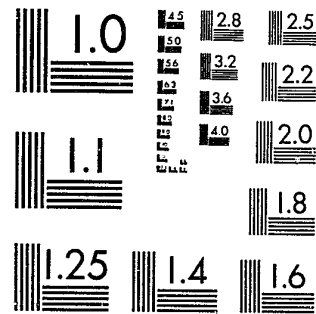

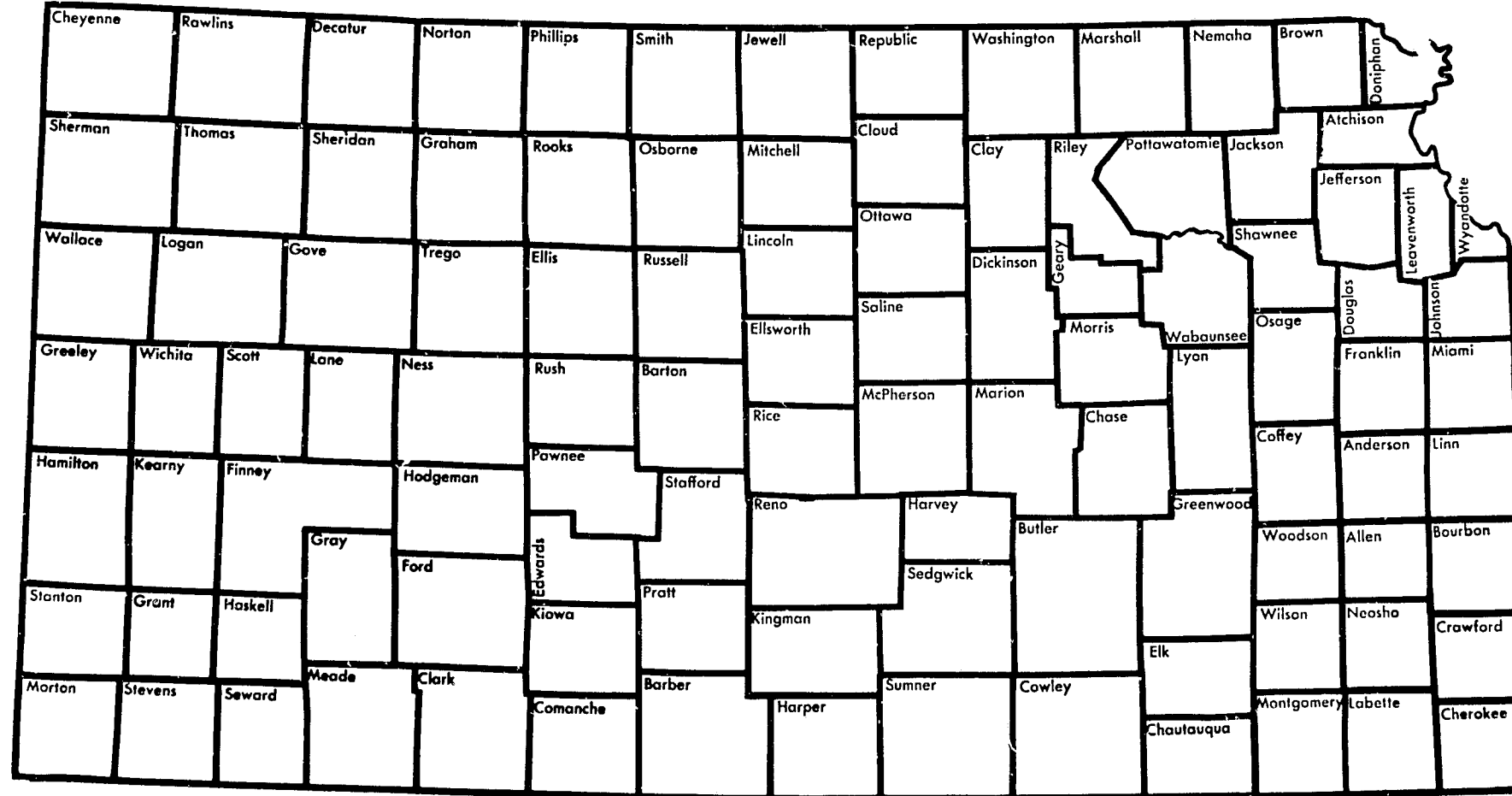

INTRODUCTION

INTRODUCTION

This report has been prepared to exhibit expenditure and manpower allocations for the criminal justice system in the state, county, and municipal governments of Kansas. This is the annual criminal justice expenditure and employment report for the fiscal year 1982. The data presented was collected by the Kansas Bureau of Investigation Statistical Analysis Center. Due to the volume of data and space limitations, extensive statistical analysis of the data is not presented. Persons requiring additional information are encouraged to contact the Kansas Bureau of Investigation Statistical Analysis Center staff.

SURVEY METHODOLOGY

The survey form found in Appendix C of this publication serves as the source document for the data presented. This survey form was mailed to all 105 Kansas County Clerks and to the City Clerks of those Kansas municipalities listing a police department in the Directory of Kansas Public Officials published by the Kansas League of Municipalities. These 224 Kansas municipalities each had a 1981 population greater than 500 persons.

Data compilation for the state government was performed by tabulating the fiscal year 1982 expenditure and employment figures from the Governor's Budget Report for the fiscal year 1984 or by contacting the reporting agency individually for their fiscal report from 1982.

SURVEY PERIOD

Data were requested for the fiscal year 1982. All local governments surveyed reported a 1982 fiscal year beginning on January 1, 1982 and ending

December 31, 1982. Data presented for the state of Kansas cover the state 1982 fiscal year, beginning on July 1, 1981 and ending June 30, 1982.

SURVEY COVERAGE

The survey population consists of all 105 Kansas counties and 224 Kansas municipalities. Of the 339 local governmental entities polled, 310 or approximately 91.5%, responded. Responding local governments accounted for approximately 96.0% of the 1982 estimated population of Kansas. Appendix A provides a participant listing of all local entities surveyed and further indicates those agencies that did not respond. Appendix A also provides the 1982 estimated population of all local entities surveyed. The reader should consider the information exhibited in this appendix before interpreting the data presented in this publication.

SECTION I
THE STATEWIDE PERSPECTIVE

THE STATEWIDE PERSPECTIVE

The information presented in this section is designed to present a graphic overview of criminal justice expenditures and employment within the state of Kansas. This section presents data for the sum of local governments, which includes both county and municipal governments, and data for the government of the state of Kansas.

Criminal justice data are presented for six functional categories: 1) police protection, 2) judicial, 3) legal, 4) public defense, 5) corrections, and 6) "other." Definitions of these functional categories are found in Appendix B. The reader is encouraged to peruse this section to aid in the interpretation of the more detailed information contained in later sections.

Figures 1 through 5 are maps of Kansas showing relative density of five county characteristics: 1) population, 2) crime index offenses, 3) criminal arrests, 4) criminal justice expenditure, and 5) criminal justice employment. The crime index offenses include: murder, non-negligent manslaughter, rape, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, larceny (theft), and motor vehicle theft. These offenses are utilized as a national standard by the F.B.I. and are selected for their severity, frequency, and likelihood of being reported. Arrest statistics are collected and reported for all arrests made for any criminal act. More extensive information concerning crime and arrests in Kansas is provided in the Uniform Crime Report entitled Crime In Kansas published by the K.B.I.

