We wish to acknowledge the assistance of the Nassau County Police Department's Juvenile Aid Bureau, other Police Department's in Nassau County, the Nassau County Youth Board, Nassau County Planning Commission and New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services.

The following observations are based upon an analysis of youth arrests data for 1980 and 1981 for the County of Nassau

- Criminal Activity by youths, as measured by the total number of arrests, declined by a significant 8.7% between 1980 and 1981.
- While juveniles are most frequently arrested for burglary (25%), those in the 16-21 year category are most frequently arrested for larceny (18.8%).
- Although the segment of the population from 10 to 21 years of age is 21.3% of the total county population, this age group accounted for 55.8% of the persons arrested for Part I crimes in 1981 and 57.8% in 1980.
- While the average age of a Nassau County resident is increasing (from a median age of 30.9 in 1970 to a median age of 34 in 1980), the percentage of total arrests accounted for by persons in the 10-21 year age bracket has increased from 44.2% in 1980 to 45% in 1981.
- The ten communities that rank highest in the number of youths arrested per one-thousand youth population represent 17.2% of the County's youth population, while these communities accounted for 41.9% of all youths arrested in 1981.

Uniform Crime Reporting data reported that 9,675 persons in the age group from 7-21 were arrested in Nassau County. This represents 45.6% of the total number of all persons arrested for crimes in Nassau County. This is a decrease of 8.7% from the 1980 total of 10,595.

As previously indicated (see Table One) persons 21 and younger accounted for 55.8% of the total number of persons arrested for Part I offenses in the county. We make note that the violent to property crime ratio for youths is .1725, which is significantly below the overall county average of .2030.

Table One and the two preceding narratives indicates that the youth population, although representing less than one quarter of the Nassau Population, accounts for approximately one half of all arrests.

A further analysis of previously cited data reveals downward trends in youth criminal activity are discernable.

This observation is based upon the following facts:

- 1) The overall number of youth arrests has decreased.
- 2) The percentage of youth arrests for Part I Offenses has decreased.
