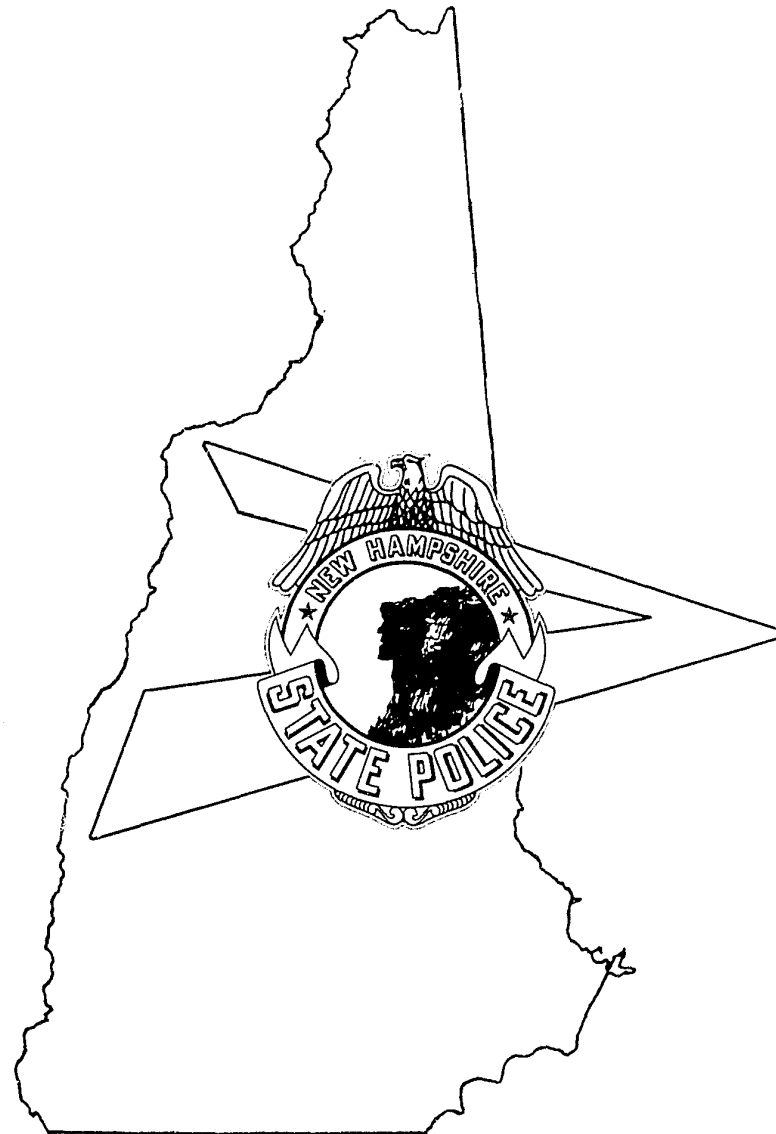

FORWARD

This Annual Uniform Crime Report portrays the nature, volume, and extent of crime in the State of New Hampshire during 1981. All statistics presented in this publication have been accumulated through direct report submission by each law enforcement agency participating in the New Hampshire Uniform Crime Reporting Program. The data, in turn, is submitted to the Federal Bureau of Investigation for inclusion in their annual publication entitled "Crime in the United States".

This report has been prepared to provide reliable and comprehensive data to the criminal justice community. While the various crime factors should prove to be of assistance to law enforcement personnel in planning programs to combat criminal activity throughout New Hampshire, they should not be used to judge the performance of any agency. It is not the purpose of the UCR program to measure individual department effectiveness, but rather to trace and reveal total criminal activity in the state.

Appreciation and gratitude are extended to all members of the law enforcement community. Without their enthusiastic cooperation, this report would not be possible.