Clearly, the first two characteristics, population and crime index offenses, directly influence criminal justice expenditure and employment at the local governmental level. While these characteristics alone are

not the only factors which determine an agency's deployment of funds and manpower, their influence is great enough to merit attention. Figures 1 through 5 portray this set of relationships and in most cases both population and crime index offenses are positively correlated with both criminal justice employment and expenditure.

Table 1 exhibits criminal justice expenditure and employment data for the 32 state governmental agencies that are a part of the criminal justice system. The table shows that the judiciary as a whole employs 35.1% of the state's criminal justice employees and expends the greatest individual budget.

Table 2 exhibits criminal justice expenditure with a percentage breakdown by function for each of the three governmental groups previously discussed. The data illustrate the way that the state of Kansas and the local entities therein funded the criminal justice system as a whole. Local governments as a group spend the largest portion of their criminal justice dollar (76.2%) on the police function, followed by the corrections, judicial, legal, public defense and "other" functions respectively. State government, however, spends the greatest portion (43.2%) of its criminal justice dollar on the corrections function, followed by the judicial, police, "other", public defense, and legal functions respectively. Table 1 further provides summation data whereby all governments represented have been added together and percentages equated for the state as a whole. The criminal justice system then funds the various functions in the following manner. Police functions account for over one-half of all criminal justice monies expended. This is followed by the corrections function which accounts for nearly one-fourth of all criminal justice expenditure. Finally the judicial,

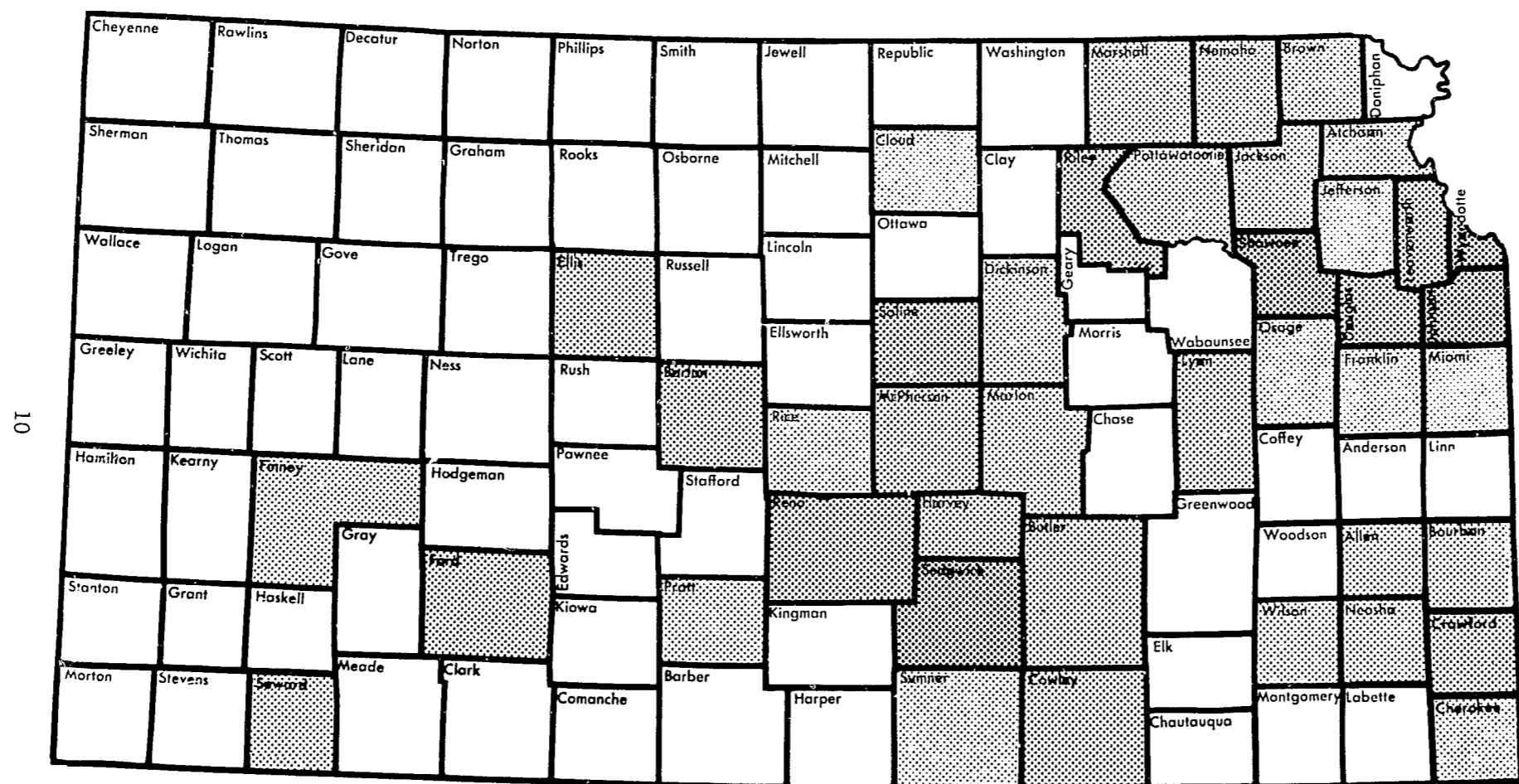
legal, public defense function and "other" functions follow respectively. Figures 6 through 8 graphically depict the percentage of the various criminal justice functions by each governmental entity mentioned above.

Table 3 exhibits per capita expenditure data for local governments, the state government and a combined total for all governments within the state. The per capita datum is based on the total estimated Kansas population in 1982 and should not be interpreted as an actual expenditure for each Kansas taxpayer. Further, per capita expenditure for local governments was based on 96.0% of the population of Kansas in 1982, or 2,338,781 persons. This is done to compensate for those agencies that did not participate in this survey.

Table 4 presents criminal justice employment data. All employment data presented in this publication represents full-time employment and does not include persons working part-time or retained to provide services for a limited time. Table 4 exhibits criminal justice full-time employment by functional category with a percentage breakdown. The proportional relationships of the functions are largely the same for the employment data as they were for the expenditure data presented in Table 2 with the largest portion of their manpower being allocated to police protection.

Table 5 presents criminal justice employment data by functional category. In comparing total employment expenditure from Table 5 with total criminal justice expenditure in Table 2 the data show local entities expend 62.4% of their monies for salaries and benefits. State government expends 71.8% of their total expenditure on salaries and benefits and overall salaries and benefits account for two-thirds of the total cost of the criminal justice systems expenditure. This is an average per capita (Table 6) expenditure of \$75.83 per taxpayer.

