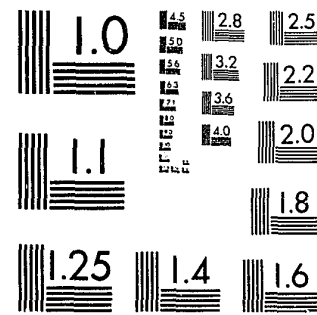

FOREWORD

The following explanations are provided to clarify the meaning of the report:

- Throughout the report, the terms "Official Cases" and "Unofficial Cases" are used as major column headings. For purposes of the report, cases are considered "official" if a juvenile court petition is filed and "unofficial" if no petition is filed.
- On pages 5-7, the subheadings "Delinquency", "Status Offenses", "Simple Misdemeanors", "Child Abuse and Neglect", and "Special Proceedings" are used. These groupings are based strictly on information collected on the reporting form under the heading "Reason Referred". The referral reasons shown on the reporting form are grouped under each of the subheadings, as follows:

- Delinquency includes:

Murder and non-negligent manslaughter  
Manslaughter by negligence  
Forcible rape  
Robbery - purse-snatching by force  
Robbery - all except purse-snatching  
Assault - aggravated  
Assault - all except aggravated  
Burglary - breaking and entering  
Auto theft - unauthorized use  
Auto theft - all except unauthorized use  
Larceny - shoplifting  
Larceny - all except shoplifting  
Weapons carrying, possession, etc.  
Sex offenses (except forcible rape)

Violation of drug laws - narcotic  
Violation of drug laws - all except narcotic  
Drunkenness  
Disorderly conduct  
Vandalism  
Other offenses applicable to both juvenile and adults  
Driving while intoxicated

- Status offenses include:

Running away  
Truancy  
Ungovernable behavior

FOREWORD CONT.

- Simple misdemeanors, for the purposes of this report, means those offenses exempted from the jurisdiction of the juvenile court:

Violation of curfew  
Possessing or drinking liquor  
Hit and run  
Reckless driving  
Driving without a license  
All other traffic offenses

- Child Abuse and Neglect includes:

Abuse  
All other neglect

- Special proceedings include adoption, consent to marry, etc.

- The use of the subheadings, "Status Offense" and "Simple Misdemeanors" should not be construed to mean that official and unofficial action was taken by the juvenile court in matters which are outside the scope of the Juvenile Code.

These subheadings are composed of groupings of various referral reasons. Referral reasons may be viewed as the presenting problem, not as the legal basis for action.

The same reasoning should be applied to the "Reason Referred" list on page 9 of this report.