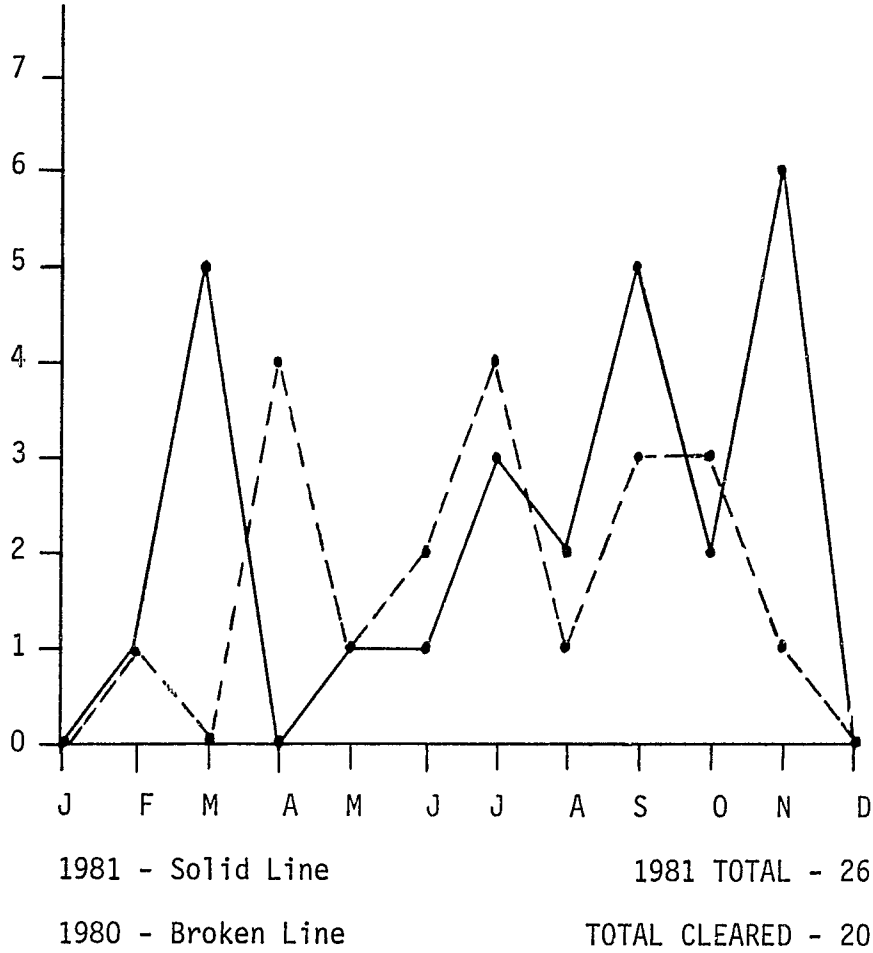

Definition - The willful (nonnegligent) killing of one human being by another. Suicides, accidental deaths, assaults to murder, and attempted murders are not included.