1982



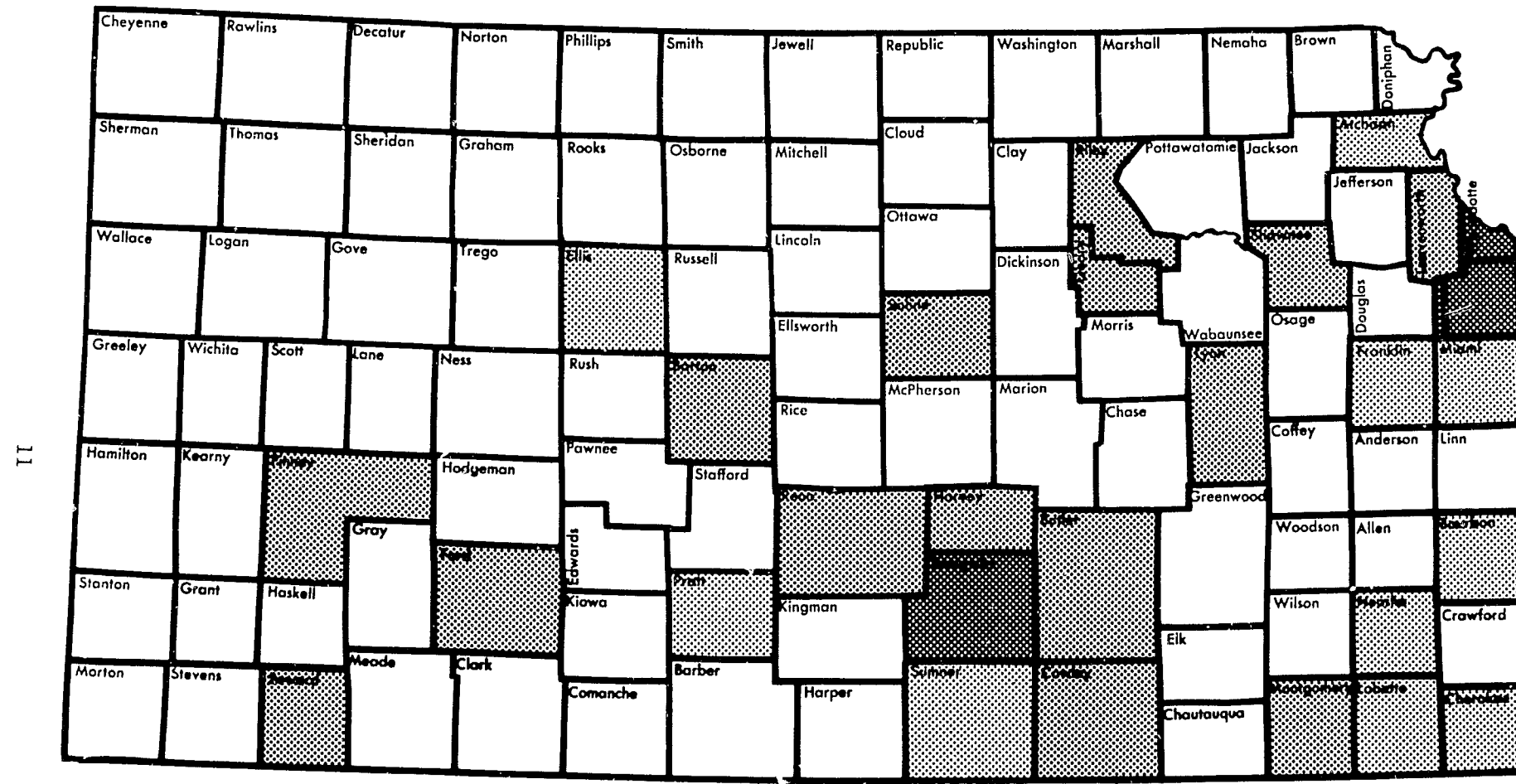

 1982

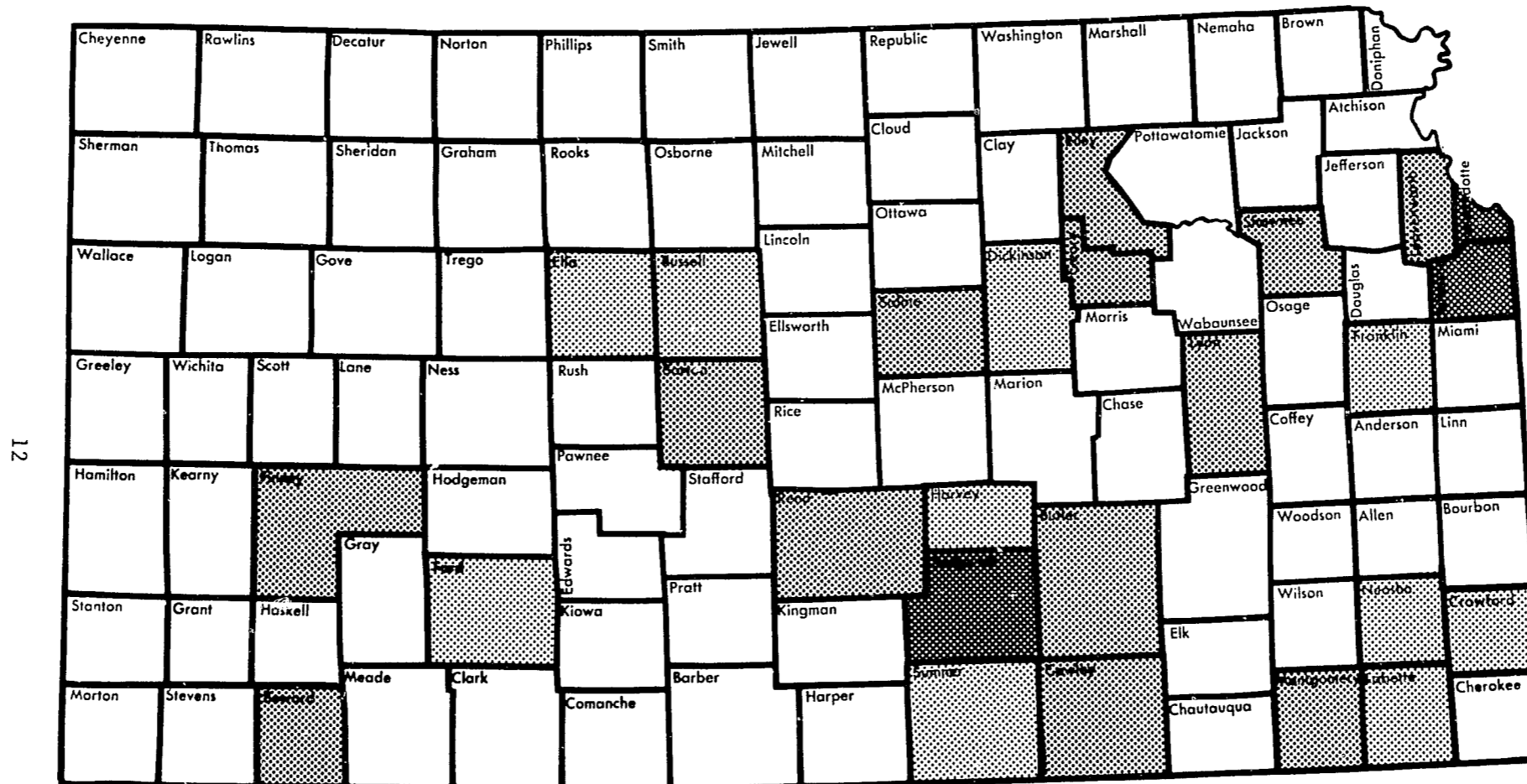


DISTRIBUTION OF OFFENSES

1982

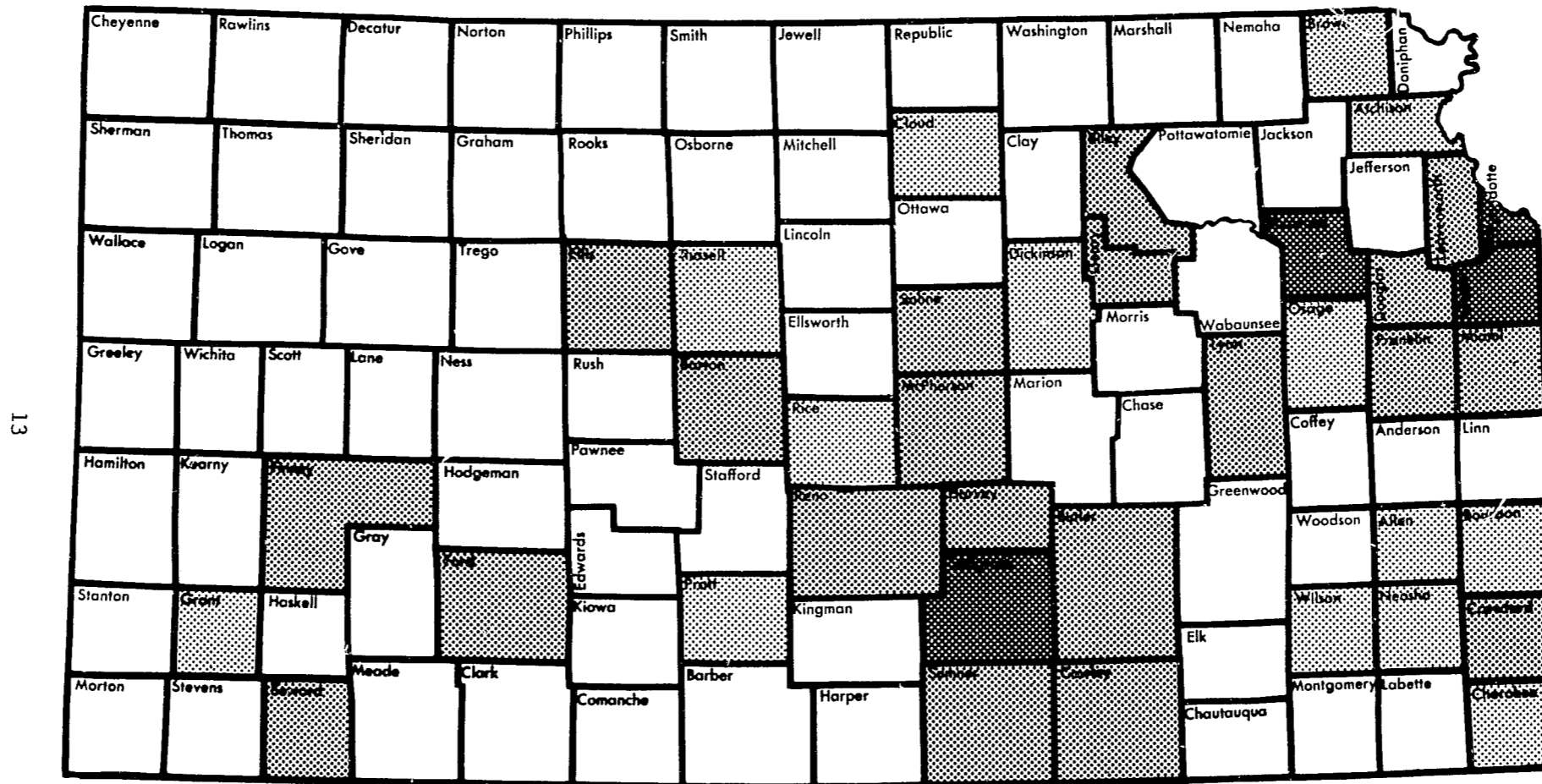


DISTRIBUTION OF ARRESTS

 1982



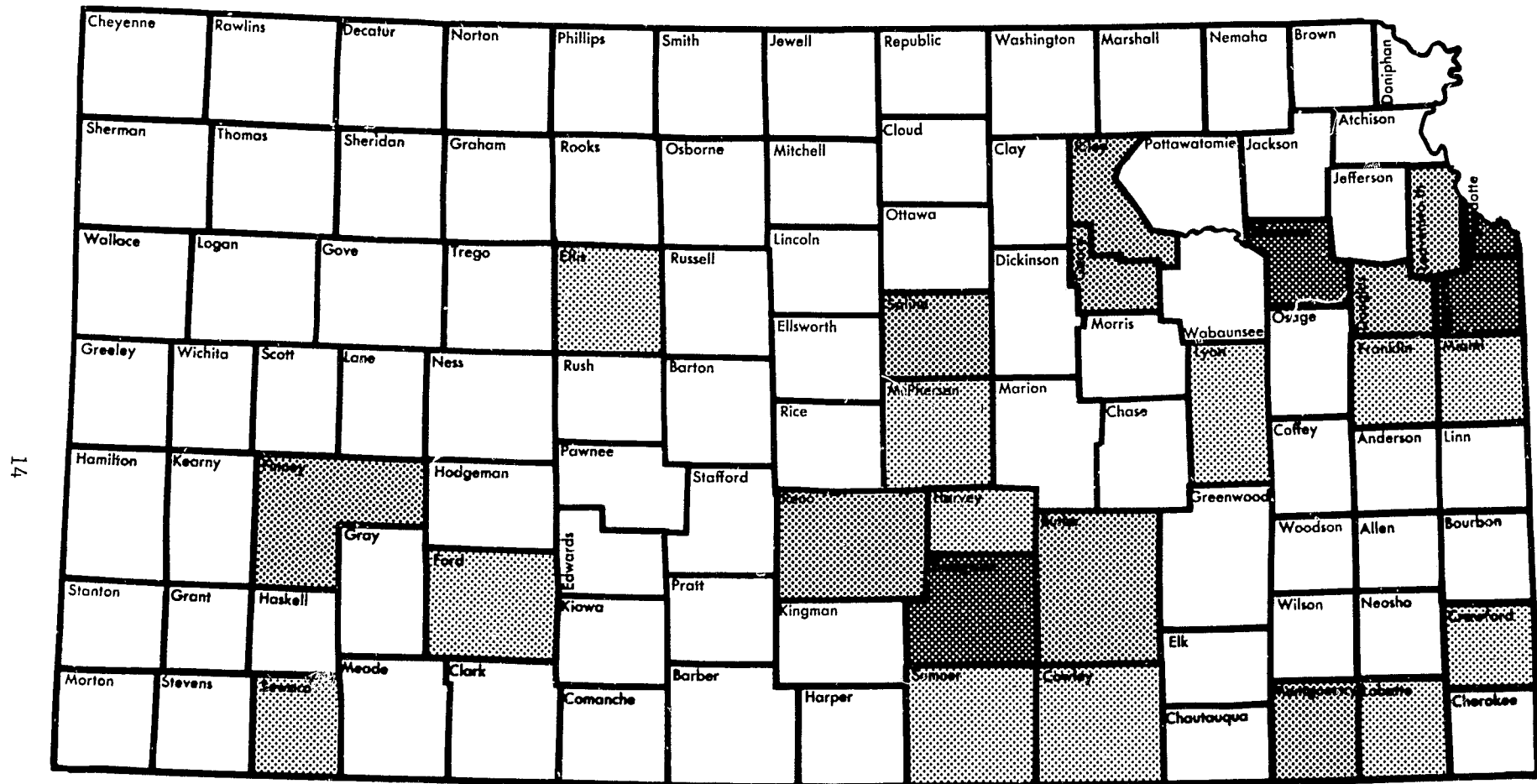

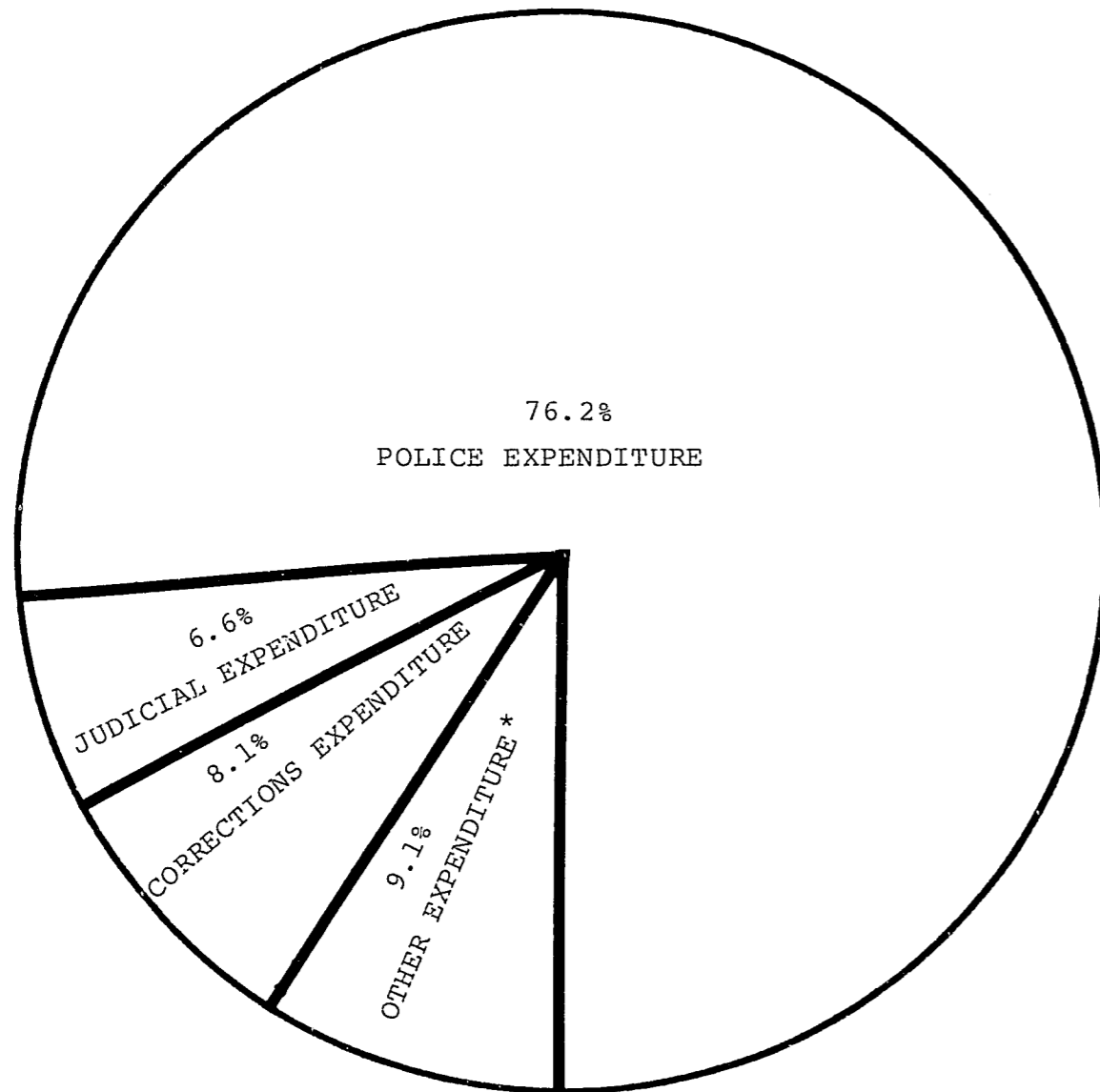

 LOCAL GOVERNMENT - 1982

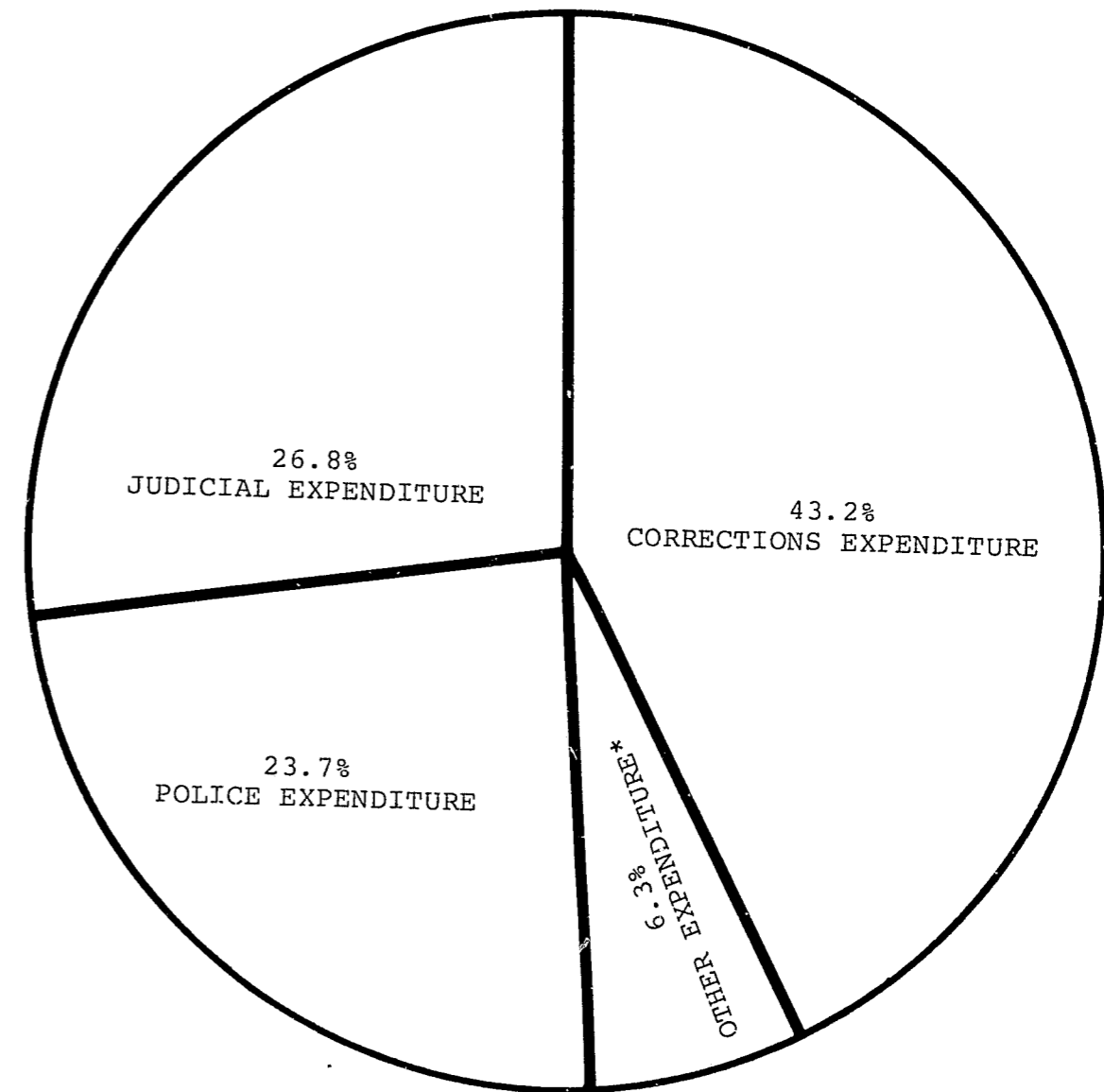

 STATE GOVERNMENT - 1982

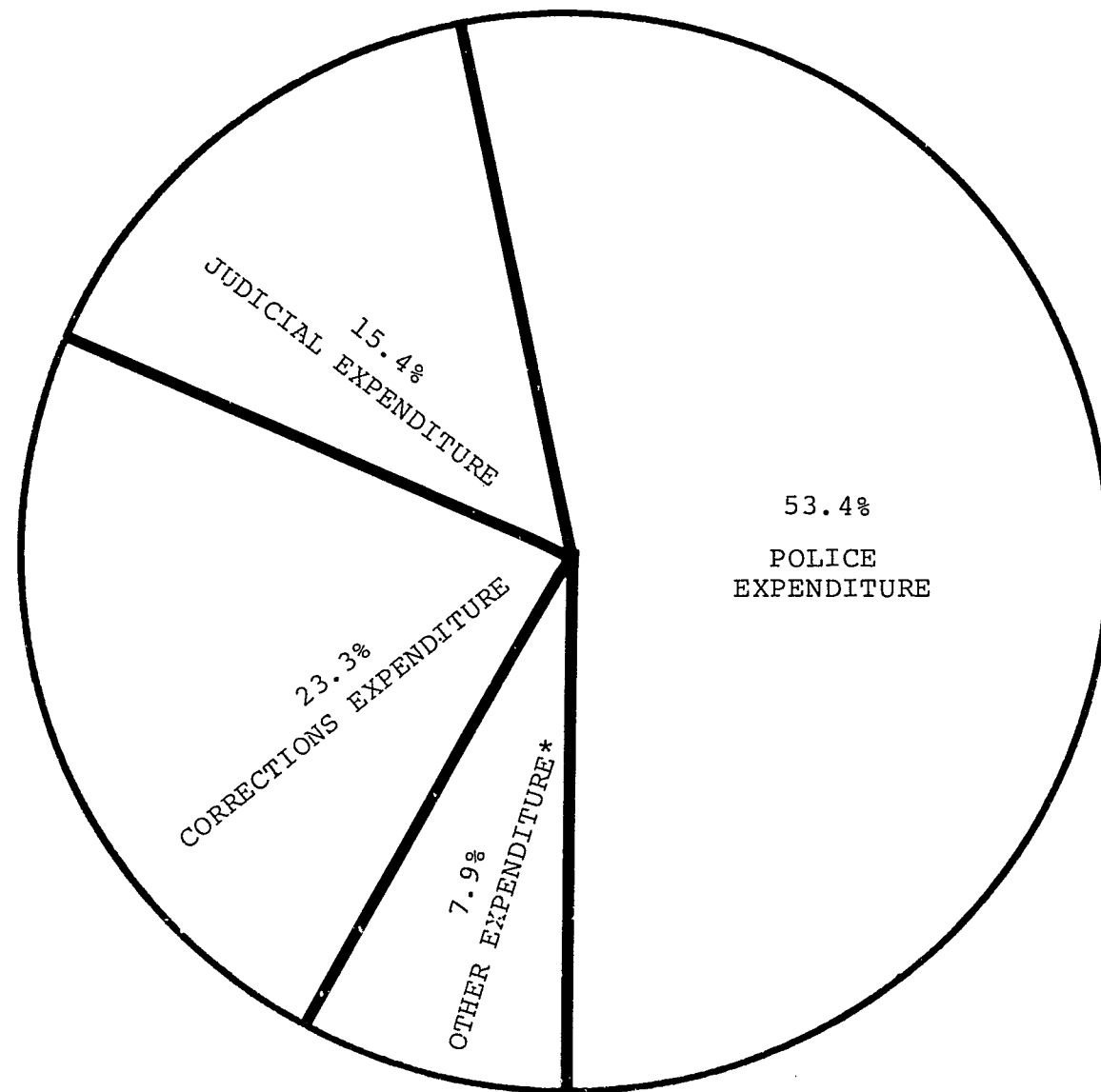

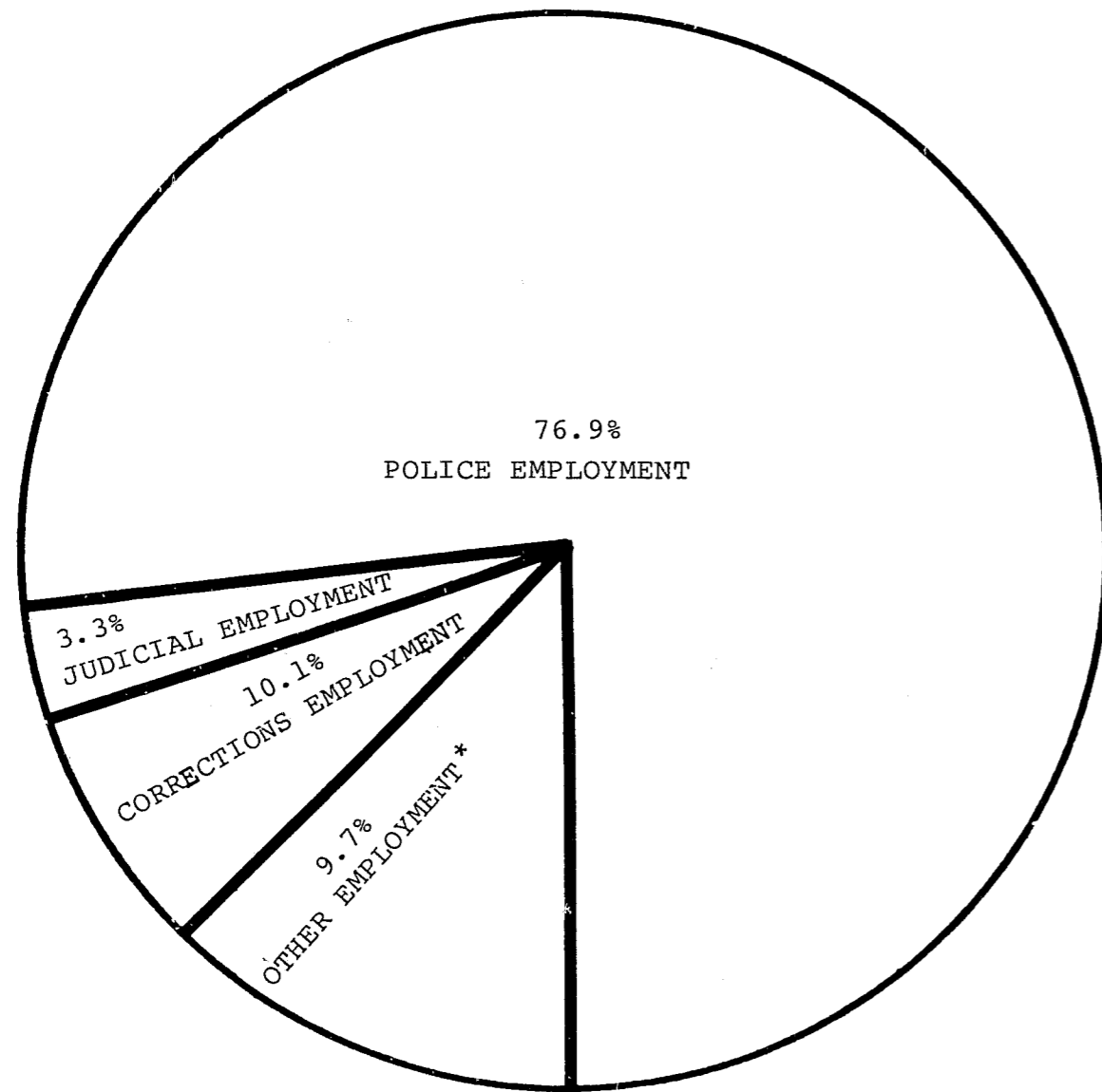

 LOCAL GOVERNMENTS - 1982

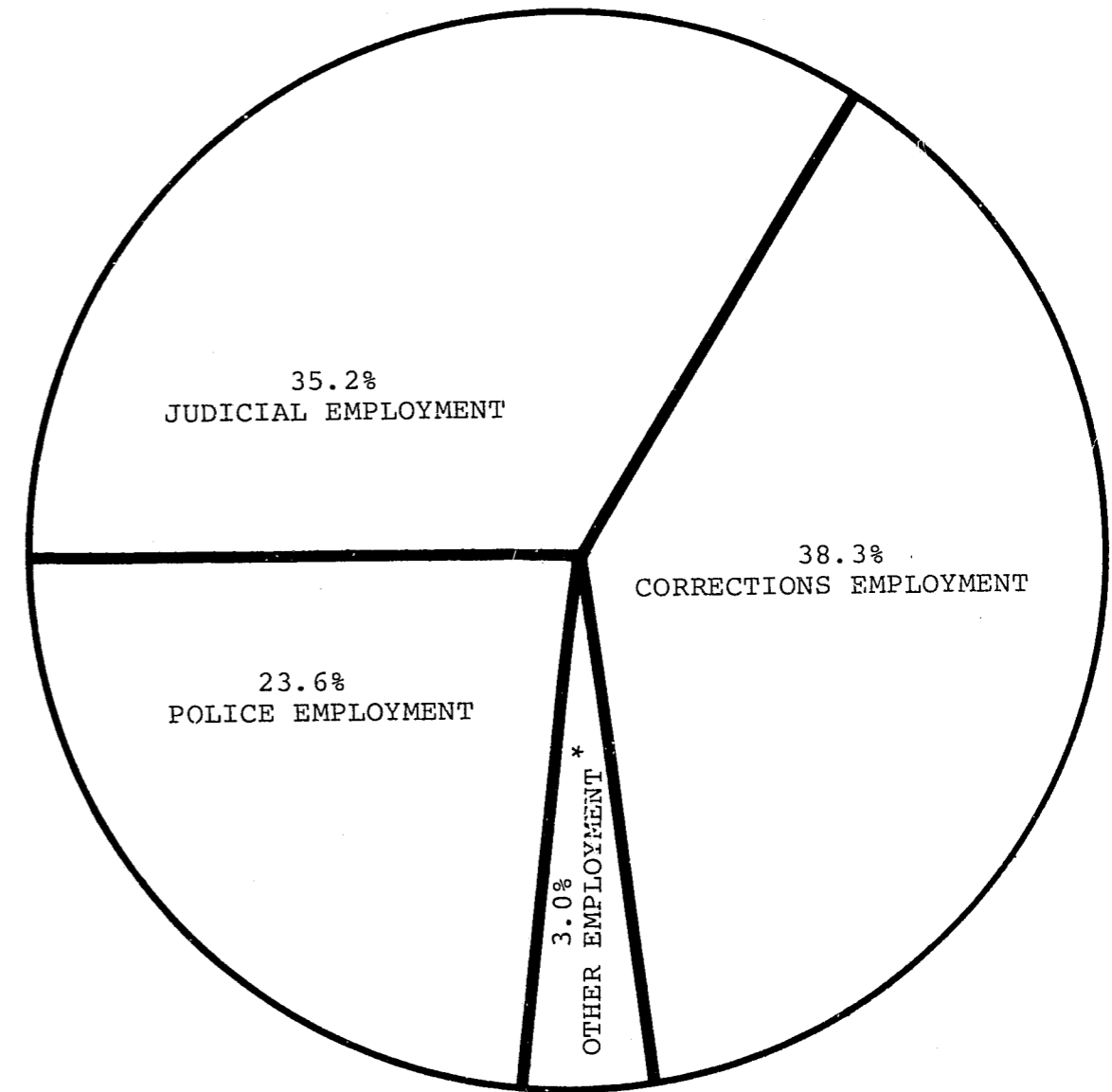

 STATE GOVERNMENT - 1982

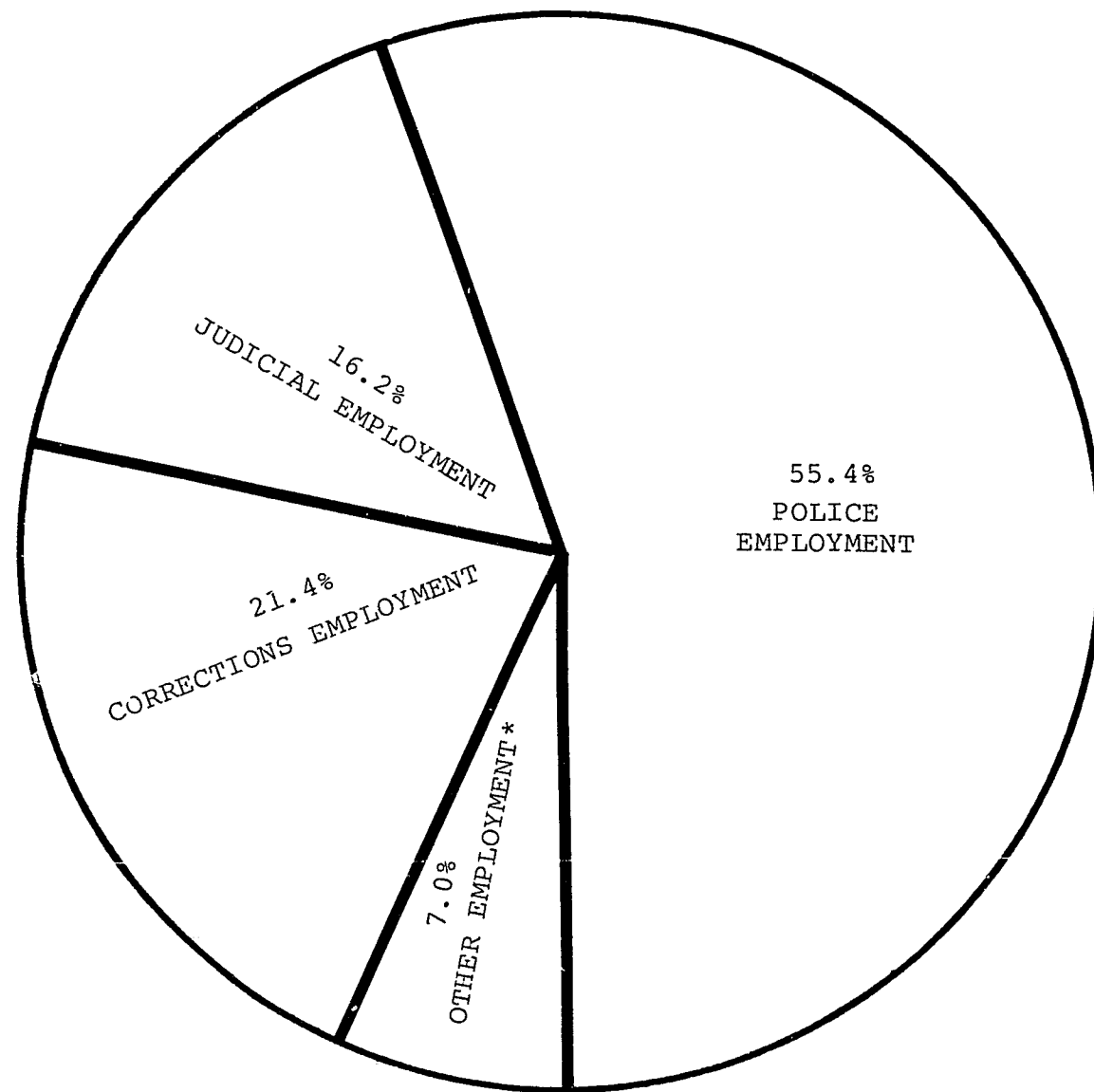

SECTION II
CRIMINAL JUSTICE EXPENDITURE

CRIMINAL JUSTICE EXPENDITURE

This section presents criminal justice expenditure and inter-governmental revenue that is expended for the sum of all reporting entities within each county and the same for state agencies. The reader is urged to consider the 29 local governmental entities that did not report and to use Appendix A, Estimated Kansas Populations By Agency and Agency Participation, 1982 as a guide in interpreting the data in these reports.

