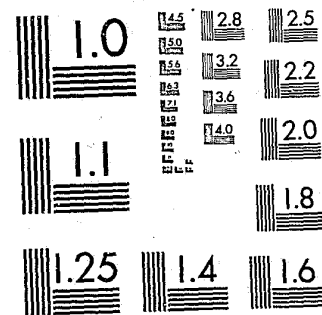

INTRODUCTION

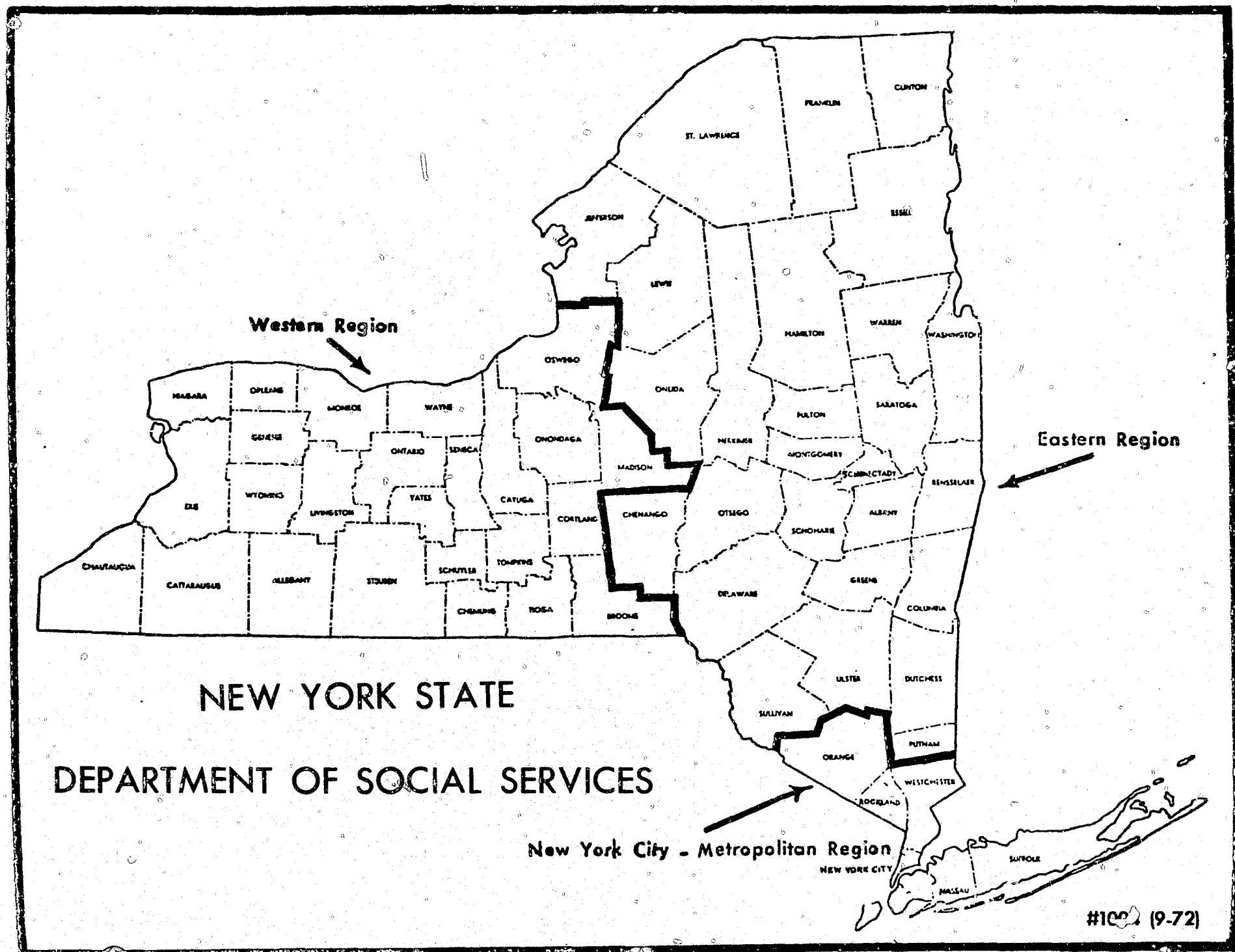
Services For Victims of Domestic Violence in New York State is the third edition of this Directory, originally published by the Domestic Violence Program of the New York State Department of Social Services. This revision was prepared by the staff of the Domestic Violence Hotline, a project sponsored by the New York State Coalition Against Domestic Violence and funded by a grant from the New York State Department of Social Services. Volunteers from Family of Woodstock also provided invaluable assistance in the updating of this Directory. This updated Directory was developed under the Domestic Violence Hotline's 1981 - 1982 contract with the New York State Department of Social Services.

The Directory is arranged alphabetically by county. In counties where no specific domestic violence services exist, the address and phone number of the local Department of Social Services is listed.

This Directory also includes a map of New York State counties to facilitate referrals to contiguous counties where necessary. A listing of all State Police Barracks is included, should police intervention be warranted. We have also included a listing of other statewide and national hotlines appropriate for victims of domestic violence.

Designed as a ready-access implement to help service providers assist victims in obtaining direct and ancillary assistance, the Directory must be kept as up-to-date and accurate as possible. We ask you to help by alerting us to any needed corrections, additions, omissions, or other pertinent information from a simple change of address or phone number to a description of new services or notice of non-functioning services.