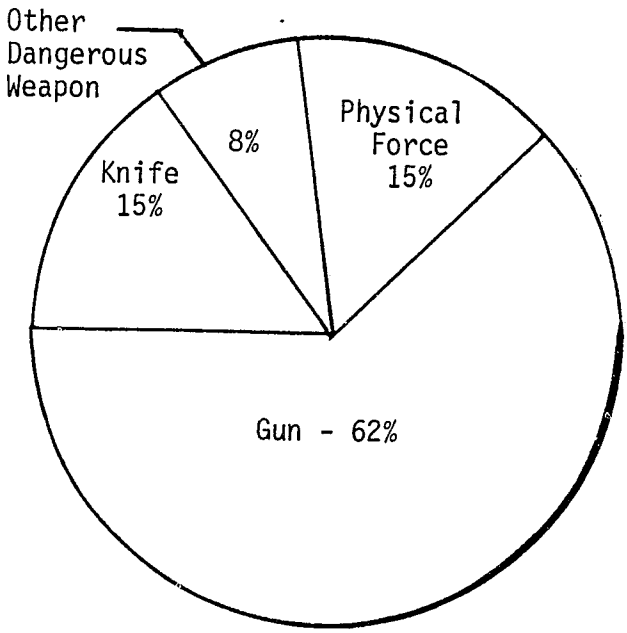
NUMBER BY MONTH

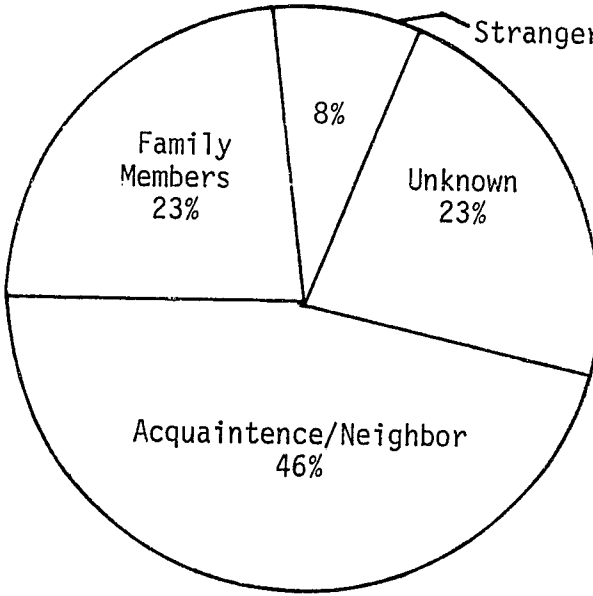

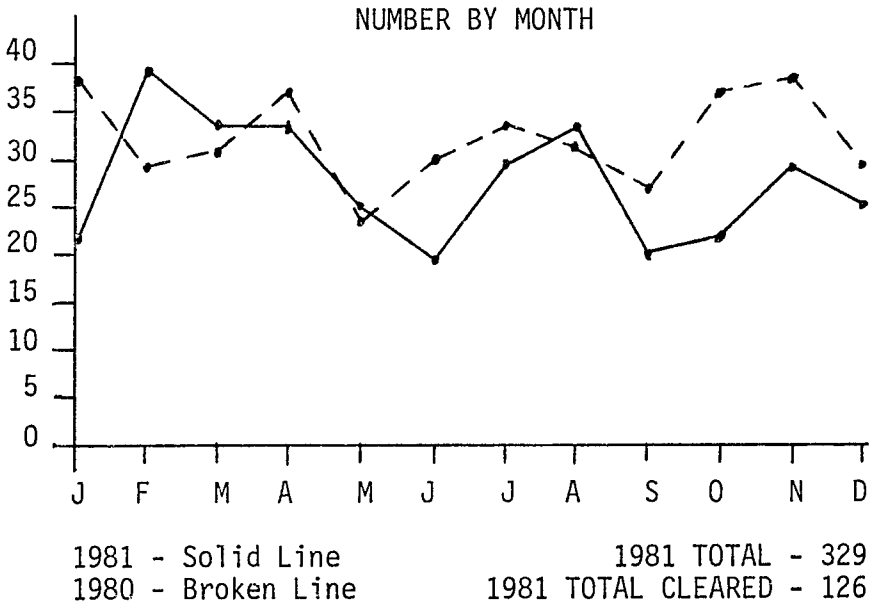

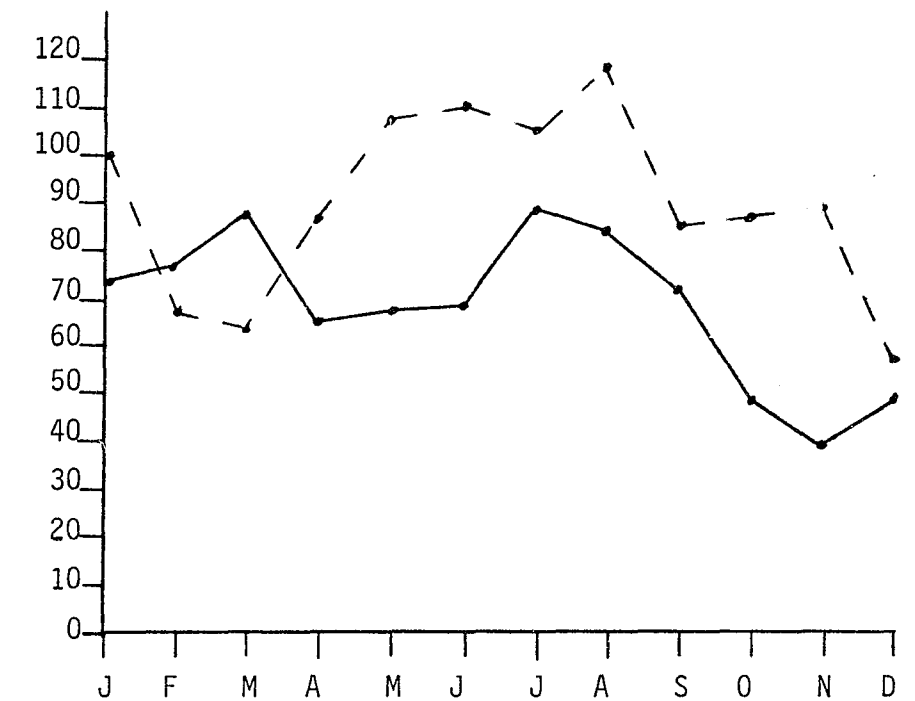
LOCATION OF ROBBERY

