
ACQUISITIONS

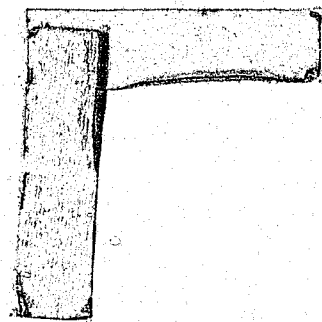

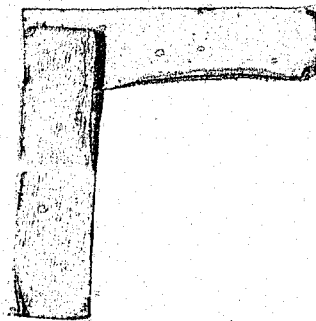