Table 7 exhibits expenditure data and total amounts dispersed inter-governmentally by state agencies within the criminal justice system. Indirect expenditures are monies paid to one governmental agency for services by another governmental agency. Inter-governmental expenditure accounts for approximately 2.2% of the total criminal justice expenditure in state government.

The corrections function of state government expends 43.2% of total criminal justice expenditures in the states system. This percentage includes 13 state agencies, six of which incarcerate adult offenders and five of which house juvenile offenders. This is followed by the judicial function which expends 26.8% of the states budget and includes expenditures for 31 Judicial Districts, the Supreme Court, Appellate Courts, district judges, court reporters, court clerks, and court services. Police function expends 23.7% of the states criminal justice expenditure and includes a total of eleven agencies. Of these eleven agencies the Kansas Highway Patrol represents 60.4% of all monies expended on police functions.

Table 8 exhibits expenditure data for local governments. This is the best accounting of criminal justice expenditure for the state of Kansas and the entities therein, but must be qualified by a reminder that only agencies

accounting for approximately 96.0% of the Kansas population responded.

The data in Table 8 further emphasize the division of functions by levels of government. In general, municipalities direct more than three-fourths of total criminal justice expenditures to support the police function. The data indicate very little support of the public defense function by municipalities, with only 1.4% of the total amounts expended for this function. Further, municipalities provide very little funding for the corrections function; support for this function at the local level in most cases comes from county government.

Table 9 presents data pertaining to monies transferred inter-governmentally from one agency to another, usually for payment of services performed by one agency for another. Examples of these types of services include housing offenders in county jail facilities for a municipality, police patrol provided by one municipality for another, or dispatching services provided by one agency for another agency. The table further shows that inter-governmental revenue transfers account for approximately 2.2% of the total amount of money expended by local government.

SECTION III
CRIMINAL JUSTICE EMPLOYMENT

CRIMINAL JUSTICE EMPLOYMENT

This section examines data concerning the number of persons employed (Tables 10 and 11) and data concerning payroll expenditure (Table 12). Data are provided for all reporting municipalities, counties, and for state government. Again, the reader is reminded to consider those agencies that did not report before interpreting the data.