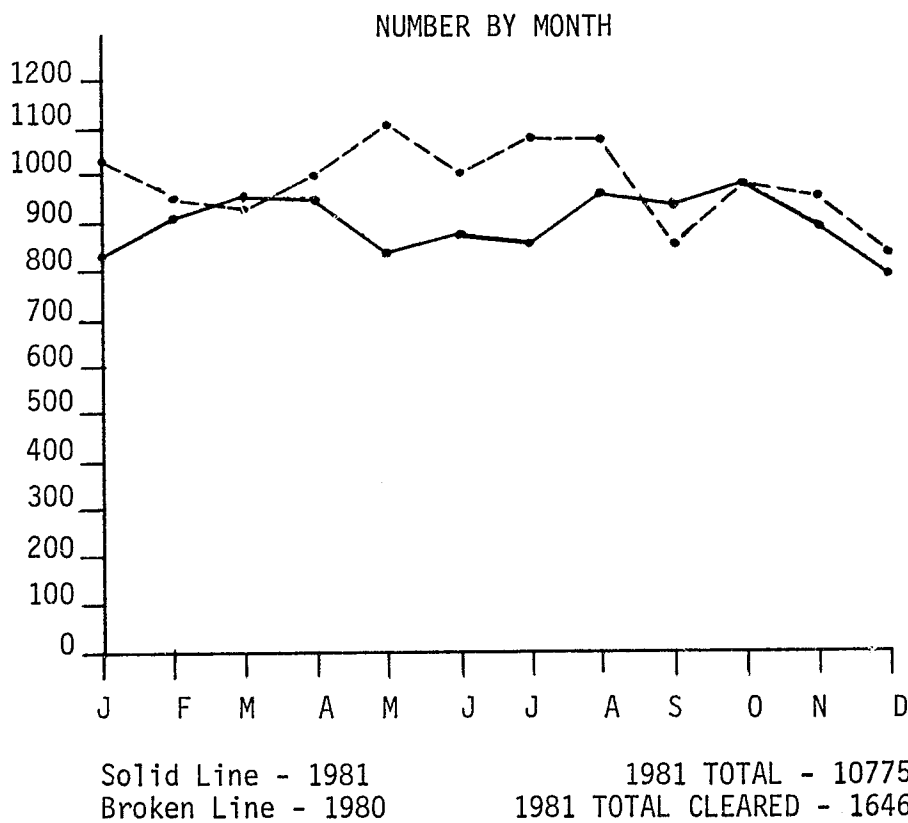

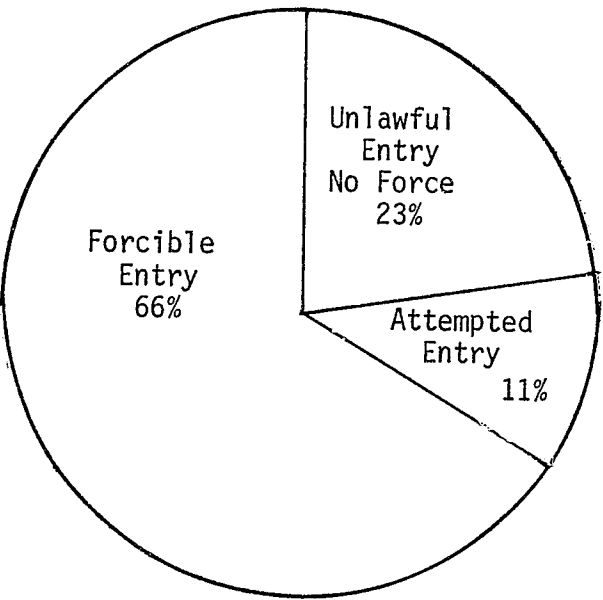

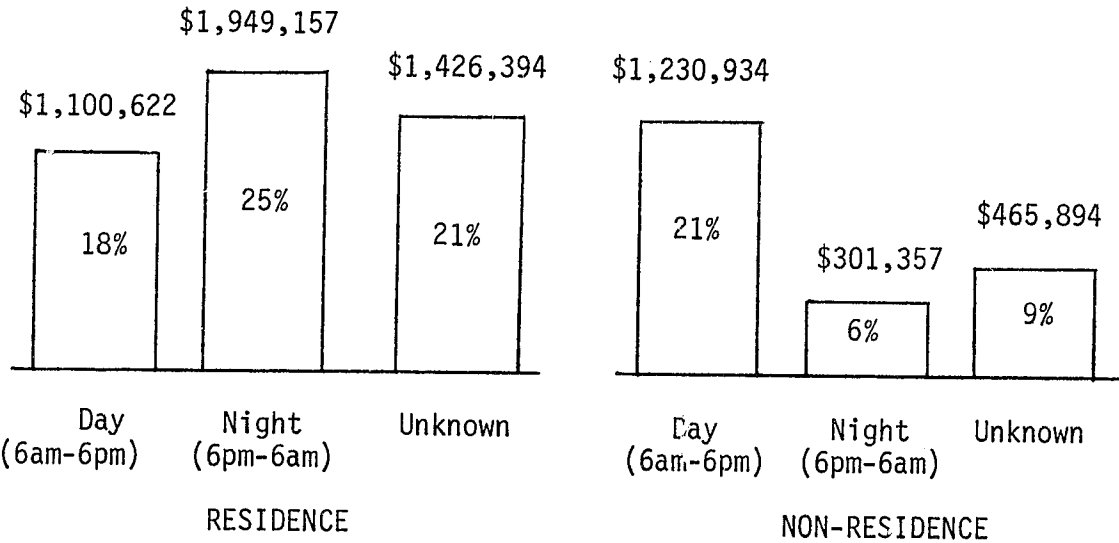

BURGLARY METHODS



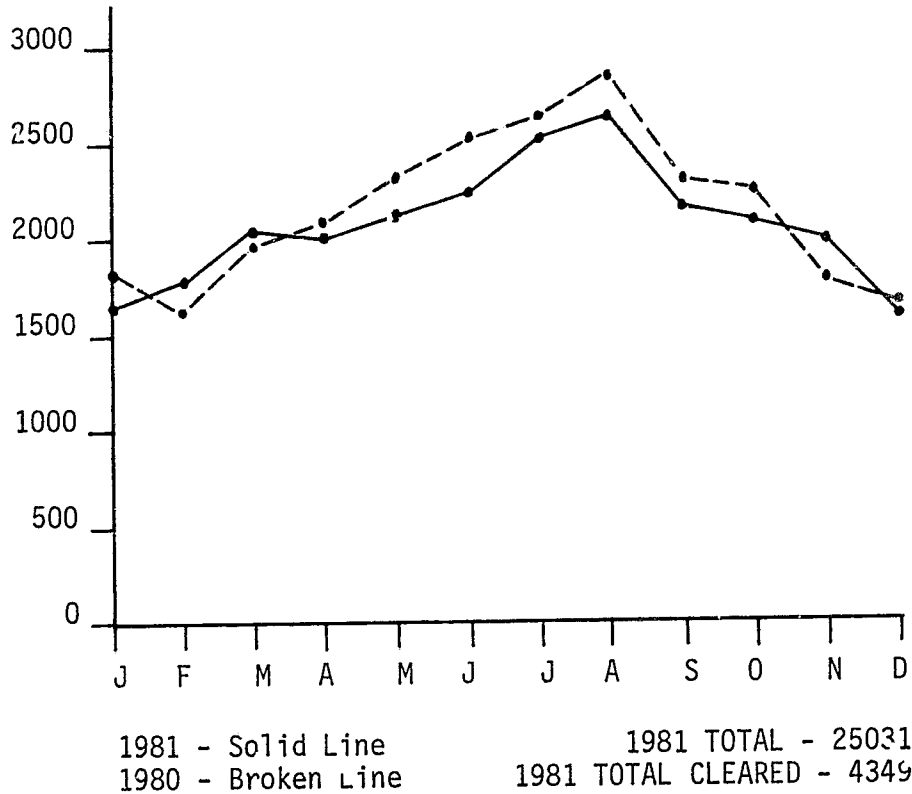
