal Law Enforcement Train-
6 ing Center', and the 'Internal Audit Unit, Office
7 of Inspection, Secret Service'; and

8 "(R) of the International Development Coop-
9 eration Agency, the office of that agency referred
10 to as the 'Office of Auditor General, Agency for
11 International Development'; and".

12 SPECIAL PROVISIONS

13 SEC. 4. (a) Section 8 of the Inspector General Act of
14 1978 is amended to read as follows:

15 "SPECIAL PROVISIONS; DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE

16 "SEC. 8. (a) The provisions of section 1385 of title 18,
17 United States Code, shall not apply to audits and investiga-
18 tions conducted by, under the direction of, or at the request
19 of the Inspector General of the Department of Defense to
20 carry out the purposes of this Act.

21 "(b) The Inspector General of the Department of De-
22 fense shall conduct a further study of the operation of the
23 audit, investigative, and inspection components in the De-
24 partment of Defense which engage in the prevention and de-
25 tection of fraud, waste, and abuse, including a review of the

1 findings of the task force on evaluation of audit, inspection,
 2 and investigative components of the Department of Defense,
 3 and shall make a report thereon to the Secretary of Defense
 4 and to the Congress not later than September 30, 1983.
 5 Such report shall include the views of the Inspector General
 6 concerning the desirability of further statutory and adminis-
 7 trative changes in the organization and operations of such
 8 components.”.

9 (b) For administrative purposes, the Office of Inspector
 10 General of the International Development Cooperation
 11 Agency may be located in such bureau or component of that
 12 Agency as the head of that Agency, with the agreement of
 13 the Inspector General, shall prescribe by regulation.

14 CONFORMING AND TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS

15 SEC. 5. (a) Section 5315 of title 5, United States Code,
 16 is amended by adding at the end thereof the following new
 17 paragraphs:

18 “Inspector General, Department of Defense.

19 “Inspector General, Department of Justice.

20 “Inspector General, Department of State.

21 “Inspector General, Department of the
 22 Treasury.”.

1 (b) Section 5316 of title 5, United States Code, is
 2 amended by adding at the end thereof the following new
 3 paragraph:

4 “Inspector General, International Development
 5 Cooperation Agency.”.