Table 10 provides data regarding full-time criminal justice employment and payroll expenditure within state government. These data are provided for each of the six functional areas. The total figures indicate that state government employment accounts for 40.3% of the total criminal justice employment within the state. Total employment within the six functional areas is supplied by state government in the following manner: 1) 17.2% to total police employment, 2) 87.7% to judicial employment, 3) 9.5% to legal services employment, 4) 13.2% to public defense employment, 5) 72.0% to corrections employment and 6) 71.6% to "Other" employment.

Table 11 contains total full-time employment data for all reporting municipalities and county governments. In general dispersal of criminal justice employees for the six functional areas within local government is as follows: 1) municipalities employ 71.1% of all police personnel at the local government level, 2) municipalities provide 100.0% of the judicial function employment at the local government level, 3) county government employs 64.6% of personnel involved in the legal service function at the local government level, 4) county government employs 91.4% of all persons in the public defense function at the local government level, 5) county government employs 96.1% of persons in the corrections function, and 6) county government maintains 59.1% of "other" services

function.

Table 12 provides total payroll data. By comparing payroll data to expenditure data it is evident that the criminal justice system in the state of Kansas is labor intensive. Total cost of salaries and benefits expended on criminal justice personnel commands 66.5% of the total amount of criminal justice expenditures within the state of Kansas.

APPENDIX B
GLOSSARY OF TERMS

GLOSSARY

- CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACTIVITIES: All governmental activities that involve the investigation, apprehension, prosecution, confinement or rehabilitation of persons who violate the law, plus all administrative activities relating to persons who violate the law, or their victims.
- CORRECTIONS FUNCTION: That function of government which includes the confinement and rehabilitation of persons convicted of offenses against the law, and the confinement of persons suspected of a crime who are awaiting adjudication.
- JUDICIAL FUNCTION: That function of government which involves the administration of justice, including all civil and criminal courts and the activities associated with these courts.
- LEGAL SERVICE FUNCTION: That function of government which involves the prosecution of persons who violate the law, and the legal counsel and representation of governmental entities and their agents. This includes the civil and criminal activities of the attorneys general, district attorneys, State's attorneys and their variously named equivalents; corporation counsels, solicitors and legal departments with various names.
- OTHER CRIMINAL JUSTICE FUNCTIONS: Those criminal justice activities of government that are not elsewhere classified, that cut across more than one category, or that are not allocable to separate categories, i.e., the operation of State criminal justice planning agencies, crime commissions, etc.

POLICE FUNCTION:

That function of government which involves enforcing the law, preserving order or apprehending those who violate the law.

PUBLIC DEFENSE FUNCTION:

That function of government that involves legal counsel and representation in either criminal or civil proceedings as provided by public defenders and other government programs that pay the fees of court-appointed counsel.