TIME OF OFFENSE AND VALUE STOLEN

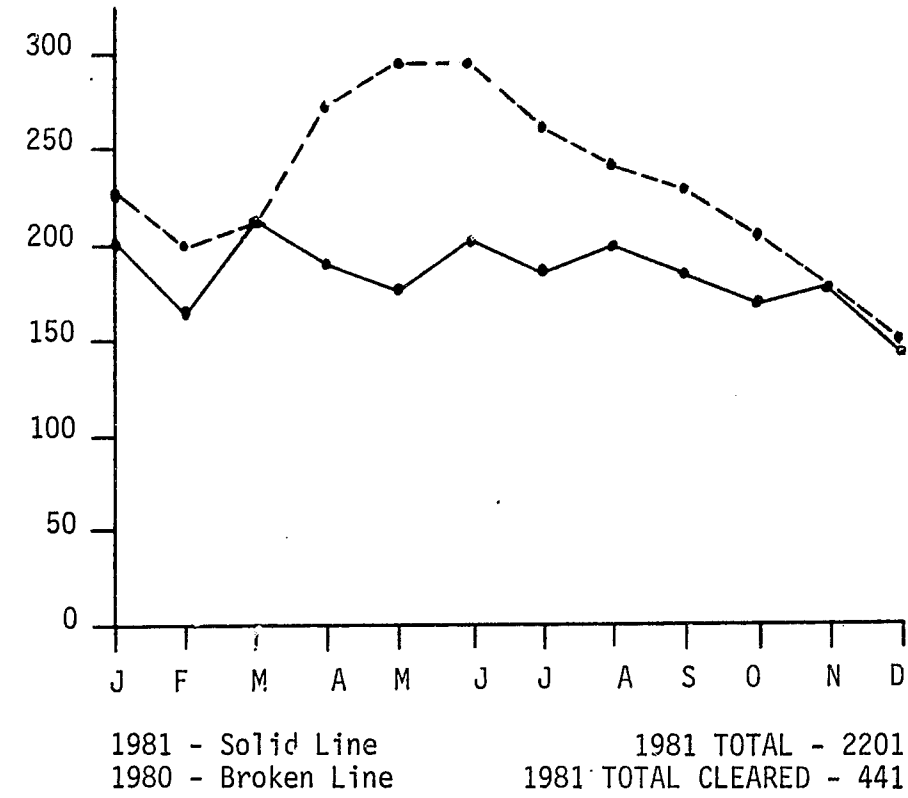

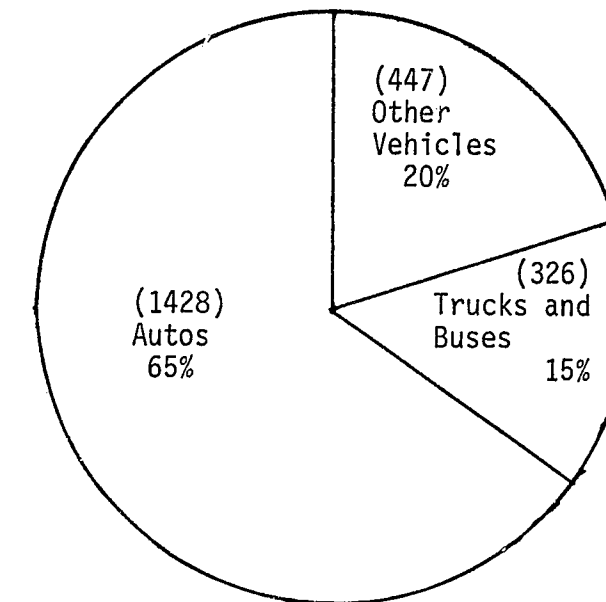

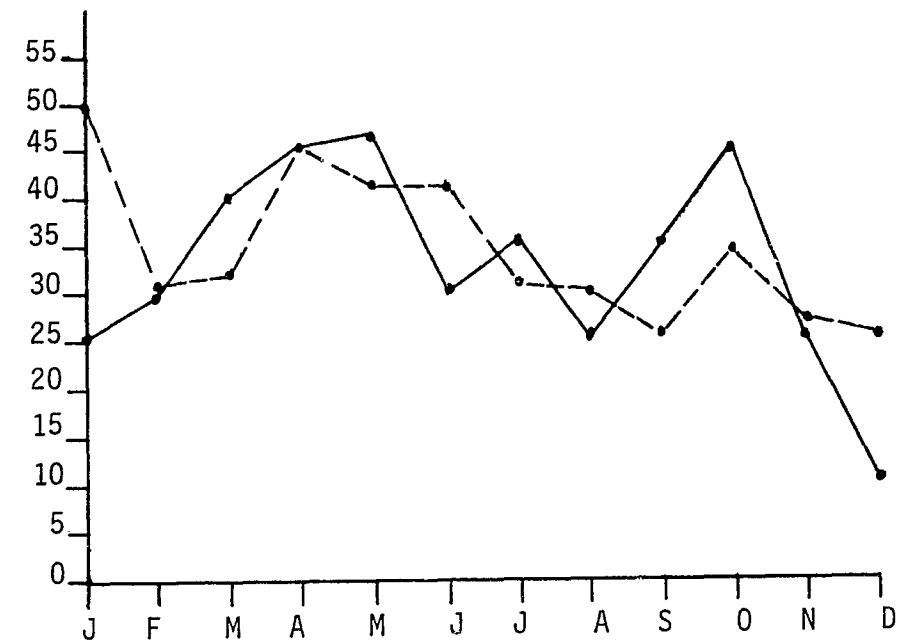

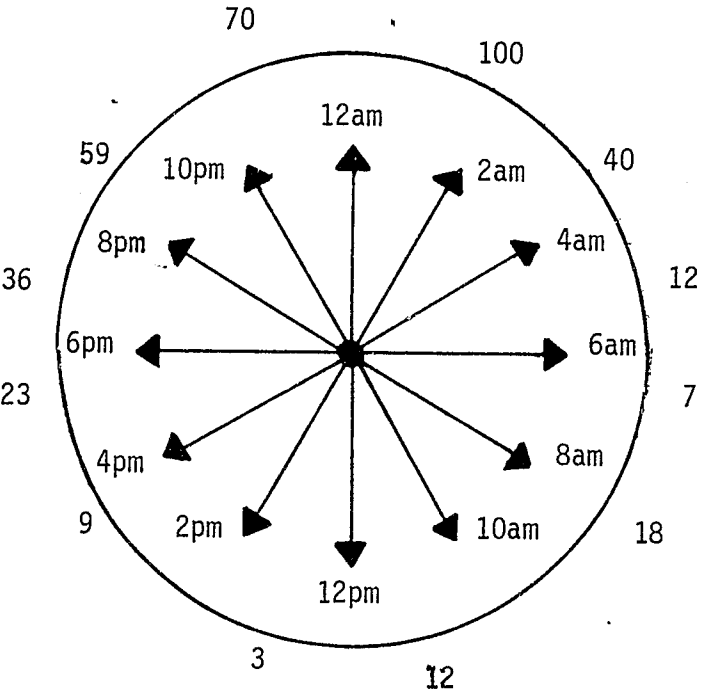

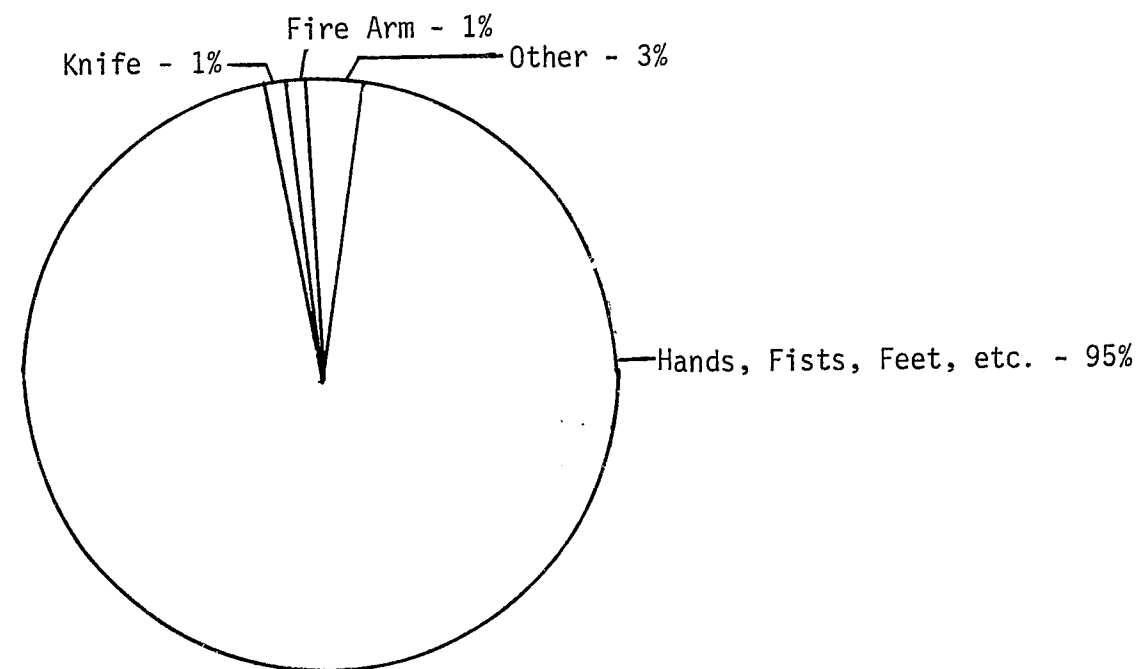
OFFICERS ASSAULTED BY TIME

DOMESTIC ASSAULT

In 1979, the General Court mandated the Director of State Police to present an annual report to them concerning the nature and extent of domestic violence in our state. It was decided to collect this data in conjunction with the UCR program by adding a relationship category to the information collected in assaults. The following chart indicates the relationship of the offender to the victim along with the type of weapon used in aggravated assaults and the number of simple assaults for 1981:
